- 4)- It is urgent that the formations should be allowed in the Army because in today's deliberation of the C.L.N.A.I. it is formally requested that all partisans be allowed into the Army and Police

The C.L.N.A.I. are endeavouring to put the Italian Government in front of a fait accompli.

Our O. 104 of 18 due to cipher error. Your PX 93720 cite ENGCT of 15. Recruitment of Patriots since last July is as follows:

1. War Ministry under MMIA instruction has been recruiting volunteers, patriot or otherwise, from all over ITALY as and when required to bring formations and units up to strength.
2. General CADORNA'S proposal to enlist 10,000 patriots from NW ITALY would partially be met by MMIA agreement to accept 4,000 for month of June and more if War Establishment of combat groups and Administrative Divisions permitted. Numbers of patriot volunteers, however, have in past fallen short of vacancies available and considered unlikely 4,000 suitable patriot volunteers will be found from NW ITALY for month of June.

This Ministry requests to point out that a Signal ref 17451, No. 1 of 1 June, a volunteer collection of four thousand patriots to be used as individual replacements has been ordered and this Ministry, although it has a liaison officer with the Ministry of War has not been informed.

However, besides the above provision which should be in use, it is suggested that the partisan division "Ugo Fannenti", referred to in the attached appendix, should be admitted into the Italian Army, and since it appears as obviously opportune, that a scrutiny should be done of its members, before transferring the above division in an organic unit of the Army.

At the same time we suggest also that a copy of the above signal should be transmitted through AC to the TIRRE.

Any other explanations and news on the subject we thank you.

M.M.I.A. has authorised the voluntary enlistment of 4,000 Patriots as individual reinforcements. These Patriots will have legal status of volunteers for the Army, and therefore they may be employed anywhere, and in any way, within the national territory.

They must possess the following qualifications:-

- 1st. They must be between the age of 19 to 26 inclusive.
- 2nd. They must be physically fit; this will be determined by a thorough medical examination.
- 3rd. They must possess good moral and penal records, duly checked.

Territorial H.Q. Cmdrs are personally responsible for the choice of volunteers. Period of service - 1 year. Pay as established for volunteers at present serving in the Army according to the units they have been posted to.

The following units will undertake the enlistments, Territorial H.Q. BOLOGNA, GENOA, TURIN, and MILAN, and they will duly contact the local authorities in order to choose volunteers from those Patriots who are most deserving.

Territorial H.Q. GENOA, and BOLOGNA, will enlist 500 volunteers each; Territorial H.Q. MILAN, and TURIN will enlist 1,500 volunteers each. To be posted: by Territorial H.Q. BOLOGNA to FRIULI Combat Group and 228 Div; by Territorial H.Q. GENOA to MANTOVA Group and 230 Div; by Territorial H.Q. MILAN to the LEGNANO and FOLGORE Combat Groups. By Territorial H.Q. MILAN to CREMONA Combat Group and 231 Div, according to requirements. The above mentioned number of volunteers to be enlisted can be exceeded up to the maximum numbers required to meet the requests for reinforcements made by each Adm Div, or Combat Group to each Territorial H.Q. by following method. Each Group and Div will send to the Territorial H.Q. concerned an officer with the following duties:-

- 1st. To request number and type of reinforcements needed to reach the W.E. strength, and replace men to be discharged from the Army.
- 2nd. Arrange for the despatch of volunteers with transport of his own formation. The clothing of volunteers will be the responsibility of the receiving unit. Formations will also ration the volunteers commencing from the date of arrival.

On each Sat Territorial H.Q. BOLOGNA, GENOA, TURIN, and MILAN, will report to this S.M.R.E. the number of volunteers that have been enlisted, their destination, and the date of departure.

Extract from Col Cripps Tour Notes 24 Jun, FMA of 115/Pat 4A

14.

There is in this Region a persistent rumour that volunteers for the Army are to go to the FAR EAST. I denied this but IMPRs here feel that a public announcement denying this if it is NOT the case should be made. It is a matter that should be discussed with MIA.

Note on discussion on 11 June 48 between Lt Col Ingledew (MIA), J/Comd Proby (Patriots Branch), and Capt Kins, (Regional Patriots Officer Venezia) re possibility of enlisting Patriots from N.E. Italy into the Italian Army.

1. Capt Kins referred to signals RXII/034-16 and RXII/034-17 from the Regional Commissioner Venezia Region to HQ A/C.
 2. Lt Col Ingledew pointed out that in view of the policy laid down by ANRS, Patriots could only be enlisted into the Italian Army as individuals, and complete bands could not be absorbed.
 3. Capt Kins stated that he thought that if a definite number of individual volunteer enlistments in Venezia could be sanctioned, it would meet the case. He estimated that up to 5000 Patriots wished to enlist, but that the Army was only accepting men in the 18 - 25 age groups, a considerable number of these would be ruled out. He undertook to draw up and forward to Patriots Branch, on his return to Venezia, a more accurate estimate of the number of vacancies required; MIA would then consider what number of individual enlistments they were able to sanction.
4. Lt Col Ingledew stated that no new Alpine units could be formed, but that Patriots enlisting could ask to be sent to existing Alpine units as reinforcements.
