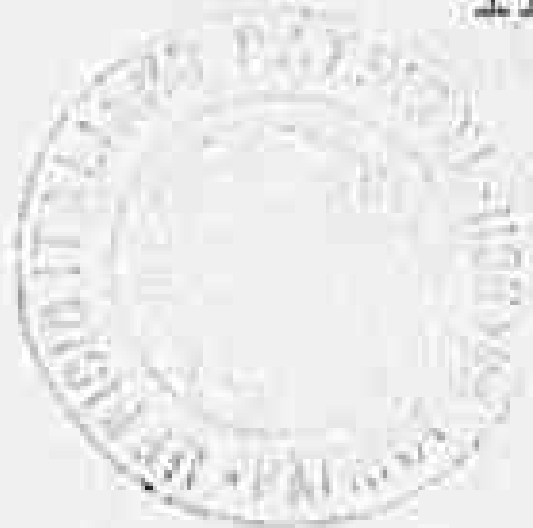

Suggestion 1

a Payment of bonuses to patriots who operated in other regions can be made only where these patriots can produce documents in perfect order and in accordance with those required for granting the above bonuses; furthermore it will be necessary that the documents should show that the bonus has not already been paid.

b - By the institution of P.M.A. Ministry it is foreseen that the assistance to patriots in those provinces where AG has ceased to function, should become the responsibility of A.P.I.

Feeding the implementation of such provisions the IIRs will have to continue in their work.

Suggestion 2

Until orders to the contrary are received, IIRs will continue their correspondence with this Ministry according to the established rules.

Other matters dealt with in the report have been passed to the assistance office.

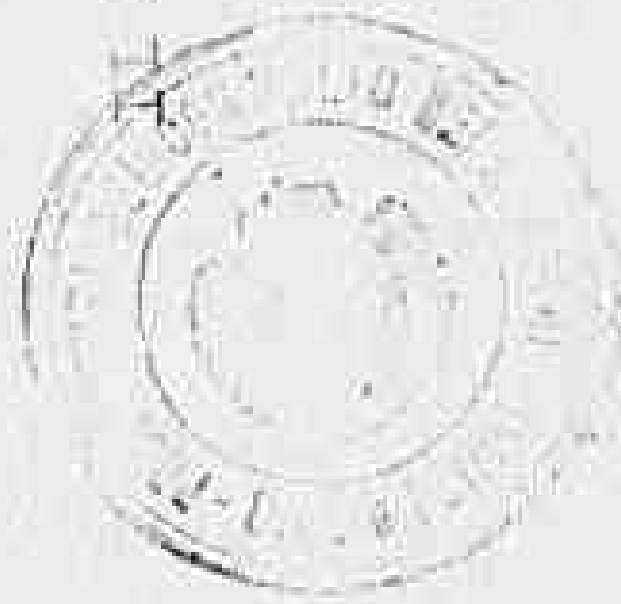

As it appears from the questions that have been repeatedly put in the last reports of Capt. Barbi - Siena Italian Military Patriot Representative - we have received no directives of any kind concerning the Patriot Representatives when the Provinces are returned to the Italian Government, and if the Office should be closed down, who should do the remaining work.

The greatest part of such work is the payment of the 1000, 5000 and 10,000 lire compensation, which have not been completed because the necessary funds have not been supplied in due time. One logical solution would be to pass the Italian Military Patriot Representative under the temporary jurisdiction of the Prefettura, who supplies the funds, until the work is completed or until the work has gone so far that it would not be possible to carry it any further (because of lack of the necessary data for the identification of fallen patriots, or knowledge of the residence of wounded patriots, etc.).

It is requested that your Office will ensure that due instructions concerning the above matters should be issued.

(Para 11) Successions. From the 10th inst. the Siena Province has been returned to the Italian Administration. It is therefore urgent that the bodies to whom this letter is addressed should give precise instructions to this office, bearing in mind that only now, after about 10 months, the issue of the necessary funds to complete payments of compensation has been authorized.

We therefore repeat the questions that have been made in the previous reports and communications:

- 1) Must this office remain alive notwithstanding the transfer of the Siena Province to the Italian Administration?
- 2) If so, under which provincial body's jurisdiction will it come? Under the Prefettura or under those ASI offices that may remain in Siena?
- 3) In the negative case to whom should we forward all matters that have not yet been settled?

(Para 12) Assistance.

- a) The payment of the funds required by this office through the Prefettura has been authorized, as above mentioned, to complete compensation to the partisans and their dependants.

Above payments however cannot begin until the bodies to whom this letter is addressed do not send the requested instructions concerning the procedure of payment of compensation specifying also the tasks of the administrations concerned.

- b) This office has also been aware with the local section of the Associazione Nazionale Combattenti, which has sponsored the assistance of the veterans, in order that all patriots returning to their homes or transit through Siena for one day at least should receive food and shelter.

The Siena I.M.P.R. at para 11 of the weekly report of 30 March 1945, points out that correspondence addressed to the Patriots Branches of Forlì and other places was answered by the local sections of A.N.P.I. He asks if such a procedure is regular and if A.N.P.I. substitutes the Patriots Representatives in areas still under A.M.G.

The answer to this query should be official and final because of the responsibility which the correspondence may involve, including the transfer of moneys.

Provinces where there is a patriots Branch, and provinces where the Patriots Branch is substituted by the local section of A.N.P.I. should be clearly pointed out.

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NOTE

It looks as if the Siena I.M.P.R. did not yet know what his own qualification is, much less what the qualifications of other Patriots Representatives are. In any case as he does not write correctly his own addresse it can be assumed that in his correspondence with the I.M.P.R. at Forlì he must have used a wrong addresse and therefore his letters must have gone to A.N.P.I. instead of to the Forlì Patriots Representative.

The suggestion arises from the fact that as definite rules on the subject are missing, the applicants put their claims through almost any channel, obtaining few if any results.

11. Assistance - A provincial welfare Committee for the members of armed forces has been instituted in Siena. The Committee is formed by representatives of all the associations of veterans, patriots and welfare of the provinces who all depend from the Central Patriots Office of Siena. Lt.Col. Croci is the chairman of the above committee and he works with all his capacities for the completion of his task. Results have been satisfactory. The clever and efficient welfare work of the Siena U.D.I. (union of Italian Women) has been greatly appreciated.

But the fact remains that these people call to this Office as representative of many different associations such as : Movimento Partigiano with HQ. in Rome, L'Unione Nazionale Partigiani d'Italia, with HQ. in Naples. These representatives produce various documents, written on official paper complete with stamps etc. which suggest the existence of partisan organisations of a certain importance and engaged upon activities which does not conform with the views of the Government and of the C.I.N. who wish to gather in one body only (the A.M.P.I.) all the Italian Partisans.

We therefore suggest that the Government should once and for all adopt a definite policy forbidding the institution and spreading of new and illegal so called partisan organisations ordering the disbandment of those already in existence which create only confusion and hinder the war effort of the country, not considering also that these organisations often land themselves in misunderstandings which often lead to personal speculations and swindles.

Subject: Patriots coming home from the Balkans.

Ref. letter 51/6/PAT dated Feb. 6, 45 forwarded by HQ A.C. APO 396 Civil Affairs Section Patriots Branch, we beg to state that:

- 1) The patriots coming back from the Balkans who have applied to this office are about 15, 3 of them only having left their address as they are still living in Siena. We have not heard from the remainders any more. L/t Salmoria handed over a regular report which has been sent to the Presidency of the Cabinet Council.
- 2) They arrived in Siena separately during the month of December 1944, but they called on this office only in February.
- 3) They were coming from Greece generally, from where they had been repatriated by the care of the Allied Military Authorities during the months of November and December.
- 4) They were furnished with very few papers certifying the activity they had performed and their appertenance to the patriot bands in the Balkans, owing to the sudden outbreak of hostilities between the E.L.A.S. units and the Greek regular forces which had compelled them to commit themselves to the Allied Military Authorities to prevent being involved in the conflict, thus losing contact with the E.L.A.S. and the opportunity to get regular documents. The papers so far produced to this office are constituted by certificates issued by Italian superior officers who, after the 8 Sept. armistice, had passed to the E.L.A.S. at the head of their own units (T.I.M.O., Italian Troops in Macedonia); testimonials issued by Allied HQs at the moment repatriation took place; a billet of admittance to the E.L.A.S. hospital.

 appears that both Patriots belonged to a "Garibaldi"
 Brigade which operated in the Commune of Castelnuovo (Piemonte)
 and whose command now seems to be in Turin.

On 12 July 1944 they were captured by German SS.
 and shot in the above Commune of Castelnuovo. The bodies
 were later buried in the cemetery of Refale, Commune of
 Santa Maria (Piemonte).

As this Office wishes to collect the acts proving
 the activity of the above Patriots the Offices to which
 this letter is addressed are kindly requested to supply
 precise data concerning the said brothers, and to what
 nation or nations they belonged. To facilitate this we
 point out that the documents that were produced consisted
 of a certificate issued by the possible Commissar of the
 "Garibaldi" Brigade of Castelnuovo, a Julius Roth, giving
 particulars of the death of the two Patriots and a certificate
 to the same effect of the International Committee of the same
 village signed by Paul Garibaldi.

The family of the dead, composed of the father Antonio,
 of the mother GI. Maria Gatti, have at present their
 residence in Florence, Via C. Lica 74. They are now moving
 to Siena through c/o Dr. Giannotti, Via S. Maria 17.

In reply to your letter of the above reference, we can give the following information:

1. About 15 patriots repatriated from the Balkans have reported to this Office, of whom only 3 have left their address here and they lived in Siena. We have no further news of the others. Gen. Salomita has made out a regular report which has been forwarded to the Presidency of the Council, Patriots Office.
2. They arrived surreptitiously during December 1944 but only reported to this Office in February 1945.
3. The majority came from Greece whence Allied Military Authorities have repatriated them during November and December 1944.
4. They have few documents to prove their activity and that they belonged to the partisan formations in the Balkans, because of the sudden outbreak of hostilities between ELAS and regular Greek forces. Consequently they had to apply to Allied Military Authorities in order not to become involved in the clash, thus losing touch with ELAS and the possibility of obtaining documents certifying their activities.

Statements that have so far been submitted to this Office consist mainly of declarations by Italian senior officers who, after Sept. 8th 1943, ceased with their units to the ELAS (ELAS Italian troops in Macedonia); certificates issued by Allied Headquarters at the moment of repatriation and one ELAS hospital certificate, complete with stamps, etc.

There is no further evidence of patriot activities.

Following verbal orders of the Chief of Cabinet, I went at once to Siena to smooth out the disagreements which had arisen between the "Comitato del Frontino" and the C.O. of the GRSI and to complete the organization of both.

The differences between the two Offices have been eliminated easily, being only misunderstandings.

I must point out the wise-work they have done in Siena to obtain the enlistment results which we are now obtaining.

Since a month ago a committee has been formed with the participation of all political parties. Meetings have been held in all villages and the Allies have granted permission to do the "week of the volunteer" during which cinema shows and balls were held for the departing volunteers. Posters have been put up and intensive propaganda was carried out. Almost the totality of the members of the Reggimento Amico and of the Brigata Liviana have enlisted.

By continuing the work, it is believed that within a fortnight the figure can be doubled. The recruiting officers, in order to continue their work need a lorry in Siena and P.O.I. permit, to enable them to gather those who wish to enlist and whose residences are in far off villages.

I will handle the matter with the competent office at the Ministry of War. S.M.P.S.

The volunteers are splendid fellows, and have a good preparation, moral as well as physical. They have a great deal of enthusiasm and good will.

I have had a conference with the representatives of the political parties, and have eliminated all existing difficulties, and have authorized the enlistment of some soldiers born before 1910 because of their moral influence on their volunteer fellows, of their physical fitness, and of their patriotic spirit.

I find it necessary to recommend to your praise Gen. Col. Cecilio Aspillero, S.O. of the Presidio, not only for his work on behalf of the enlistment of volunteers but also for the bulk of the material that he salvaged and stored in the warehouses of the district, and for the discipline that he maintains in the Sierra District.

As we believe that the task of the Military and the Civil Reps. has been completed, and as for unexplainable reasons the military rep. has been substituted, we inform you of the activity we carried out to this date on behalf of the Patriots.

- 1) Since September 1944 all the Patriots Communal Committees have been instituted in the Province, and have been working in accordance with instructions contained in the circulars.
- 2) Patriots Clubs, in all the Communes have been instituted.
- 3) We are organising two concerts on behalf of the Patriots who, at present, are in Siena province but whose homes are in occupied territories.
- 4) Little has been done to disarm the patriots, actually the patriots have not been disarmed at all, and the greatest majority has kept its arms. Situations of arms have been requested to the Carabinieri Stations.
- 5) We have given legal assistance to many patriots who have been charged by Allied Courts, of holding arms, or on other grounds.
- 6) We have contacted Allied Authorities to signal patriots of various nationalities and to thank them for their activity.

We have made contact with the Provincial Assistance Office for the distribution of clothes to the Patriots of those regions which are not yet liberated and who are therefore considered as refugees. We need money for the funeral obsequies. We have many times requested the sum of 500.000 Lires and we urge to provide us of it as soon as possible, otherwise this office is compelled to stop his authority on this camp, which is surely strictly connected with the moral of the Patriots.

3)-ENLISTMENT OF PATRIOTS INTO THE ARMY

It was not satisfying in the province. This command enlists also Patriots of the province of Grosseto and Arezzo.

4)- RETURN OF PATRIOTS TO THEIR HOMES

We have made some progresses.

5)-COLLECTION OF ARMS

We shall report to the Communal Offices to make a revision of the delivered arms by Patriots after the occupation, in order to have an exact view about the existence of arms in the province.

6)- DISTRIBUTION OF CERTIFICATES

We will take care of this as soon as we have cleared some irregularities. It would be opportune if the Patriots Office would be able to release only one type of card with a photo of the bearer to all the organisations and specifying the

At present the applications are being collected on special printed forms.

5) The Civil Affairs Command of Siena has asked the Mayors of the Municipalities for a list of all those who took part in operations as Patriots. On the basis of these lists the diplomas for distribution will be prepared.

This is in contrast with the instruction contained in par. 11 and 12 of Rif. 3/1/Pat, dated 18th of July 1944, since the Mayors of the Municipalities cannot know who is a true or a false Patriot. Furthermore, the Mayors have different political tendencies and are consequently liable to favour political parties of their own particular party.

This difficulty has been overcome, however, since the Colonel Commanding Civil Affairs will have the lists which are received from the Municipalities, checked by the representatives of the Patriots Branch before distribution is effected.

6) Lt. Colonel CAMPOSU, of the Italian Staff, is attached to the A.M.G. of the Province of Siena. SUBJECT: Report from Patriot Representatives at Siena.

TO : HQ ACC, Patriots Branch, attn. Col. McCarthy.

Attached report is returned herewith with the following comments.

1. It must be remembered that these representatives were working in the French area: in view of Franco - Italian relationships it was considered advisable to restrict their activities to the town of Siena. Furthermore the front was stabilised at the time a few miles north of the city.
2. With regard to the Republican Fascists the standard procedure in Fifth Army is for the CIC to handle such persons. Here again there was a slight misunderstanding with the French S.M. whose activities were not as thorough as those of the CIC.
3. In general the activities of these two representatives were found surprisingly satisfactory in view of the many complicated factors involved and both the SCAO CEF and the CAO Siena expressed themselves as well pleased with their work.
4. Enclosed also is a report from the Patriot representative attached to SCAO II Corps, which may be of interest.

On 10th July we left Rome:

- Capt. Tannarone Filippo
- Signori Spinelli Cerio + Giuliani Gino; & I.

The above-mentioned ~~as~~ with 4 taxi's reached the 5th Army H.Q. on the same day. The next day Sig. Spinelli & I. were introduced to Mayor Walker (American) Governor of the Town of Siena, by invitation of the operation section of the French expeditionary force.

My mission, according to the orders ^{received by} of ~~this~~ the Central Italy Patriots' Command, was, ¹ to contact the patriots' bands, ² to help in the disarming of them, ³ to ~~convince~~ ^{encourage} them to wait & trust in the reconstruction of the national armed forces and ⁴ to facilitate ^{the settlement} ~~the systems~~ them in settling.

tion of their private affairs; 5) to ~~write~~ request the commanding officers of the bands to collect information on the strength of the ~~best~~ ~~formative~~ various groups and on the activities engaged in against the nazi fascists; 6) to compile as soon as possible the list of ~~the~~ names of those who have really belonged to the armed bands so that they should be given in due course the recognition as patriots; 7) to get information on the number of volunteers who wish to join the forces.

As soon as we arrived at Siena, Major Walker assigned us to an office with the usual office hours, and we were given work of general political character & connected only in a general way with the mission above mentioned.

To execute the ^{mission} ~~services~~ given me in Rome by the Central Italy Patriots Bands Command we should have been given as a bare liberty of movement + transportation to travel in localities liberated ~~as~~ as the Allied Forces advanced to the North; actually only twice were we able to leave Siena to contact in a village nearby ~~the~~ police forces.

2

I was able to do something only in the town of Siena, in connection with the ~~Command~~ ~~Regg. di Patrioti~~ "M. Amiata" patriots ~~band~~ groups Command & with the local C. N. I. this last mentioned formed of talkative elements & not active with the exception of the Socialists & Communists.

At Siena, the Temporary Command of the bands was taken over by Lt. Col. Croci Commanding officer of the Monte Amiata group. His work was: to send home the patriots who wanted to, to provide means for those without, to help the police, & to collect all the material abandoned by the enemy.

The intervention of the police was needed frequently to settle quarrels for quarters & food supplies for the personnel. 1112

From information received, only a minority ~~minimum~~ part of the patriots of the armed bands intend joining ~~the~~ as volunteers the Italian army; even these few as soon as they find work change their minds.

The local patriots, especially those who have contributed with personal sacrifices to

anti-fascist & anti-German cause, are disappointed with the mild allied reaction against fascists, and they are even more surprised that ex-militia officers & Republican Army officers are still free in the town. The list of these individuals has been given to the allied police & for some of them proper acts of accure have been presented. The allied police limit itself to surveillance service against to prevent intelligence with the enemy to preserve a calm situation without trouble from military or political sides.

It is understood that the calm is superficial. On the 23rd July the section held by the French Expeditionary Force was taken over by the 5th & 8th Army which has gradually substituted the French by the English. Major Walker has handed over to Col. Johnston (English) but this has not affected our work. 200 ^{printed} certificates ~~presented~~ ^{from} Gen. Alexander certifying the qualification of patients have arrived. We will ask for the same number. The Air Force has sent a Major with the duties of compiling personal records of ex-service men of the province, troops included.
