SUBJECT : Report.

Since the present date from which has completed the work and tested the activity, which has proved useful in the achievement of the tasks established by the Central Committee.

As was pointed out in previous report, our work has always been entirely individual, acting exclusively at the recruitment and reactivation of individuals, as well as collective efforts of all those who actually fought for liberty (in my opinion the specialized type is less suitable to complete such a delicate work of such collective and individual interest).

After the necessary screening by the Regional tribunals, 200 certificates have been issued in the whole of the Rhodes Province.

About 50 participants in civilian work, have been recruited. They received a plausible assistance and collaboration in a various by nature of their activities.

Central Authorities, well aware of the patriotic consciousness of the men effort, have understood that the participants need to be well compensated and protected because they can now not be likely on account of political power in the country, - in which are illustrated in a possible service.

At A. A. Z. Welfare office has been established who sees to the support of anyone due to the degradation of the guard, and to whom is need. They also handle any request to do in addition.

The conditions of the town of Kosice - at 125.7 destroyed by the war, and the spirit of the people here have helped the activities of the welfare office in the social and assistance work and in the solution of a transit problem, gave final look to reconstruct, and cooperation with all their strength for the future of the country.

The assistance to districts in provinces and regions should be constant and be guaranteed by trustworthy men of proved ability unconnected with political or party influences active in a moderate power, and desirous only of order and justice.

SUBJECT: Report.

The ascertainment of the activities of those who either were members of bands, or of Patriotic organisations has been completed.

Certificates have been issued to members of organized bands and single individuals who operated in the Pescara Province, in the towns of S. Angelo and Spoltore.

The impressive ceremony was held in a public hall at the presence of the Representative of Allied Government for the Provinces of Chieti, Teramo and Pescara, the G.A.C. of Pescara and all the local authorities and representatives of political parties.

The patriots formed in their units, the families of the fallen patriots, the war invalids, the wounded and numerous public attended.

The Magg. of Alpini Giacomo Lombardi, Commander of a Band which operated North of Pescara and representative of the Military centre was the official spokesman.

The general instructions and directions of the circulars 30/1/PAT - PRB/RI/62 of **A.C. HQs. Patriots Branch**, have been put into action in the majority of cases.

Instructions have been issued to local authorities concerning the welfare work on behalf of the Patriots, and the organisation of reemployment of patriots.

Provisions have been made to give the Patriots highest priority as compared to other civilians.

The commanders of the bands have been shown all instructions concerning the treatment of Patriots as established by the above circulars.

The activity of this Office has been profitable, *having secured* from various bodies and authorities employment and assistance for the Patriots.

Only the areas north of Pescara, where the bands commanded by Magg. Lombardi and T.Cpl. Di Clemente have operated, have been visited.

been The commanders of the bands and other personalities have contacted every week for the following purposes:

- collect news on their activity (such news were transmitted in our weekly reports);
- complete the data on the casualties that have been suffered ~~and~~ inflicted;
- obtain particulars on the sabotages that have been carried out, and on all news concerning the life of the Bands (ammunition, munitions, food supplied, etc.).

Reemployment of the Patriots.

About 80 patriots and collaborators have found employment.

Volunteers.

Following arrangements with the Military Authorities very many patriots have been sent to the recruiting centres. They were supplied with an accompanying letter signed by the representative of the Military centre.

Lists have been compiled of patriots who volunteer~~for~~ for sabotages in the German rear lines (report dated 2 October 1944).

Assistance.

This Office has promoted in the Pescara Province the institution of the Associazione Patrioti, which upon orders of the C.C.L.M., was transformed in the A.I.P.I., the tasks of which were similar to those previously established for the Associazione Patrioti.

An office has been set up to organise the assistance to the families of fallen patriots, to the invalids, the wounded, and generally to all Patriots in need.

One can draw the conclusion that the results that have been achieved have been very satisfactory and can be summed up as follows :

1. - to give the proper value to the contribution of the individual effort to the common cause;
2. - to avoid that certificates should be issued on false pretences and therefore that the qualification of Patriot and the corresponding credit should only be granted to those who really fought and suffered;
3. - to assist those who were disappointed because they did not happen to find any help and were treated with little consideration;
4. - to reemploy capable individuals, assuring to them a satisfactory position fitting their capacities.

- a) Visited zone: territory between the torrent Piomba and the river Tarricella.-
b) Had contact with men of the band of Major Giacomo Lombardi. The developed activities had been controlled and assured.- Contact has been established too with Col. Russo Licheli the Commander of the Patriot Group of Spoltore. Here the developed activities, the strength and the political tendency must still be controlled. The verifications of endured losses are in progress.
c) The re-employment of the Patriots continues. We are still awaiting to know from the provincial authorities how much has been done according to the directives of the circulars emanated by the F.A.G.C. - and to the numerous questions transmitted from this office.- The arrangement of the patriots in the town of Pescara is difficult for the interferences deriving from the activity performed by some men of the Partisan Movement.- To avoid that true patriots should be considered on the same share of the elements who set in possession of certificates, however released by different associations, a Provincial Association, a Provincial Association of patriots with apolitical tendency has been constituted in the town of Pescara with the exact duty of collaborating assisting and rebuilding.

- (b) The work of controlling and checking up on the band's activities has been completed, with satisfactory results.

Bands. In the Pescara province there are three Bands i.e.

1. Bande di Popoli. Commanded by Mr. Natale Camarra - Strength 113 men - tendencies : socialistic, communistic - armament mixed (rifles, pistols, hand grenades). Casualties : 5 dead, 7 wounded.
2. Band operating in the area Loreto Aprutino - Fiume Tavo - Civitella Casanova - Fiume Piomba. Commanded by Ten. Col. Ezio di Clemente - strength 59 men - No political tendencies - mixed armament (rifles, pistols, hand grenades, sub-machine guns) Casualties : 3 dead.
3. Band operating in the Area : Lumezino - Torrente Barricelle - Torrente Piomba. Commanded by Naggiole degli Alpini Giacomo LUMBARDO - strength 64 men. No political tendencies. Mixed armament (sub-machine guns, pistols, hand grenades). Casualties : 8 dead, 4 wounded, 3 prisoners or missing.

In addition, all the Bands, were in possession of explosives, and of explosive devices stolen from German ammunition dumps. Such material have already been turned over to the competent authorities.

Isolated Patriots.

In the Pescara Province there have been many elements who have worked by themselves or in small groups, each of 5 to 6 men. The work of controlling and checking is in progress. One has so far taken in the consideration only the applications completed by documents which cannot be doubted and which confirm the statements of applications. Reemployment of Patriots.

About 50 Patriots and collaborators who wished some form of settlement have been reemployed. The existing difficulties have been partly overcome. Practical results have so far been satisfactory. There is still a certain amount of mistrust towards Patriots, due to the equivocal activity of some of the leaders of the Partisan Movement which, in the town of Pescara, has created an atmosphere of opportunism and profiteering which are not in line with the dignity of the real Partisan spirit.

Volunteers.

30 members who volunteered for the Army have been sent to the C.E.R.S.A. Following verbal agreements the young men who wish to enlist are sent to the Commission for Alpine ~~Recruiting~~ ~~Training~~ ~~Organization~~ for the constitution of the Battalion "Abruzzi".

Assistance.

To Patriots and collaborators requiring permits, facilities, employment or information, full assistance is given through this Office by the competent local authorities.

Problems of a social character connected with reconstruction and organisation, are handled by this Office, in full collaboration with the Central Authority who has to make decisions thereon.

Patrioti isolati.

Nella provincia di Pescara molti sono gli elementi che hanno operato isolatamente o inquadrati in gruppi della forza di circa 5 o 6 uomini. Sono in corso i lavori di accertamento e di controllo. Sono state prese sin'ora in considerazione soltanto quelle domande avanzate da inopponibili documenti che affermano quanto asserito dai richiedenti. È necessario controllare sul posto l'attività di questi elementi per evitare che patrioti effettivamente attivi vengano esclusi dal giusto riconoscimento (desiderata ed ambita ricompensa).

Reimpiego veterani.

Sono stati reimpiegati circa 50 veterani e collaboratori, che desideravano una sistemazione. Le difficoltà esistenti sono state in parte superate. I risultati pratici sono stati sin'ora solo iscencti. Persiste ancora un certo stato di diffidenza verso i veterani per l'attività equivoca di alcuni esponenti del Movimento Partigiano, che, nelle città di Fessina, ha creato un'atmosfera arrivista ed opportunista non rispondente alle dignità ed allo spirito del vero partiziano.

Volontari.

Complessivamente sono stati avviati al C.P.S.A. circa 30 elementi volontari, attualmente è seguito accorci verbali. I ~~xx~~ giovani che intendono arruolarsi sono avviati alla Commune di Reclutamento Alpino per la costituzione del Settaglio "Appennini".

Assistenza.

- 1) For want of transports it wasn't possible to verify the activities developed by all bands of the Province. This office is constituted to collect documents which proves the activities of the various bands.
- 2) We are always in contact with the leaders of the different bands. We get many documented reports of patriot element who operated isolatedly. As soon as possible this office will answer about these actions in the places were these patriots acted.
3. Till to-day we have effected controls in the area where the band led by ^{the} Major Giacomo Lombardi - Acted.
- 4) Bands: We can say that Bebauiss ~~is~~ is the Province of Pescara.
 - A.) Band of the Lt Colonel Di Clemente Ezio strong about 50 men, no political tendency.

- b) Band led by the Capt. Major Gracino Lombardi strong of about 47 men no political tendency —
- c) Band of Mr. Cariaria Notable showing 110 men, anarchist socialist and communist tendency —
- 5) Besides were accomplished sabotage acts and fights by little nucleus as that of Spoltore ~~of 10~~ of 14 men and that of Giombà of 7 men —
- 6) The demobilization operations had just been done in the Province by patriots who delivered their arms voluntarily to the Commands of the CCR (Royal Carabiniers) —
- 7) In every Commune has been constituted, by request of the Office to the Prefecture, a committee to find work for patriots according to the circular PRB/R/62 from the 21st July 1944 - Public Relations Branch ACC —

2) All the requests of the patriots have been considered and transmitted to the competent Authorities. But only few has been done till now by the surrounding authorities. The reemployment of patriots is in progress — but ~~there~~ ^{we met with} some difficulties, for some troubles were provoked by some elements of the partisan Movement who acted according passed principles in the town of Pescara —

- a) Inspected zones = Penne and exactly the locality of "Coneria" (region of Cutilli - Blanzano) - where a German Command (requisition commission) was disarmed by the Patriot Renato FERRARINUCCI (killed in a fight) and other elements of the band led by major Lombardi Giacomo.
- b) During this week we have always been in touch with the leaders of those bands who operated in the province of Pescara to issue temporary certificates to the components of the bands, while waiting for the original certificates.
- c) Many isolated patriots arrive to this office, requesting certificates. The control of the activities of those patriots proceeds slowly because we are still with no means of transportation. This work is now accomplished by informative elements who are in touch with persons who are dwelling in the countries where these activities have been performed. These reports are then controlled by the patriot's representatives of the ACC Patriots Branch, who after careful investigations, give their approval.
- d) Re-employment of Patriots.
As we have already reported, the communal authorities, unions are diffident towards the patriots' re-employment owing to the interference created by the Partisan Movement and to the opportunism of some elements, who pretend to be patriots. The concern of this office and the continuous assistance relative to the patriots are leading daily towards the solution of this important problem : that of the re-employment of Patriots.
- e) with an official deliberative note of the 4/10/44, the Provincial National Committee of Liberation of Pescara has promised the constitution of the Provincial section of the National Association of Italian Partisans which gathers all the partisans who acted in bands in the Province of Pescara. As president of this section has been appointed Lt. Col. Lawyer Ezio di Clemente, and as deputy-president the Patriot Natale Camarra, and as secretary the 1Ind Lt. Rafaello Moccia.

- a) Visited area: from Piomba to Barricella river.
- b) We took contacts with members of the gang commanded by the Major LOMBARDI Giacomo. The performed activities have been confirmed and controlled. Beside that we took contacts with the commandant of the Patriots' Group of Spoltore, Col.RUS O Michele. We have not yet controlled the performed activity, the number of the members and the political creed. We are controlling the losses of the gang.
- c) The operations for the re-employment of the Patriots continue. We are yet awaiting to know from the Provincial authorities how much has been done after the H.Q.A.C.C. circulars and after the many applications transmitted by this office.

The sistematization of the Patriots in the Pescara town is difficult for the interferences from the activity performed by some members of the Partisan Gang. To avoid that through Patriots would be considered like persons having documents released from various Associations, a Provincial Patriots' Association has been constituted with the definite duty of collaborating, helping, rebuilding.

- a) For the lack of a car it wasn't possible for me the reports of the activities of the other bands and isolated groups in the territories month of rescues.
- b) But contacts with the patriots of the zone are very frequent. New reports of isolated groups who had operated for the Allies arrive here daily. These reports are controlled and sifted by the assigned men, who will make ulterior inquiries as soon as possible, about the developed the activity of those partisans.
- c) The re-employment of the patriots is going on. Till to-day it was not possible to enforce completely the spirit of the circular issued by the I.G. A.C.C. - Patriot Branch - about the existing passive resistance to the central, surroundings *and* communal and to its branches.

- d) The perseverance of the local office continues towards the central authorities for the settlement of the patriots in according to the HQ AGC - Patriots Branch. For this purpose copies of *the* letters concerning the re-employment (re-operation) of patriots, have been sent for circulation. In agreement with the Italian military authorities the volunteer patriots are sent to the CERSA for the engagement. -

- a) Report of visit: the work of control in Pescara is in course while additional visits of transport to visit the places where the work is located.
- b) General comment:
 - 1) With the Commanders of the bands north of Pescara: Lieut.-Col. Lino Di Giacomo, Major Piccione Lomb *rdi*.
 - 2) With the Commander south of Pescara (head of Popoli) Lieut. Sordi Di Nocella.
 - 3) With the band Major Longo *rdi*: 40 men, political tendency none, underground organization.
 - 4) With the band of Pescara: 110 men, political tendency; communists, activity to be organized and controlled.
- c) The many visits indicating the current AFCS/1/2 public relations between AFCS and Italian population have been carried out the object of rearing and their spirit. Some have returned to their normal occupation others have left after a short period of work.
- d) Conclusion: the position of the situation of the districts.
- e) The districts that have imposed themselves due to the arbitrary domination caused by the fascists has been eliminated. The conditions and means of life of the bands have been established and freed of all restrictions imposed upon the treatment towards individuals in the following of Allied occupying command.
- f) Notes on the consolidation of the bands of patriots who remained in touch with those who to their usual activities.
