SUBJECT: Claim of Borella Benvenuto

TO : HQ Allied Commission
Patriots Branch

482.

1. Mr. Borella Benvenuto declared on 28 Aug in this Office that he belonged to the Allied Military Mission working with partisan forces in this Province Bardi-Bore Area.

2. According to Borella he has been employed with the Mission by a certain Capt Bob (English), commander of the Mission. Borella depended direct from one member of the mission named Roberto.

3. Mr. Borella got monthly 3000 Lire from the Mission and expenses. The Mission left the area suddenly after the liberation and therefore Mr. Borella could not get one month's pay and 1.600 Lire for expenses encountered in March.

4. Mr. Borella is claiming this sum. This office is not in the position to check the Italian members of the Mission and Mr. Borella has no statement at all from the Officers of the Mission.

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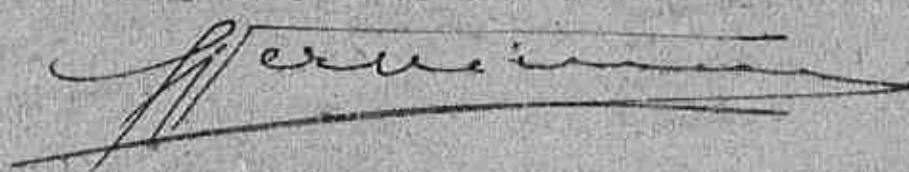
