SUBJECT : Correspondence to AFHQ

TO : All CA Sub-Commissions

AFHQ Cable 69639 8/16 Dec 44 is quoted below for your information.

- 1 "A growing tendency has developed of addressing messages to this Headquarters "PERSONAL" for some named individual. This is of course proper in certain cases where it is desired to limit distribution. It is misused however when it is merely the intent to insure that the message reaches the proper person and under the procedure now in effect within the Headquarters causes much unnecessary clerical labor and delay in distribution. Usually it is unnecessary to name the individual who is to take action in the matter under correspondence but where the originator desires to insure that his message is seen by a particular individual but does not desire to limit distribution to him, the message should be addressed to him, but the word "PERSONAL" should not be used. Correct address on such a case would be "AFHQ FOR JONES".
- 2 Where it is the intent to limit distribution to the addressee, or such persons as he may designate, it is urgently requested that the message be addressed for his eyes only, for example, "AFHQ FOR JONES FOR HIS EYES ONLY", or "AFHQ PERSONAL AND PRIVATE FOR JONES". This method of address will only be used by subordinate commands in the case of messages for SAC, D/SAC, CHIEF OF STAFF, DEPUTY CHIEF OF STAFF, CAO, CG MTOUSA and CHIEF OF STAFF MTOUSA."

SUBJECT: Uniforms

In the last weeks it was noticed an impressive increase of the disorder and the breaches committed by all rank enlisted men in the use of military uniform, especially by the men crossing over Home.

Uniforms of the most different fashion, often composed in same time of green-gray and khaki cloths, are worn fancifully, with the collar of the shirt open - also without a tie - with folded up sleeves, without cap, etc.

I understand perfectly well the present difficulties which don't permit a strict observation of the regulations concerning uniforms, but I ask to every man, and specially to the officer, to do their best in order to improve the present situation in that matter. Special instructions will be given by the commanders of units to their men, specially to batemen and clerks, so that the present disorder can cease.

A special account of the breaches must be done, in order to ascertain in which units the uniforms disorders are more frequent so as to punish the responsible commanders.

The following are the new rules for the use of uniforms, taking into account the present difficulties of a regular supply of clothing:

1°) - The uniform for officers, non commissioned officers and men is the green-gray wartime uniform, as prescribed by the circular letter 543 G.O. 1940.
- In service officers and non commissioned officers must wear uniform with breeches, green-gray tie and cap.

It is admitted - for officers not commanding troops - to wear long trousers, with green-gray shirt and cap.

Other ranks men can wear long trousers of the para-troopers model.

- Out of service officers and non commissioned officers can

All rank men must not bear weapons (circ. lett. 10150/I July 7).

- 2°) - It is admitted the use of khaki uniform, also with a short sleeves shirt and a colonial jacket of the same colour.
- 3°) - In service and out of service:
- it must be avoided, if possible, to use promiscuously clothing objects of different colours.
- with the colonial khaki jacket it is allowed not to wear a tie, when the collar of the jacket is closed; with open collar a tie must be worn.
- peace time cap can be worn only by the Royal Carabinieri.
- 4°) - Officers and non commissioned officers wearing uniform with breeches must bear the belt without pistol, out of service, and in service not with their unit.
- 5°) - The present rules must be considered as temporary.

I am sure that all the H.C. will act so as any abuse, exceeding the tolerance limits admitted by this circular letter, will be eliminated.

A particular attention must be given to enlisted men serving in Rome or crossing over the town, where their uniform can be much more easily noticed, especially by the Allies.

- A nominative list of the informers and the spies (if possible with all the identity data and the present residence), specifying the single accusations.
- Eventual proposals of military rewards.
- A rigorous documentation and witnesses (written statements delivered by the local Liberation Committee, by the Sections of the political parties, by the "Sindaci" (Lord Mayors) by the Parsons and the Carabinieri) so as to make a complete description of the activity of each Band, taking into account that the Commander of the Band is penally responsible for his declarations.

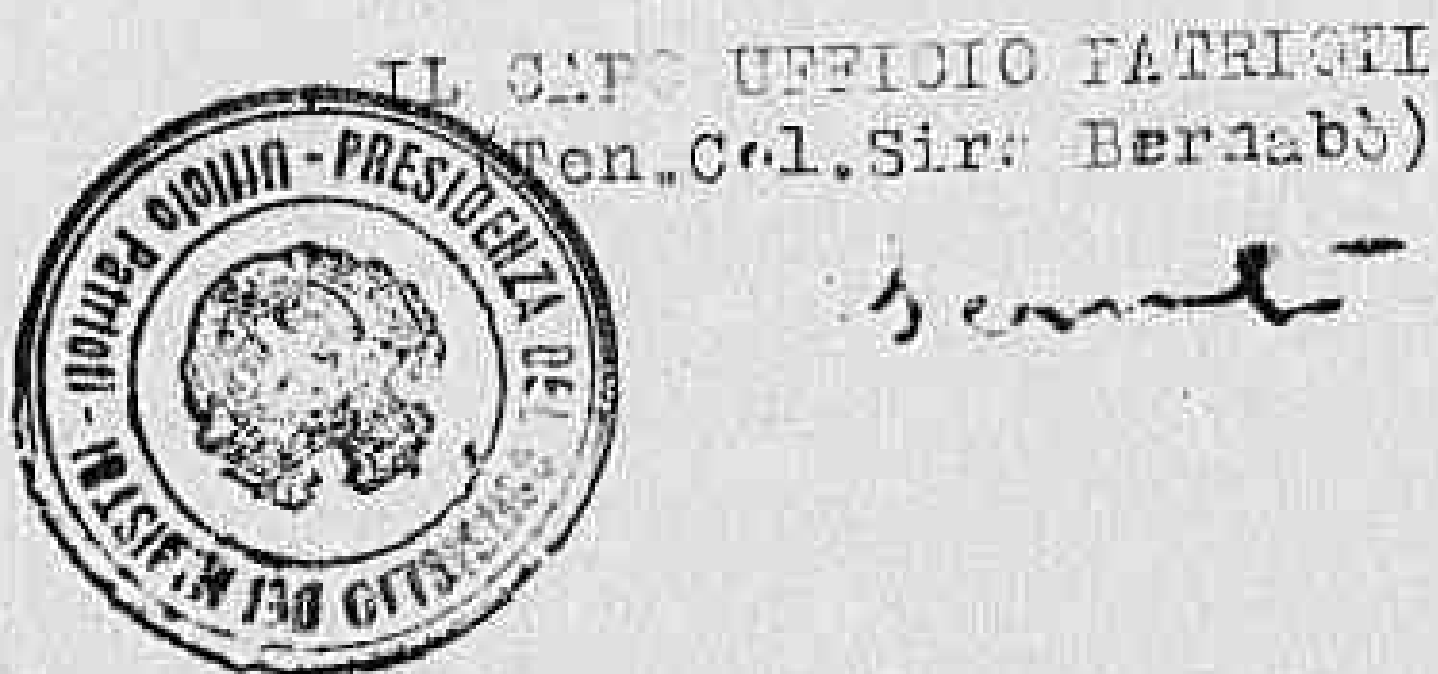

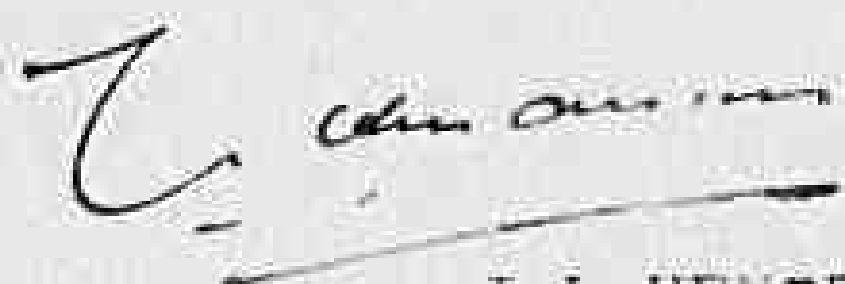

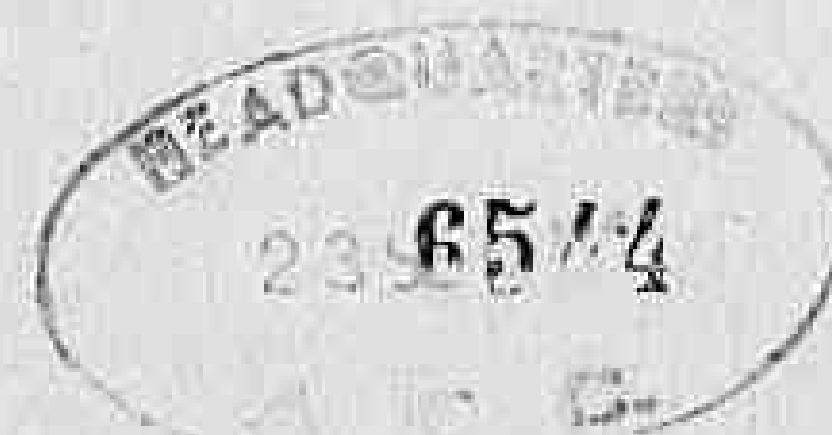
