Mrs Agatina CAPANNI thinks you know Baron Giacomo LOMBROSO who left for Florence with the 8th Army at the beginning of July. The Baron was killed in Florence.

Mrs Agatina Capanni, is maid to Marchese Negrotto Via Corsini 12, Rome, helped Lombroso when he was in hiding from the German SS because of his contact with Lt. Luciano Russiani arrested on the 27th April.

Lombroso had to change apartment for security reasons and the maid hid all his belongings in a cellar owned by Marchese Negrotto (brother Lombroso's brother-in-law).

Baroness Lombroso lives in Florence, Via Manzoni 14, and knows all about Agatina. Agatina had a letter from Barone Lombroso to fetch all his personal effects from Via Salaria 124.

Apparently almost every thing has been stolen from the cellar and the Questura does nothing about it. Agatina puts the blame on Miss Marras Elvira maid at Via Corsini 12.

Agatina Capanni makes a request to help Marchese Negrotto to return to Rome to settle these matters.

Reference your letter c/a subject and letter from Secretaries Office Italian Communist Party, the following particulars extracted from report of 427 F.S. are forwarded for your information.

"ORSINI Giuseppe fu Germino, born at Popoli 21 Dec 1912, Secmetra. Interned for duration for having illegally arrested and dispersed the CC.ER. of Popoli and having his small party remove all records in the Caserma. For having armed his Partisans with arms taken from the CC.ER. and for having appointed his so called Partisans as Police. He is a representative of a certain class trying to gain power, local or otherwise by posing as a Partisan."
