

In order to eliminate the difficulties connected with the transfer of moneys necessary for the payment of indemnities to Patriots Representatives, this Patriots Branch upon agreement with the Presidency of the Council, requested the paymaster of Allied HQs to pay the Patriots Representatives. The Presidency of the Council would have refunded the expences through the Allied Financial Agency at the Bank of Italy.

Mr. Fencaltea, at the time undersecretary to the <sup>13</sup> Presidency of the Council, with a letter ref: 34/U.2 dated 21 October 1944 engaged himself to deposit the amount necessary until 31 October 1944, and to refund any further expence afforded by Allied Authorities for the Patriots Representatives.

To this day, disregarding several requests, no payment has been done by the Presidency of the Council, although Allied paymasters have already disbursed nearly three million lire. We therefore request your Office to make the necessary provisions in order to obtain the reimbursement of the above amount which can no longer remain impayed.



1. Instructions are being sent to regional commissioners regarding the employment of Patriot representatives and the hiring of motor vehicles on their behalf.
2. The Italian Government has indicated that the representatives have not received pay for some weeks, as it is possible that the general instruction will not reach regional or provincial finance offices for some time you will proceed to make the necessary payments on the receipt of this letter. The relevant extracts from the general instruction are as follows:
  - "1. Regional Commissioners will notify the Regional Finance Offices of the names and location of all Patriot representatives in the Region. Any change in the personnel of the Patriot Representatives or in their location will at once be reported to the Regional Finance Office by the Regional Commissioner.
  2. On the basis of the information received from the Regional Commissioner the Regional Finance Office will make arrangements to pay, through his Provincial Finance Offices or other sub-accounts, the Patriot Representatives who will be distributed throughout the Region.
  3. Patriot Representatives will immediately be paid by not as from the date of their appointment or as from the 1st of September if their appointment was prior to that date, up to the 15th of October 1944. Thereafter they will be paid on the 1st and the 15th day of each month.

As it is possible that the general instructions will not reach regional or provincial finance officers for some time you will proceed to make the necessary payments on the receipt of this letter. The relevant extracts from the general instruction are as follows:
  1. Regional Commanders will notify the Regional Finance Offices of the names and locations of all Patriot representatives in the Region. Any change in the personnel of the Patriot Representatives or in their location will at once be reported to the Regional Finance Officer by the Regional Commander.
  2. On the basis of the information received from the Regional Commander the Regional Finance Officer will make arrangements to pay, through his Provincial Finance Offices or other sub-commissions, the Patriot Representatives who will be distributed throughout the Region.
  3. Patriot Representatives will immediately be paid by AIG as from the date of their appointment or as from the last of September if their appointment was prior to that date, up to the 15th of October 1944. Thereafter they will be paid on the last and the 15th day of each month.
  4. The rate will be two hundred (200) lire per day for a 7-day week; the rate will be the same for civilians and for officer personnel, irrespective of rank.

5. The pay of Patriot Representatives will eventually be received by AGO from the Italian National Patriot Committee. It will therefore be necessary for all Patriot Representatives to be paid on a separate payroll, the original copies of which, along with each Patriot Representative drawing pay, will be furnished with the Monthly Report of Revenue and Disbursements to the Chief Accountant AGO. He will take the necessary steps to obtain reimbursement from the Italian National Patriot Committee each month.

6. Attached is a schedule with the names of existing Patriot Representatives. This schedule should be used as a basis for making the original payment. Thereafter, the schedule will be sent periodically to the Regions; as, however, the Regional Committees may change the personnel or location of the Patriot Representatives in his Region, these lists may not subsequently reflect the actual situation. For this reason they will only act as the authority for payment, up to the end of September, and subsequent payment will be made on the authority of the Regional Committees.

Use of Motor Vehicles

1. Motor vehicles may be hired on behalf of the Patriot Representatives in the specific authority of the District Branch, Headquarters AGO, who will issue instructions through the Regional Committees. In all such cases the prior agreement of the Italian National Patriot Committee will be obtained.

2. The sub-committee making the payment will obtain a receipt on a Payment Voucher, R/13, in triplicate, (using two originals and one duplicate), and will mark them clearly to show that the payments in question are in respect of the hire of vehicles for Patriot purposes only.

The two originals will then be sent, with his Monthly Report of Revenue and Disbursements, to the Chief Accountant, Headquarters. Such expenditure will subsequently be recovered from the Italian National Patriot Committee by AGO in the same way as the pay of the Patriot Representatives.

2. The sub-accountant making the payment will obtain a receipt in a Payment Voucher, 2/33, in triplicate, (using two originals and one duplicate), and will mark them clearly to show that the payments in question are in respect of the hire of vehicles for Patriot representatives.

The two originals will then be sent, with the Monthly Report of Receipts and Disbursements, to the Chief Accountant, at Headquarters. Such originals will subsequently be recovered from the Italian National Patriot Committee by AGO in the next way on the part of the Patriot representatives.
