The only personnel of the Advanced Detachment of the Patriots Branch to remain in FLORENCE are as follows:

1 Driver - Mr. R. INNOCENTI
1 Italian Typist capable of typing in English
(to be chosen at your discretion)

All other employees must be given a graceful notice of discharge at seven days. I leave this in regard to personality to your discretion.

2. The Patriot Representatives, as at present attached to you, should be offered to either V or VIII Armies, and if not required by them should be returned to ROME.

3. The officers and AM/ORs attached to you from Regions should be returned to Regions. You had better write direct to the Regions concerned in my name and state that, owing to the reorganisation of the Patriots Branch, there is no further work for these officers and men to do at the Advanced Detachment, and that you are therefore returning them to the Regions concerned.

4. Transport. I am not at all clear in regard to your transport, as I understand that LANCIA HQ No. 336 is the only requisitioned car on your strength, and this you will please not let go on any account but will retain for your own transport.

I can see, however, no possible use or work for the other cars in the Advanced Detachment, but do not wish them to be disposed of if they are requisitioned, or until the matter is clear in my mind. I will probably discuss this with you on Monday et seq., but you might explore the possibilities of giving the Patriot Representatives the balance of your cars. Nothing is to be construed in this remark of mine as definite, but I should like you to
