Pietro and partly by this office in demobilisation premiums to the Patriots of this Group, we would be very glad to hear of any good results that have derived from your humane interest in the request for winter garments for our men.

The bad economical conditions of this area and the scarcity of every item of primary importance lead us to foresee a winter that will be worse than the others, because no tangible aid, nor any appreciable means of comfort, has reached these people which more than any other in Italy have experienced the tremendous destructions of war. Poverty, hunger, destruction and epidemics are still sources of mourning and suffering!

And it is from you, from your kind heart, from your generosity that our faith and hope are expecting great things.

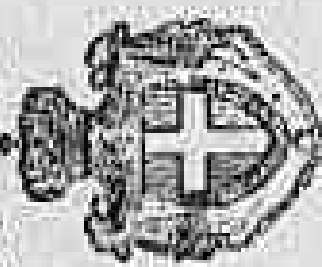

TO : Civil Affairs Section
Lt. Col. Bonham-Carter

1. In recent weeks demands for repaired army clothing and boots have been diminished steadily. At the same time it has been increasingly difficult for the Commerce Sub-Commission to find trained personnel for carrying on the reprocessing of salvaged garments.
2. Therefore it has been decided to transfer the supervision of the repairing process and the work of allocating the finished garments to the Italian Government. Thus in the future the Istituto Nazionale per il Commercio Estero will exercise control over the reprocessing of clothing and shoes and all allocations will be made by the Ministry of Industry & Commerce. Commerce Sub-Commission will no longer be responsible for either repairing or allocating.
3. Thus from the present moment, Civil Affairs Section will no longer receive weekly allocations of clothing from this office. If Sub-Commissions or Branches of the section are in need of clothing in the future, demands will be made by them on the Ministry of Industry & Commerce preferably via their corresponding agency in the Italian Government. No further requests for these items will be accepted by this Sub-Commission.

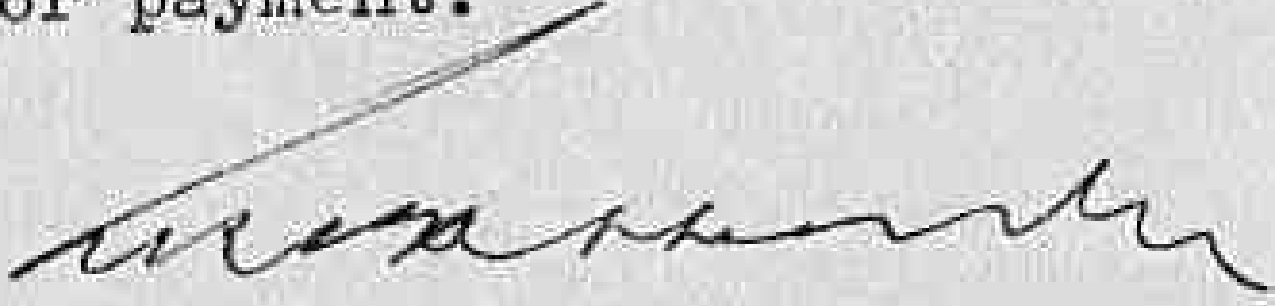

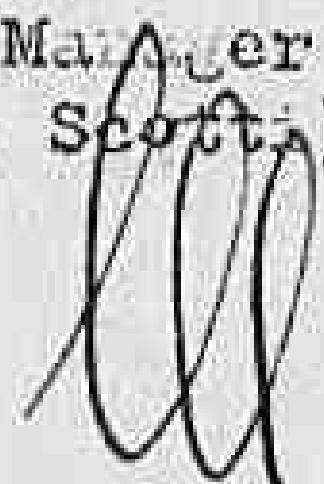

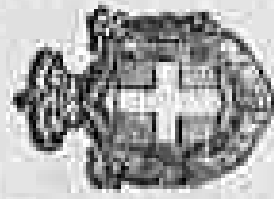

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PREPARATION OF BID - FORM TSC/3

1. Bidding system is designed to provide positive control of transportation by rail of civil freight traffic (both AC and Ordinary Italian). Careful reading of and compliance with their instructions and accurate preparation of Form TSC/3 will materially help all concerned to obtain the best possible transportation.

2. Types of Civilian Freight Traffic. Civilian (i.e. all non military) traffic falls into two broad categories.

(a) AC Traffic. Comprises commodities which AC considers essential to meet vital needs, and over which AC exercises a large measure of control, such as wheat, flour, sugar, olive oil and other basic foodstuffs or supplies. Salt, fuel, fertiliser, seeds, and essential products sponsored by Italian Government under AC auspices are included in this category.

(b) Ordinary Italian Civilian Freight Traffic. Comprises all freight movements required by civilians, not coming under sub-para (a) above. Such movements must be limited to capacity available after requirements of sub-para (a) above, have been fully met.

3. Emergency Traffic of Extreme Urgency. Regular working of bidding system is essential. However, it is appreciated that emergencies may arise requiring special movement arrangements. In such cases, form TSC/3 will be prepared, clearly marked "Emergency Request", and details of emergency clearly specified. Officers and consignors preparing form TSC/3 are responsible for determining that there is actual urgency.

4. AC Official Wagon labels. Attention is directed to the fact that wagons must bear official AC WAGON LABELS, completed in ink. Two numbered labels will be provided, upon acceptance of bid, for each authorised wagon. Labels will be supplied by AC in Representative to Regional and Provincial Supply Officers, who will endorse them with details of commodity, serial number of bid, date during which movement is authorised, stamp and sign them before issuing to consignor. The number of the railway wagon will be inserted in ink by stationmaster at time of loading. On any cancellation of movement, AC official wagon labels must be returned to issuing authority.

5. WARNING. Italian railways have been seriously affected by ravages of war. There are critical shortages of coal supplies and wagons, and military necessities must always receive preference. Bids beyond reason or necessity must not be made and quantities must be limited to actual requirements, and must not exceed the quantity that can be loaded within any one seven day period. Mass bids for large quantities to move at problematical date, or for which all details have not been fully determined, will NOT be submitted on form TSC/3. Letter giving details of such proposed or problematical shipments should be submitted to HQ AC Transportation Sub-Commission in advance, through usual channels giving all known details.

3. Emergency Traffic of Extreme Urgency. Regular working of bidding system is essential. However, it is appreciated that emergencies may arise requiring special movement arrangements. In such cases, form TSC 3 will be prepared, clearly marked "Emergency Request", and details of emergency clearly specified. Officers and consignors preparing form TSC 3 are responsible for determining that there is actual urgency.

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5. WARNING. Italian railways have been seriously affected by ravages of war. There are critical shortages of coal supplies and wagons, and military necessities must always receive preference. Bids beyond reason or necessity must not be made and quantities must be limited to actual requirements, and must not exceed the quantity that can be loaded within any one seven day period. Mass bids for large quantities to move at problematical date, or for which all details have not been fully determined, will NOT be submitted on form TSC 3. 1. Reference telephone conversation on 7 April between Major SHANE, Patriots Branch, and Major COLE, Land Forces Sub-Commission.
2. It is appreciated that normally M.M.I.A. can issue battle dress uniforms only to Italian Officers and men whose units appear in the current order of battle.
3. The nature of the work of Italian Military Patriot Representatives which involves close contact with Patriots of every political shade and makes it advisable that the dress which they wear should be more democratic than the old uniforms of the Italian Army.
4. In addition these uniforms are entirely out of place at the front. It is requested, therefore, that green battle dress uniforms be made available to these officers. About 50 uniforms would be required.
5. As the matter is urgent a quick reply will be appreciated.
