

TO : SAC, Rome, with copy.

1. During the month of February 1945 nothing of particular note occurred in regard to this Section. Influx of arrivals both at L. G. and at Florence Centres was more or less what would be expected and I attach hereto the monthly totals showing how the various numbers were distributed. I also attach hereto a list showing the stock which was present at the warehouse at the Florence Centre at the close of the month of February 1944, which shows the amount of equipment which has been loaned to the two Centres.

2. Italian Army stations have been issued to all centres through our Centres at the discretion which we are exercising at the moment in that whilst we obtained the authority from the local authority was given for the issuance of Army and District and District with the result that we are at present drawing these certificates from the offices. Owing to limit time in transport I fear that when we start to move, some difficulty may be experienced in obtaining these certificates, unless the local authority is advised so that we may draw them from the local offices.

3. On the 18th of February Mr. Harold Hillier, British representative of the Transit Section, visited the Transit Centre in Florence and on the following day at San Casciano. Chief Constable Hillier was inspected the Centre. Both these gentlemen expressed their approval in the manner in which the organization was functioning.




