SUBJECT: Repatriation from France
of Signor F. Chabod.TO : G-5 Section, Allied Forces
Headquarters.

The Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs have requested that permission and facilities to return to Italy may be granted to Signor Frederico Chabod together with his wife and sister-in-law. Signor Chabod is at present residing in Grenoble.

2. Signor Chabod fought for a long period in the ranks of the Partisans of the Aosta Valley and was forced by enemy action to seek refuge in France where he enjoyed the hospitality of the French Partisan leaders. He desires to return to Italy to continue the struggle against the Germans.
3. No. 1 Special Force, C.E.F., and the Patriots Branch of this Headquarters, who have been consulted, see no objection to Signor Chabod's return.
4. The Political Section would therefore be grateful if G-5 Section would initiate appropriate action. 9378

YMINISTERO DEGLI AFFARI ESTERI.MEMORANDUM FOR THE POLITICAL SECTION, C.A.

The Ministry for Foreign Affairs have recourse to the courtesy of the Allied Commission with a view to obtaining that Signor FEDERICO CHABOD, now residing in Grenoble (France), be authorised to return to Italy with his wife and sister-in-law.

2. Signor CHABOD, after having fought for a long time in the ranks of the partisans of the Aosta Valley, as one of their eminent leaders, was forced by the enemy's action to seek refuge in France where he enjoyed the hospitality of the Authorities of the - French "Maquis" -. His return to Italy is connected with his activity in the partisan struggle against the Germans.
