The transition in 1945 - proposed new forming the MPWA is USA.
2. Below is a summary of the effect of the annex to which reference is made.

(Para. 3) DL 12 of 3 March 1945 - Art 2 institutes a committee whose function is to assist the President of the Council of Ministers in the administration of the "Fondo di Solidarieta' Nazionale" and is composed of vice-presidents, Ministers without portfolios, the Ministers of Finance, Interior, Treasury, Public Works, Occupied Territories and High Commissioner for food supplies.

DL 220 of 28 Sept 1944 empowers the President of the Council of Ministers to appoint the acting President of the Executive Committee of the E.S.D.S.I. and to appoint by decree the Board of controllers.

DL 79 of 19 March 1945 approves the agreement stipulated in Rome on 8 March 45 between the Italian Government and UNR

DL 19 of 19 March 1945 between the Italian Government and UNRRA.

DL 147 of 14 April 45 empowers the President of the Council of Ministers to fix in conjunction with the Minister of the Treasury, the salaries of the Italian representatives in the Italian mission with UNRRA.

(Para 6) DL 100 of 4 Feb 45 provides for the employment in State Departments of persons who are not civil servants, to perform unspecified duties for indefinite periods of time by contract renewable every year.

(Para 7) DL 2440 of 6 Nov 1923 lists expenditures under ten specific headings such as allowances to military personnel, operational expenses of armed forces, wages and allowances of personnel communication department and bodies organized on military basis, etc., and limits the expenditures to 250,000 lire.

DL 356 of 21 June 40 contemplates in full the rules in question.

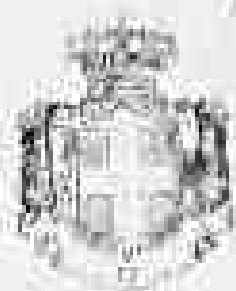

Civilian administrators have been refused to us by the British. I still ignore and this is spite of the intervention of many Italian political leaders.

Therefore I kindly ask the Allied Commission of the Allied Military Command Naples or any other high authority to which I have to address my request to grant me the honour of the permission to speak as an Italian, as a partisan, as a free man and leader of the most genuine and worthy political movement of an Italy trying to rise again from mourning and massacre, in the Italian. There are 300,000 in Naples.

I am sure that all good

I am sure -and all other intentions are sure- that this movement will be united by those believing in the old way of living of the people. I've placed the sacred flag of Democracy and Liberty.

I have also ask you that the promises in the new movement to the European Movement which have been renounced in spite of the other not to renounce them, issued by the Allied Command, be given back to us. These promises are now unfulfilled and are almost empty but for a section of whom which is occupied by UPRR. The actions of these promises obtained by the party from the Allied authorities only by surprise. We are waiting now from the Allied authorities which have been deceived in their good faith, without of justice to satisfy this inconvenience.

Winter-time is approaching rapidly and we want to give assistance to the more unhappy and needy part of the population that collaborating with the population as good works of human solidarity. It is kinder to do this would mean to satisfy all

The decree instituting the Ministry for P.W.A. gives me authority to institute detached offices.

In a few days, when the decree instituting the Ministry for P.W.A. will be signed (the Minister Soleri died before signing) and when the same decree will have been published in the G.U., I intend to appoint Dr. Chisbaf the head of the detached office of the Ministry of P.W.A. in Milan. The decree instituting the Ministry for P.W.A. gives us authority to institute detached offices.

It is necessary to institute a detached office in Milan in order to coordinate the assistance activities in all the provinces of the North which are still occupied by Allies. In consideration of the great distance between Rome and Milan, it is my wish to endow the above office with wide authority.

As Dr. Chisbaf shall exercise his functions in territory occupied by the Allies, I wish to inform you of the above. In view that we should, with his usual courtesy, facilitate his task.

Dr. Chisbaf temporarily will have his office at Piazza Leonora, Duke J, Milan at the former refugee's office.

PRO-MEMORIA PER IL COL. CRIPPS

Commissioner, as from date that this decree comes into force.

10. The Liaison Office with the Ministry of War, and the Welfare Office, formerly under the jurisdiction of Ministry of Occupied Italy shall come under the jurisdiction of the Liaison with such organization and rules as may be laid down by the Liaison Office, and that of the Treasury.
11. The Liaison Office authorized to use, for the special purposes mentioned in this decree, any funds formerly at the disposal of the Liaison Office, increased or diminished to be taken over by the Ministry no far as the funds handed to the staff of War under the special heading of the Budget estimate for the financial year 1944 - 5 as the respective authorities are concerned. The above provision shall be valid until the estimate for the financial year 1945 - 6, if the Liaison has been approved.
12. The Liaison Office shall issue a decree to make the necessary amendments to the Budget to implement this decree.
13. This decree shall come into force on the day of its publication in the "Gazzetta Ufficiale" of the Kingdom.
