2. The demobilization bonus will be paid to:

Patriots of foreign nationality (who fought in the Italian cause) set out in letter 146/121 of 20 July 45 of the Patriotic Branch (copy attached). Patriots coming from Venezia Giulia and having all documents in order are entitled to the payment of the demobilization bonus, the payment and the issue of the welfare booklet must be requested on the documents. However, in Venezia Giulia and still at an early date over a Patriotic Office; as soon as this Office is organized (the exact date will be notified) they will be responsible for the payment of bonuses to the patriots of that region.

3. Besides the ones set out in the above paragraph the bonus will be paid to patriots who belonged to formations which did not operate in the region of provision under the administration of the I.M.B. In such cases the Patriotic Office should transmit his documents direct or through the I.M.B. of the region where he is residing or through which to the I.M.B. of the region where he operated.

4. The bonus to be paid for the family of the deceased patriots is 12,000 lire for each deceased.

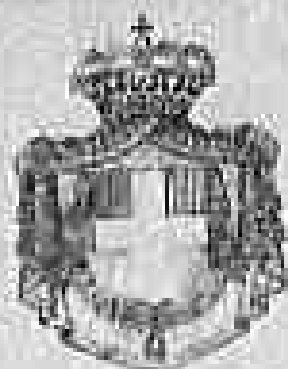

There are in this Province upwards of 300 persons of South Tyrolian origin who have been since 1939 extremely active in contra-nazi work. During the period of war they have been operating with O.S.S. and at the direction of the S.O.I. and have sent over the border into Switzerland a great deal of information regarding the activities of German Army which has been very valuable to the allied cause.

In addition they conducted many sabotage activities and generally speaking, they have been very useful in bringing about the successful conclusion to the military operations in this country.

At present they are engaged in pickung up SS-deserters and have within the last 2 months apprehended 50 of these people during which time they have suffered two killed in their ranks.

In the total operation to date they have suffered 50 dead and a considerable number of wounded.

Now the question comes up as to recognize the service of this group for they have conducted themselves in a manner far more valuable than the usual patriots.

To my mind they are entitled to Alexander-Certificates and to money benefits which go with them. Of course, such certificates need to be converted and possibly put in German language for these people are all South Tyrolian.

Therefore I would like an expression of opinion from you as to how to procede to reward these people at the earliest possible moment.

The head of the movement is Mr. Egarter who will be responsible for the production of an authentic list of the persons authorized to receive a recognition.

1. Col. Cripps explained that he had several points that he wished to get straight regarding Patriots in the North. The first problem related to these individuals returning from other countries, stating that they have been doing underground work on Patriot activities. They are turning up in some of the Patriot Centres and demanding pay as Patriots. Col. Cripps said he would like to know what the Italian Government had in mind with respect to such people. Do they agree that Italian nationals returning from other countries were not entitled to Patriot payments, etc.?
2. Sig. MOSCONI said he agreed. He went on to say that the problem needed an adequate solution, and said he thought there should be a clause of reciprocity included that those subjects who were members of foreign formations should receive the same treatment as Italian Patriots.
3. Sig. MOSCONI further stated that it was his understanding that a directive had been issued covering this point by Patriot HQ in the North; this allowed payment to foreign nationals serving with Patriot Bands in Italy and outlined the procedure to be adopted with regard to such individuals.
4. Col. Cripps stated that the Garibaldi Division had disbanded and were coming into the province of Udine from Yugoslavia, where they have an official stand-down parade day after tomorrow. It was understood that they were practically all serving at the time of the Armistice, and it was intended to pay them at their military rates for the period of time they were serving. Col. Cripps said he did not think they should also be paid as Patriots for the same period of time. This will be an exception to the decision NOT to pay

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5. Sig. MOSCONI stated that technically, if any compensation should be paid, it should be paid by the Yugoslav Government. But if they were not going to pay them, then the Patriots should have their compensation from the Italian Government.

6. Col. Cripps stated he was anxious to know what would happen with INPRs in the end.
7. Sig. MOSCONI stated that concerning INPRs., the Chief of Cabinet of the Ministry of Occupied Italy had informed Col. Pava that, following arrangements and discussions between SCOCCHIARELLI and the Under-Secretary of the new Ministry for Post War Assistance, they decided that the whole assistance of Patriots should be transferred from the former Ministry of Occupied Italy to the new Ministry for Post War Assistance. Therefore, the INPRs will become a part of the Assistance Ministry and will weigh on that budget, while their payment may be transferred to the jurisdiction of the Ministry for Post War Assistance and would weigh on what is left of the funds which have been appropriated originally by the Ministry of Occupied Italy for assistance purposes.
8. It was agreed that Sig. MOSCONI should inquire of the Ministry of War whether or not the instructions issued by them to A.N.P.I. on 15 May 1945 were actually in effect and being followed, or whether they were still under discussion.

1. When dispersing Patriot Bands one comes across the occasional German deserter who has been fighting with the patriots against the German Army. Can instructions please be issued as to the disposal of such persons. It is obviously not desirable that they should be interned with surrendered Germans.
2. The number concerned is not believed to be very large, but a band operating in Piemonte under one EDUARDO, is said to have a number. Enquiries are on foot as to the number in his band, but no answer has as yet been received.
3. Leaders of patriot bands are being informed that they may supply German deserters with written evidence of their "patriot" service for production to CIC or FBI.

When in TURIN the Chief Administrative Officer, AFHQ was approached by one "Eduardo", a commander of the partisans, who told him that he had amongst his partisans a considerable number of Germans who had been fighting with the partisans for about a year after deserting from the German Army. He understood that these had to be handed over to the Allied authorities for internment and was loathe to do so unless they could be given some document ensuring preferential treatment and an early return to GERMANY.

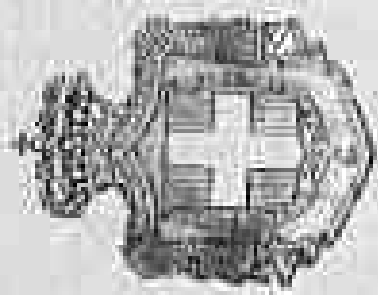

VERBAL NOTE

- 1) Obtain from C.I.N.A.I. (Milano) a full list of Soviet Citizen partisans.
- 2) Ensure that partisan brigades will issue to each soviet partisan, a personal identification booklet or another document showing the activities which they have carried out, a copy of which shall be sent to the Ministry of Occupied Italy.
- 3) Obtain a list of all soviet partisans who died in action, stating the place of burial, and all other information available, which should be passed to their families through the Russian Embassy in Italy (Military Attache').
- 4) Refrain from disarming soviet partisans who wish to return to Russia? armed, more so because their arms are war booty.
- 5) Where repatriation of soviet citizens who are partisan officers might harm the exigencies of the services, priority should be given to other russian partisans whose repatriation should be recommended to the Russian Embassy, <sup>in</sup> ~~an~~ agreement with Allied Commission.
