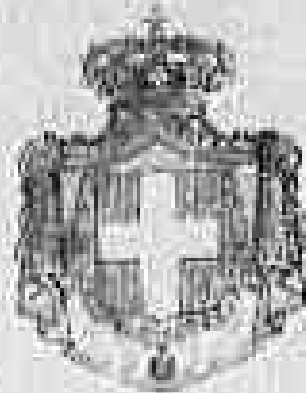

A copy of your letter No. 4545 dated 9 October has been received at this HQ. The following is in answer to the points raised in your letter.

1. Italians who fought as Partisans in France, Austria and elsewhere (except the Belgians) will be documented and recommendations made as to whether they should be recognized as Patriots or not. (See this HQ letter 166/1/PAT of 28 September para 4). Bonuses will be paid as laid down in the above quoted letter paras 4 and 5. No other payments are authorized.
2. So far as persons in need are concerned your attention is drawn to this HQ letter 121/6/PAT of 5 Oct. enclosing copy letter from Ministry of Post War Aid No. W 121/Q/5 of 27 September 45 which clearly sets out the conditions and documents required for helping a person in need.
3. Military personnel returning from concentration camps in Germany should be treated as Military and as such will receive back pay from the Ministry of War. They will not receive Patriot bonus. Your attention is drawn to paras 4 (a) and (b), 6 (a) and 10 of letter 166/1/PAT of 28 September 45. If however these personnel are not genuine Military personnel their cases must be examined and determined according to the present rules laid down for recognizing Patriots. If they are not patriots, then no authority exists for paying patriot bonuses to relatives of deceased soldiers.
4. The above mentioned letter is disquieting as it disclosed a lack of acquaintance with the instructions issued by this Headquarters.
5. The following instructions on Policy have recently been issued for the use of IMRs.

1. Italians who fought as Partisans in France, Austria and elsewhere (except the Balkans) will be documented and recommendations made as to whether they should be recognized as Patriots or not. (See this HQ letter 166/1/PAT of 28 September para 4). Bonuses will be paid as laid down in the above quoted letter paras 5a and 8. No other payments are authorized.
2. So far as persons in need are concerned your attention is drawn to this HQ letter 121/6/PAT of 5 Oct. enclosing copy letter from Ministry of Post War Aid No. M 1240/5 of 27 September 45 which clearly sets out the conditions and documents required for helping a person in need.
3. Military personnel returning from concentration camps in Germany should be treated as Military and as such will receive back pay from the Ministry of War. They will not receive Patriot bonus. Your attention is drawn to paras 4 (a) and (b), 6 (a) and 10 of letter 166/1/PAT of 28 September 45. If however these personnel are not genuine Military personnel their cases must be examined and determined according to the present rules laid down for recognizing Patriots. If they are not patriots, then no authority exists for paying patriot bonuses to relatives of deceased soldiers.

MILANO, 9 October 1945

This office has received your instructions and assures you that it will keep to them scrupulously. However, we wish to point out that the instructions neither solve nor remove the doubts and the questions we have often expressed to the Italian and Allied Authorities.

There is no mention of Italians who have fought as partisans in France, in Austria and in Italy south of the Gothic line. As we have received applications from the persons concerned and from their relatives, we request you to examine these cases still further and issue more precise instructions for the same.

The same circular specified moreover that every office is to extend its jurisdiction only to the Patriots belonging to formations which have operated or have been demobilized in the region or province under the jurisdiction of each "I.M.P.R.". We should like to point out the serious difficulties arising from these instructions.

Before receiving the above-mentioned circular, all the patriots offices followed the system of paying the bonuses to the person concerned, whether the patriot or relatives of fallen soldiers. Under this system the offices requested confirmation of the activity carried out by each patriot from the offices in the corresponding zones. This system required only one official letter and one document and did not give too much trouble to the person concerned.

With the new system the task of the offices is not in the least facilitated, since the offices have still to issue the authorization as in the past and moreover no office at the present moment could proceed to issue an authorization without first certifying that the person applying has not already made an application in the locality of this residence. This system also provides almost unsurmountable difficulties for the persons applying, since their presence is often required in order to certify the qualifications for applications before issuing the authorization for the bonuses and for many other reasons.

We think it more desirable therefore to continue, at least for the present, under the old system, at least as regards wounded and fallen patriots, in order to avoid further delay in the operations, which might cause discontent among the persons concerned who are

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We think it more desirable therefore to continue, at least for the present, under the old system, at least as regards wounded and fallen patriots, in order to avoid further delay in the operations, which might cause discontent among the persons concerned who are as a rule of the poorer and needier classes.

We request you therefore to re-examine the matter and give instructions with the greatest possible speed.

There is another question on which we should like to have more precise instructions:

- 1) Are the fifty thousand lire for patriots in hospital to be paid only for the period of insurrection, i.e. from 25 April, or extended, as we think just, to the whole period of the republican government, for wounds received during the clandestine struggle before the insurrection?
- 2) Whether the allotment can be paid to wounded patriots who have been put out of hospital but who are still undergoing special attention which leaves them totally disabled. We should like to point out that such cases are very frequent as the hospitals are unable to take all the wounded and keep them until they have been thoroughly cured and reached the stage of convalescence.
- 3) Are the wounded to be declared temporarily disabled, and if so what allowance is to be paid him during the period of convalescence.

Lastly we should like to have instructions regarding soldiers who have returned from concentration camps in Germany, where they have been wounded or fallen ill. This office has already been paying the bonus of twenty thousand lire to the relatives of soldiers who have died in these camps whenever it has been possible to ascertain without doubt that their arrest and subsequent internment was due to political or partisan activity.

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Infatti, in base alle disposizioni ed alla prassi adottata da tutti gli uffici patriotti prima che venissero le disposizioni di cui alla circolare in esame, si era adottato il principio, per la determinazione della competenza, - per i patrioti non smobilitati con le loro formazioni - per cause diverse non presenti alla formazione al momento della smobilitazione - del pagamento del premio "4884" della persona interessata, patriota e famigliari dei caduti. Adottando il nuovo criterio, non si viene per nulla ad agevolare o facilitare il compito degli uffici, poiché questi inevitabilmente dovranno continuare a richiedere ed a rilasciare nulla-osta, come per il passato, in quanto dopo quattro mesi già per molti si è provveduto alla liquidazione, appunto seguendo le disposizioni che basavano la competenza degli uffici sulla residenza civile degli interessati e, quindi, ogni ufficio nel momento attuale non potrebbe proce-

dere ad alcun pagamento senza essersi prima assicurato che l'ufficio ove l'interessato ha la propria residenza non abbia dato corso ad alcuna liquidazione. Inoltre, tale provvedimento crea difficoltà pressochè insuperabili per gli interessati. Your letter 166/1/PAT of 3 Oct and circular even number dated 28 Sept 45 is acknowledged. The matter in para 8 should be settled as follows:

The payment of bonuses of 1000 and 5000 Lire are suspended until the time when the Regional Committees instituted by DLL 518 of 21 August have fixed definitely who is entitled to be recognised as a Patriot. However, IMPRs may pay an amount non superior to 5000 lire to those who are in serious need if:

- 1) It has been ascertained that the applicant is entitled to be recognised as combatant Patriot according to Art 7 of DLL 518 of 21 August;
- 2) If the applicant is in serious need which can be proved by a distress-warrant issued by the Commune where he is residing;
- 3) The applicant should make a statement to be in possession of the necessary qualification fixed by DLL 518 of 21 Aug N.518; he should be warned that he is responsible for false statements.

Such payments are to be considered as anticipations drawn upon the bonus of 5000 Lire to which according to DLL N.421 of 20 June 45 the combatant partisans are entitled.

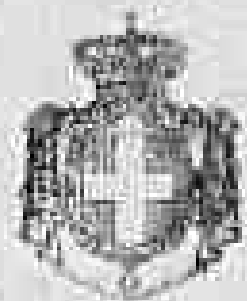

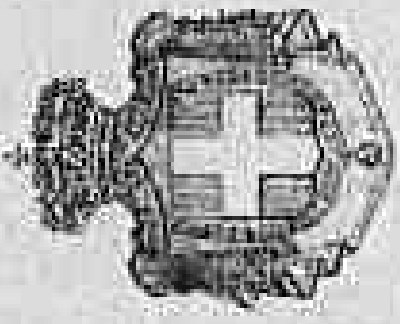

between

COL CRIPPS AND SIG. BERNARDINONE AND SIG. MOSCONI

on 6th September at 1100 hrs.

Col. CRIPPS desired to raise the question of treatment of Patriots who fought outside Italy and referred to a letter from the Ministry No 886 dated 29th August. One point he wished to be clear about was the statement concerning persons returning from the Balkans as soldiers. He read it to mean that all fighters coming from the Balkans should be considered as members of the Italian Army and therefore not entitled to any demobilisation bonus they will receive arrears of pay as soldiers.

Sig. BERNARDINONE agreed on this point of view and stated that the Minister has already expressed similar views on this point.

Col. CRIPPS said he would issue that instruction but said there might be exceptional cases of Italians who fought outside Italy (with the Maquis etc). In these cases he suggested that the facts and particulars of each case should be collected and passed to the Ministry of PWA for final decision.

Sig. BERNARDINONE agreed that special cases should be put up for decision by the MPWA.

Col. CRIPPS mentioned that he had forwarded two cases. One concerned 10 Italian soldiers who would be dealt with as soldiers and not as Patriots. The other concerned two men who claimed to have been fighting in YUGOSLAVIA as Patriots. They were soldiers and had already been paid the bonuses due to them as soldiers. Quoting from the letter Col. Cripps stated that it said that for the time being all coming from abroad should not be considered Patriots.

Suggest a screening Commission and if that was a success then it could investigate all claims.

Sig. BERNARDINONE had not much idea as to the number of patriots in V.G. but thought it better to wait until Col. CRIPPS returned from his visit and get his views.

Col. CRIPPS It is agreed that no letter be sent meantime. I will try and persuade Col. Bowman to allow an IMPR to operate in the Region.

Discussed choice of man suitable for the post. It is better that he should know local conditions rather than be an expert on Patriot matters.

Col. CRIPPS Was going to raise the question of AMPL. Sig. MOSCONI handed Col. Cripps a memorandum which he proposed to study, first, and raise at the next meeting.

Sig. BERNARDINONE Spoke about his visit to the North and said there is a difference between AMPL of the North and AMPL of the South. The difference appears to be one of programmes. He feels that one set of instructions would not be suitable meantime but later on it will become a National affair. The two branches act independently but decide together.

Col. CRIPPS I have no other point.

Sig. BERNARDINONE Spoke about hospital in Trento and showed two letters he had received from the IMPR in which he stated that the Sanatorium at AICO is not going to be used for military purposes and therefore should be considered available. He will send us copies of the letters. L. 1,000,000 has been allocated for the hospital and Mr. CHIABOFF thought this was sufficient until the end of October.

Col. CRIPPS Said he will speak with the Regional Commissioner of VA on the subject.

Sig. BERNARDINONE Stated that hospitalisation is the subject of special care from the Ministry of PWA without any distinction between patriots veterans or ex-internees. The point of view of the Ministry is not to have different kind of hospitals for patriots, veterans and so forth but to have hospitals well equipped for everybody in need of medical treatment. He said that convalescent centres are to be organised.

Sig. BERNARDINONE Said that during his visit to Milan AMPL had informed him that they intended to publish a newspaper but Col. Poletti had not granted permission.

Col. CRIPPS I will try and find out why permission was refused. I will ask De Carston about this point.

1. The last sentence of para c and d. should be deleted. Instead IMPRs should be instructed to keep the documents and investigations ready to be presented to the Commission to be formed according to art. 2 of D.L.L. n. 518 dated 21 August (G.U. n. 109 of 11 Sep 45)
2. An analogous instruction should substitute the last sentence of para c and f.
3. It should be added that in case of Italian civilians whom fought outside Italy IMPRs after having checked that these are effectively entitled to be recognised as "combatant partisans" according to para 7 of the above D.L.L. might pay the following bonuses:
 - L. 20,000 for the families of the dead
 - L. 10,000 for seriously wounded partisans.
 - ~~L. 5,000 for those who are in particular need.~~

In case of those who are entitled to L. 5,000 but are not in the above conditions and in every doubtful case the IMPRs will not pay the bonuses until the Commission (see para 2 of the above D.L.L.) has not pronounced its judgment.

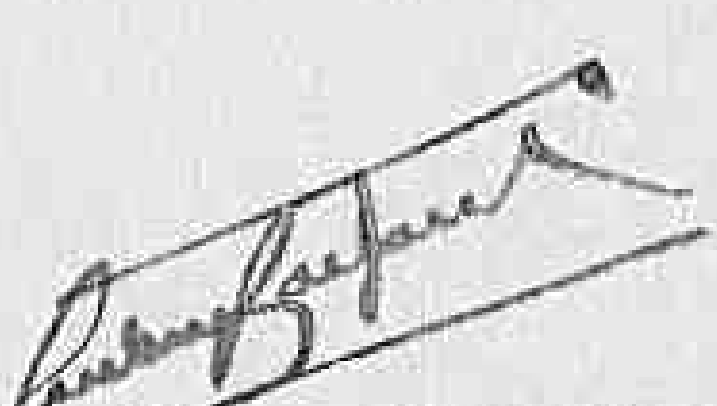

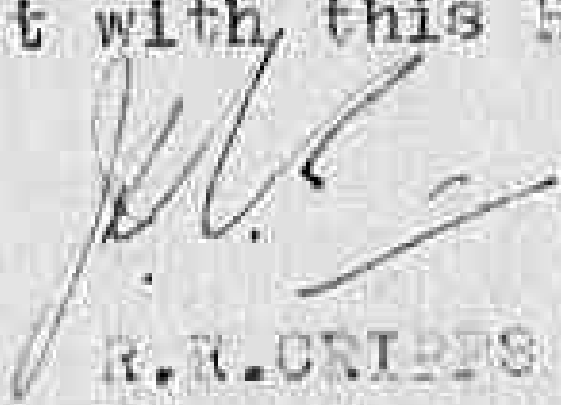

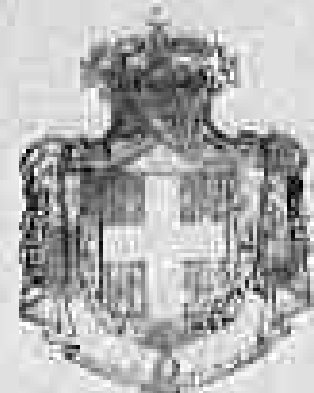

"The partisan elements who were members of partisan formations operating in the Balcanes are considered by the Ministry of War to all administrative effects as military personnel: the demobilization bonus is not due to them as they are getting from the above Ministry all the arrears due to members of military units.

The demobilization bonus however is due to:

"Patriots of foreign nationality who fought for the Italian cause;

to patriots of the Venezia Giulia if their documents are according to the rules set out for the assignment of the bonus (further issue of the assistance booklet) and on which the payment of the bonus will be annotated. However, AMG will on an early date organize in the Venezia Giulia a Patriots Office which will be responsible (effective from the date to be communicated) to pay the indemnities for the patriots of this Region.

It would be appreciated if a copy would be sent of your letter to the IMPRs on the above subject. If the letter should be routed to IMPRs, we send for information to this Ministry.

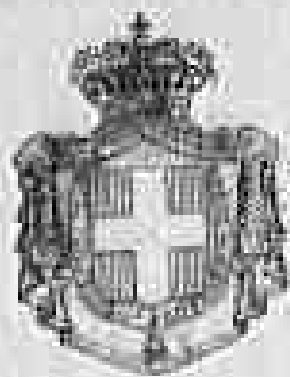

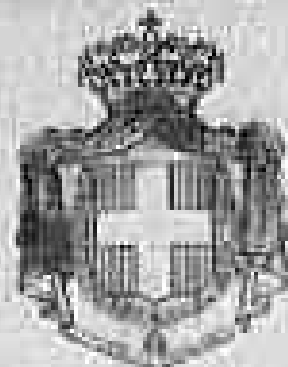

Mr. Tartaglione was an information agent and took part in the liberation of Shjak and Tirana. After the occupation of Tirana he joined the +Italian circle "Garibaldi" created in Tirana.

After two months he left the service owing to his bad health. On 30 May he left Tirana.

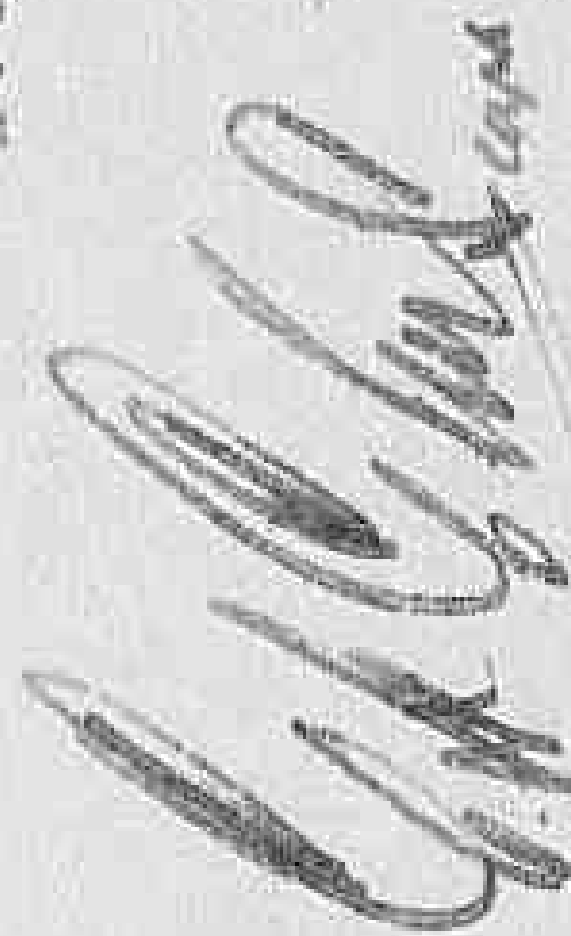

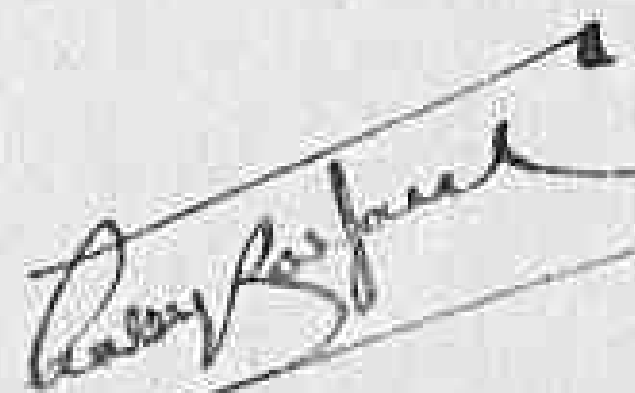

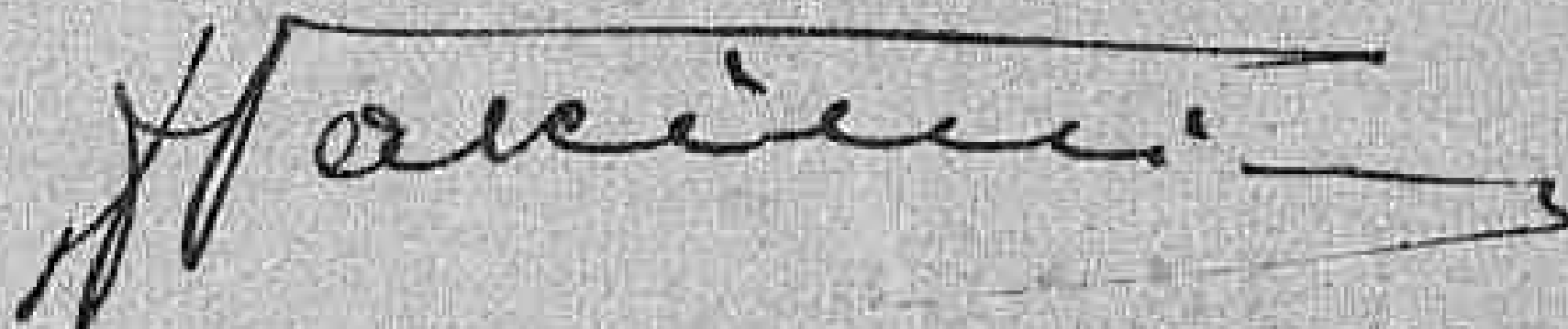

1. Many servicemen of the above named division, returning from the Balkans, are sent by the Military District to this office in order to obtain bonuses or assistance.
2. This office cannot take into consideration these requests, and this has a bad influence upon the applicants who do not see any answer to their problems.
3. It would be useful if precise directives could be issued to the Military Districts laying down the treatment which should be granted these servicemen or, alternatively, we should be put in a position to help the worst cases.
4. In the provinces a committee to aid the Veterans should function, but unfortunately all Veterans have no other way open to them than applying through this office.
5. Also the next of kin of those who have been shot by the nazi-fascists, who did not belong to patriots formations claim a bonus or a subvention and this office is unable to assist as present directives do not grant them any subvention (no matter how small).
6. I believe that it is necessary to obtain some directives from the competent Ministry, in order that this office which is the only Patriot Office in the Province can also help the next of kin of those who have been shot by the nazi-fascists and who were not partisans.
Such aid could be established by a committee appointed by the prefect or by any other body established by the Ministry, after due scrutiny of the applications.
7. Needy persons and those who have suffered from the brutal actions of the nazi-fascists, could become a menace for the Nation.

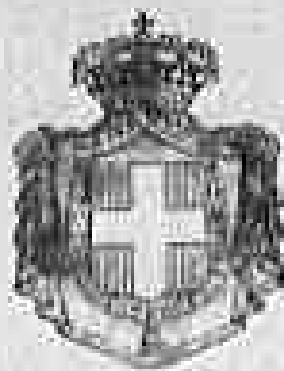

MOOI has informed me that in agreement with PWA and Ministry of War it has been decided that Patriots who have fought abroad in Italian and foreign bands will receive the same bonuses and assistance as those who have operated in Italy, and that the members of the "Divisione Garibaldi" will NOT receive the bonuses because this Division has been considered as "gruppo di combattimento" (fighting group) as the Legnano, Friuli, Folgore etc.

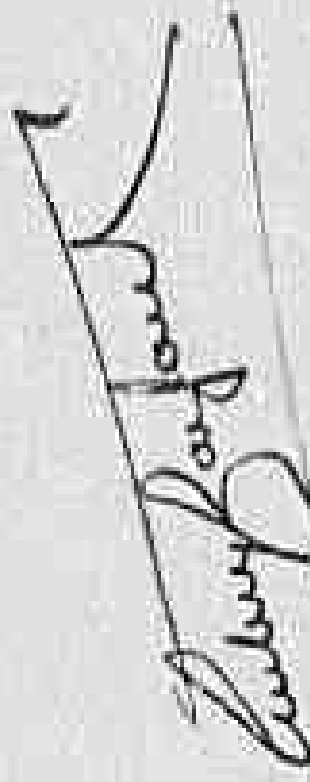

Extract of Monthly (Citizen Report 1/30th June 45 of Senior
Patriot Officer, 5th Army.

A special camp has been set up at De-Medosa for a thousand Partisans who have come in from Switzerland. These men have been fighting in the mountains with the French Maqui. They will be paid and issued with certificates and gradually dispersed to their homes. It is of interest to note that in this Region the Italian military authorities informed the Regional Patriot Officer that they were prepared to take up to 1,500 Patriots into the Italian Army as volunteers.

Note Lt Col Rinung stated during his visit to Patriots' Branch on 13 July, that the Partisans in question had operated on Italy, before going into Switzerland & that the Italian Band Commanders had reached for them.

1. COL. Grigore explained that he had several points that he wished to get straight regarding Patriotes in the North. The first problem related to these individuals returning from other countries, stating that they have been doing underground work on Patriot activities. They are turning up in some of the Patriot Centers and demanding pay as Patriots. COL. Grigore said he would like to know what the Italian Government had in mind with respect to such people. Do they agree that Italian nationals returning from other countries were not entitled to Patriot reputation, etc.?
2. SIG. MEXICOTI said he agreed. He went on to say that the problem needed an adequate solution, and said he thought there should be a clause of reciprocity included that those subjects who were members of foreign formations should receive the same treatment as Italian Patriots.
3. SIG. MEXICOTI further stated that it was his understanding that a directive had been issued covering this point by Minister HQ in the North. This allowed payment to foreign nationals serving with Patriot Bands in Italy and outlined the procedure to be adopted with regard to such individuals.
4. COL. Grigore stated that the Carabinieri Division had disbanded and were coming into the provinces of Udine from Udineville, where they have an official stand-down parade day after tomorrow. It was understood that they were practically all serving at the time of the Armistice, and it was intended to pay them at their military rates for the period of time they were serving. COL. Grigore said he did not think they should also be paid as Patriots for the same period of time. This will be an exception to the decision not to pay

6. Col. Grippa stated he was anxious to know what would happen with funds in the end.

7. Sig. MARONI stated that concerning TIRRE, the Chief of Cabinet of the Ministry of Occupied Italy had informed Col. Zava that, following arrangements and discussions between ROCCAMONTE and the Under-Secretary of the new Ministry for Post War Assistance, they decided that the whole assistance of Palermo should be transferred from the former Ministry of Occupied Italy to the new Ministry for Post War Assistance. Therefore, the DIME will become a part of the Assistance Ministry and will weigh on that budget, while their payments may be transferred to the jurisdiction of the Ministry for Post War Assistance and would weigh on what is left of the funds which have been appropriated originally by the Ministry of Occupied Italy for assistance purposes.

8. It was agreed that Sig. MARONI should inquire of the Ministry of War whether or not the instructions issued by them to A.N.P.I. on 15 May 1945 were actually in effect and being followed, or whether they were still under discussion.

PAY OF PATRIOTS DURING THE WAR OF LIBERATION

Copy of instructions issued by Ministry of War to A.N.P.I. on 15 May 45.

1)- The following provisions have been adopted in connection with those partisans who have taken active action against the Germans:

- a) partisans who were on active military service on 8.9.1943:
 - (i) service with partisan formations during the period of underground resistance against the Germans, will be considered as active operational service;
 - (ii) full, war economic treatment (including operational indemnity and ration allowance) will be granted, for the total period of the underground war;
 - (iii) to next of kin of patriots fallen during the liberation war, payment of the "presenti alle Bandiere" economic treatment (this includes full war pay up to the end of the war) besides the payment of privileged war pensions;

b) patriots who were not on active service on 8.9.1943, will be entitled to:

- (i) administrative parification (operational indemnity and ration allowance) according to their functions within partisan formations and corresponding to the following ranks of the regular army:

capo banda	= Captain
vice capo banda	= Lieutenant
capo gruppo	= W.O.
capo nucleo	= Sergeant
capo squadra	= Corporal
patriot without rank	= Pte Soldier

- (ii) the next of kin of patriots fallen during the liberation war will be entitled to the economic treatment mentioned in para a) (ii) w.e.f 1 Oct. 43 until the date of death.

- (iii) wounded patriots will be hospitalised free of charge in military hospitals.

= The above provisions require investigation of the activities of the qualification of the patriots. Such investigations were formerly carried out by the Patriot Office at the Presidency of the Council, who notified this Ministry of the results. The committee instituted with D.L.L. 5/4/1945 n. 158 published in the Gazzetta Ufficiale n. 53 of 2/5/1945 is now responsible for this matter. Pending the implementation of the decree and the appointment of the committee, the practical action required is temporarily delayed. In order to avoid this, it has been requested that the appointment of the committee should be hastened.

c) Assistance during the war to partisan formations operating in the lines with the Allies and beyond the lines.

- (i) Funds will be assigned to the units in the lines of the 5 and 8 Armies front in order to institute the unit funds and to pay individual bonuses to patriots.

- resistance against the Germans, will be considered as active operational service;
- (ii) full, war economic treatment (including operational indemnity and ration allowance) will be granted, for the total period of the underground war;
- (iii) to next of kin of patriots fallen during the liberation war, payment of the "presenti alle Bandiere" economic treatment (this includes full war pay up to the end of the war) besides the payment of privileged war pensions;

Other amounts collected by dependent Headquarters are awaited and will be handed over to Ministry of Occupied Italy.

2)- The following legislature is being prepared:

- (i) legislative provision by which all those who were not on active service on 8.9.1943 and who took part in the underground war, will receive all the advantages granted to members of the regular forces. Patriots who fell in the war will be considered fully equivalent to combat service troops and their next of kin will receive all provisions mentioned in para a) (iii).
- (ii) Legislative provision granting temporary recognition as regular army ranks to those ranks held in patriot formations, corresponding to the size of the patriot unit commanded during the war against nazi-fascists.
- (iii) Legislative provision for the award of the "croce al merito di guerra" (lowest military decoration) to combatant patriots.

Ora invece è competente al riguardo la Commissione istituita con il D.L. 5.4.1945 n. 158 (pubblicato nella Gazzetta Ufficiale n. 53 del 2.5.1945); in attesa dell'applicazione del decreto e della costituzione della Commissione, l'attuazione concreta dei provvedimenti sopra indicati ha subito una forzata temporanea sospensione. Allo scopo di eliminare questo inconveniente e' già stata sollecitata la nomina della Commissione;

- b) per i patrioti che alla data dell'8.9.1945 non erano in servizio militare:
- equiparazione ai fini amministrativi (soprasoldo operazioni intiero e razione viveri in contanti), in base alle funzioni svolte in seno alle formazioni partigiane, ai seguenti gradi della gerarchia militare:

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- c) assistenza, durante la guerra, alle formazioni di patrioti operanti sulle linee con gli alleati e oltre le linee, in particolare:
- assegnazione di somme alle formazioni in linea sul fronte della Sa. 9
 - Sa. Armata per costituire fondi di reparto e per corrispondere premi individuali;
 - istituzioni di posti avanzati di raccolta patrioti nella zona avanzata delle armate;
 - libera sottoscrizione "pro patrioti" presso i reparti dell'Esercito; sono state raccolte e versate al Ministero dell'Interno Occidente L. 1.669.150,05.

Si attendono ancora somme raccolte dai Comandi dipendenti e che saranno ugualmente versate al predetto Ministero. /.
