SUBJECT: Motor Vehicles and Gasoline Conservation

TO : All heads of Sub-Gen Isairns, Sections, Branches,
R.C.A.G., Region I.

Requisitioned civilian ~~passenger~~ motor vehicles, (not load-carrying vehicles) now in use by AGF-AGC personnel on the Island of Sicily will be returned to owners or custodians, effective immediately, unless such surrender will be seriously detrimental to vital projects. Vehicles it is found necessary to retain under above exception will be reported to this Headquarters on or before 5 Dec. 1943 by letter stating the necessity for their retention and the type of vehicle.

2. Effective immediately no additional civilian ~~passenger~~ motor vehicles will be requisitioned by AGC personnel without prior approval of this Headquarters.

3. Civilian ~~passenger~~ vehicles, requisitioned or seized on this basis, shall not hereafter be used for any purely personal transport, i.e., from billet to office, office to mess, vice versa, or for any other than official mission.

4. Motor vehicles released in accordance with paragraph 1 will be delivered to headquarters garages, (A or B), Palermo. Details of all known facts concerning vehicle will be made the subject of letter to this Headquarters, and will include (a) make, (b) model, (c) body type, (d) license or permit number, (e) owners name, (f) source from which obtained, (g) date obtained, (h) serial number, sub-section or branch retaining, (i) other known facts which may assist in return of vehicle.

5. Captured stocks of gasoline are rapidly becoming exhausted and drastic reductions have been made in allotment of gasoline to AGF-AGC, effective 1 Dec. It is necessary that utmost conservation be exercised to reduce use of gasoline.

MEMORANDUM: Port Officers

TO : A.C.A. - Regions I & II

1. As the result of a conference with movement representatives of A.P.A.C., it is directed that an AAG Port Officer be appointed in each port city listed below. In most cases these assignments will be made from the Civilian Supply Officers in the region. It is not contemplated that the duties of a Port Officer in the smaller ports will in all cases require his full time and, therefore, the assignment in such cases can be treated as an additional duty for the officers selected.

2. The duties of the AAG Port Officer will be as follows:

a. To maintain close liaison with all port agencies, military, naval and civilian.

b. To follow the movement of all ships with civilian cargoes to and from his port. He will be supplied with information concerning the expected time of arrival of ships carrying civilian cargoes in each port city. If such a ship enters his port which is destined for some other port, he must make arrangements for the onward movement of the AAG supplies which are in it.

c. To report all movements of civilian supplies in and out of the port which are not in accordance with the port instructions received by him.

d. To supervise the loading and unloading of civilian goods at his port, maintaining accurate accounts of the goods shipped and received.

e. To arrange for the warehousing and proper disposition of civilian goods awaiting shipment and of goods unloaded.

f. Upon request, to prepare and send through channels the necessary information to enable higher AAG authority to ascertain where cargoes are at any given moment.

g. To assist in the separation of unloaded cargoes intended for military or naval use from those intended for civilian use.

3. The Port Officer will be a representative of the Industry and Commerce Subcommittee and will be responsible through the A.C.A.C. in the normal manner. However, he will, upon request, assist the Shipping Commission in the performance of duties in and around the port.

4. The primary duty of the Port Officer is concerned at present with imports of civilian goods directly from the Allied Governments. However, as far as possible, Port Officers should also keep in touch with civilian cargoes moving between two or more Italian ports and civilian cargoes imported from nations other than Allied Nations.

SECRET Screening of Italian Nationals

1. Regional Civil Affairs Officers (Regions I and II)

1. This directive indicates the policy for screening Italian Nationals which will be carried out by all Regions.

2. The screening will be the responsibility of the Regional Civil Affairs Officers. The will be assigned to eliminate officials of the following categories:

- (a) Fascist and anti-fascist;
- (b) Those who have actively helped the enemy;
- (c) Those potentially dangerous to the security of the Allied Armed Forces or to Allied Government administration;
- (d) Racist resisters;

3. Unless such officials have already been investigated as to the satisfaction of the S.C.A.O., the following measures will be taken:

4. The S.C.A.O. will prepare a list "A" classifying the names of officials and a list "B" classifying the minor officials who are to be screened. A guide to classification is attached (Appendix I) which may be adapted according to any special regional requirements.

5. The S.C.A.O. will distribute, through his S.C.A.O.s and S.C.A.O.s, Schedule to the approved form (Appendix II) to be completed by the Italian officer is concerned and returned by them to the Italian S.C.A.O. Officials of Schedule are identified in request from this S.C.A.O. or may be printed by Regions, provided that no alteration is made to the standard form.

6. The completed forms will be forwarded to the S.C.A.O., who, after consultation with the S.C.A.O. and local Security Services such as S.C.A.O. or S.C.A.O., will endorse this recommendation and forward the form to the S.C.A.O., who will act as follows:

- (a) In the case of the minor officials (List "B") who are not members of a National Agency such as the S.C.A.O. Postal Services, S.C.A.O. or S.C.A.O., will decide whether or not they remain in office. If, in his opinion they should be dismissed, the consent of the head of the appropriate specialist or technical division of the region must be obtained (i.e., if the S.C.A.O. is of the opinion that an Italian transport official should be removed for any of the reasons specified above, he should submit the consent of the S.C.A.O. or S.C.A.O. to the S.C.A.O. or S.C.A.O. for approval. 115
- (b) In the case of minor officials who are members of a National Agency, the S.C.A.O. may decide to retain them in office, but, if in his opinion they should be dismissed, the consent of the head of the appropriate specialist or technical division of the region must be obtained (i.e., if the S.C.A.O. is of the opinion that an Italian transport official should be removed for any of the reasons specified above, he should submit the consent of the S.C.A.O. or S.C.A.O. to the S.C.A.O. or S.C.A.O. for approval. 115

10 4. Confidential Source Material (Paragraphs 1 and 2)

1. This directive mandates the policy of screening all individuals which will be carried out by all Agents.

2. The screening will be the responsibility of the S.C.A.O. and will be signed to eliminate officials of the following categories:

- (a) Agents and field sympathizers
- (b) Those who have actively helped the enemy
- (c) Those potentially dangerous to the security of the United States
- (d) Those who are involved in movement administration
- (e) Executive resistance

3. Unless such officials have already been investigated in the establishment of the S.C.A.O., the following resolution will be adopted:

4. The S.C.A.O. will prepare a list of all individuals in the above categories and a list for classifying the same. Officials who are to be "screened" will be classified in accordance with the following (Appendix I) which may be adapted according to any special regional requirements.

5. The S.C.A.O. will distribute, through the S.C.A.O. and S.C.A.O. Agents, in the approved form (Appendix II) to be completed by the Italian office, is concerned and returned by them to the Italian, S.C.A.O. Supplies of Agents are distributed on request from the S.C.A.O. or may be obtained by Agents, provided that no alteration is made to the standard form.

6. The completed form will be forwarded to the S.C.A.O. and, after consultation with the S.C.A.O. and local Security Services such as the S.C.A.O. or S.C.A.O., will enforce his recommendation and forward the form to the S.C.A.O. who will act as follows:

- (a) In the case of the Italian (last year) who are not members of a national agency such as the S.C.A.O. Postal Service, Italy Services, decide whether or not they remain in office. **115**
- (b) In the case of minor officials who are members of a national agency, the S.C.A.O. may decide to retain them in office, but, if in his opinion they should be dismissed, the consent of the head of the appropriate specialist or technical division at Regional II, must be obtained (i.e., if the S.C.A.O. is of the opinion that an Italian Transport official should be removed for any of the reasons specified above, he should obtain the consent of the Chief Transport officer at Regional II, before taking steps to dismiss the official). In the event of disagreement between the S.C.A.O. and the head of the Division, or in the absence of such a decision, the final decision will be made by the S.C.A.O.
- (c) In the case of Major Officials (List I), the S.C.A.O. will submit recommendation as a further endorsement on the recommendation approved by the S.C.A.O. and S.C.A.O., and will report it to the S.C.A.O. at Regional II. The Chief Public Safety Officer, in consultation with the Chief of Special Police, such as Military Intelligence Services as may be available and with the Regional head of the technical division concerned will recommend to the S.C.A.O. whether the official ought to be retained.

deserve possible, the S.C. (Security Intelligence) office will be detailed from this post to coordinate the S.C. in the handling of such information as an advisor to the Chief of Staff and Director of Public Safety.

(4) In any case of notification of the S.C., the S.C. should refer the matter to the S.C. as the will proceed as outlined in (c).

7. The most senior Italian officials such as those who have been in provincial responsibilities, for example, Regional Officials, and all members of the Carabinieri and Guardia Finanza, may be dismissed by the S.C. only after such a decision has been confirmed by the S.C. In such instances in which together with the S.C.'s recommendation should be submitted for consideration. In accordance with the S.C. should the S.C. decide to retain such a person in office.

8. The members of the Declassified Central Italian Government posted in the S.C. are exempted from these requirements and will not therefore be subject to regional screening.

9. The S.C. officials should be reviewed for: filing at the Regional HQ, and those of the officials by the S.C. The files of any individual or class of official will be forwarded to this HQ with request.

10. The S.C. will inform this HQ:

- (a) date on which this screening plan is completed;
- (b) date of completion;
- (c) the results of the screening, including the total number and categories of officials seen and the date the screening was completed in office or dismissed.

ORDERS FOR THE SECURITY OF H.Q. AMGOT.General.

There are 5 British personnel who will act as Police for the security of the H.Q.

The Police will be situated at the entrance to H.Q. and on floors occupied by AMGOT personnel, and it is their duty to ensure that no unauthorized person enters the building.

All persons will be in possession of a pass, whether permanent or temporary, and will be required to produce it on demand by the Police.

Security of Offices

It is the duty of every officer to ensure that papers are locked away.

Most Secret files left on tables will always be the personal responsibility of an officer, who should be aware that he is in charge of the file once it is handed to him. If, therefore, there are only two officers in a room at any given time and one wishes to go out, leaving "Most Secret" files on his desk, he will inform the remaining officer that he is leaving the files out and place them in his charge. If all officers leave the room, then all files will either be locked up (highly desirable), or placed in charge of the Chief Clerk of the Division.

In general there should only be a limited number of files out at any one time. Each file when disposed of will be returned to the appropriate place. The presence on desks of a large number of files renders it most difficult for them to be adequately supervised.
