TO: HQAO, Region III ANG

1. British Film Unit Team will make a film on Military Administration in Italy incorporating reconstruction of some towns after heavy bombing. The film will be produced jointly with OWI. It will be used in Italy for PWB purposes.
2. It is stressed that the film will be a joint Anglo-American production for use by and available to both nations.
3. AMGO commands utmost assistance.
4. Three AMGO officers, Captain ARTHUR C. FLETCHER, Lieutenant JOHN F. F. PALMA, and Lieutenant GORDON LANG, will be accompanied by Captain WILLIAM HAINES, JR. of the Information Sub-Commission, A.M.G., and by Major T. L. ELLISON, AGO of Region IV, and until recently Deputy Director of this Information Sub-Commission. The party will have with it six EM/OR.
5. The party will conduct a reconnaissance of Region III, beginning on or about December 21.
6. The party will have its own transport and drivers.

1. Reference is made to the following messages concerning the A.F.U. team which is to make a film of military administration in Sicily and Italy.

Our message - 8768 of 18 October
Your message - B-387 of 3 November

Other communications in the series can be traced from these two messages.

2. Capt. Fletcher and Lt. Palmer left here by air for your Headquarters on 11 November; the three remaining members of the team, Lt. Lang, Sgt. Stuart, and Sgt. Burst arrived at Algiers by sea from U.K. on 27 November, and will be embarked for Syracuse on or about 3 December. Confirmation of date and L.T.A. will be notified later, but owing to the shipping position here it is impossible to transport the party to Palermo without a long delay.

3. As Lt. Lang and party have brought with them 1 ton of equipment including a number of large cases, it will be necessary to obtain a larger vehicle than the $\frac{1}{2}$ ton truck which it is understood is at present to be provided for the A.F.U. team. A check has been made and there is no doubt that the equipment cannot be loaded onto a $\frac{1}{2}$ ton truck.
