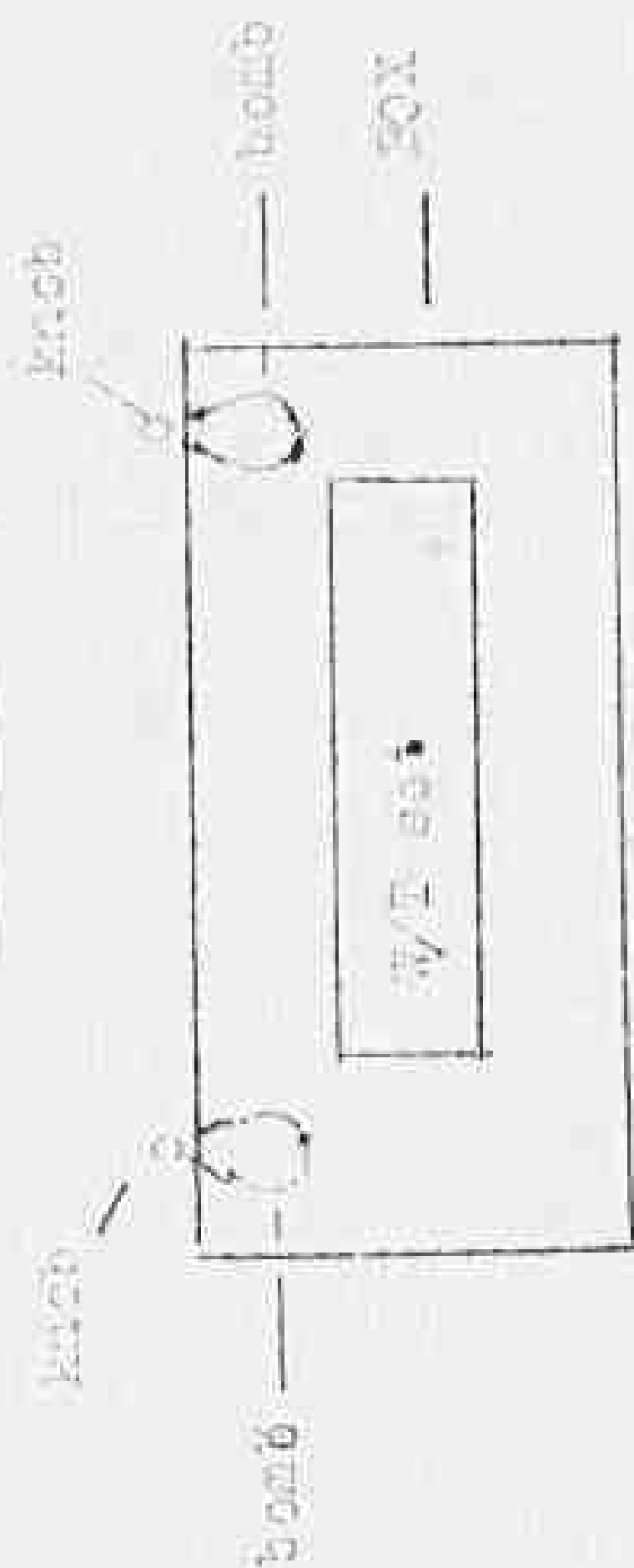

The following facts have been related by a reliable (Italian) person who can be named upon request:

1. It is common procedure at some Allied offices, especially those issuing permits (travel, transport etc.) to distribute numbers to the people queuing up in front of the office before the opening hour, giving the first person number one and so forth.
2. By the time the office opens for business sometimes a hundred or more persons are in the line. Then the usher, instead of having the person holding ticket Nr. 1 enter first, calls out: "Who has a letter of recommendation from Colonel Poletti", and the persons having such letters of recommendation are admitted first without consideration as to their position in the queue.
3. After all persons possessing these letters of recommendation have been admitted, the usher then asks the persons holding letters of recommendation issued by other Allied Officers to step forward.
4. After these have been taken care of, those persons with letters of recommendation from persons other than Allied Officers are admitted, so that sometimes persons not in possession of

-2-

a letter of recommendation have to wait all day and even to return the next day and wait all over again.

5. It is understood that upon bribing the usher with perhaps 500 Lire, it is always possible for a person without a letter of recommendation to be permitted to enter and see the Officer in charge.

6. In relation to the a/m procedure the following comment was made by another Italian (known Anti-fascist) : "We wanted so much to do anything useful to the Allies, and consider it part of our duties to respect regulations to the fullest extent, but it is made impossible for us to do so and we have to resort to fascist methods."

RECLASSIFICATION OF OFFICERS PHYSICALLY UNFIT
FOR GENERAL MILITARY SERVICE

Circular Number 33, Section II, Circular Number 181, and Section IV, Circular Number 220, this Headquarters, 1943, are rescinded and the following substituted therefor:

1. Definition of "Limited Service Officer" - A limited service officer is one who is disqualified under current physical standards for general military service, but who has been classified, following thorough physical examination, as physically fit for certain types of active military assignments commensurate with his physical qualifications.

2. a. Officers with physical defects may be assigned to limited service in this theater provided the defect is of a static nature, non-progressive, and not subject to the development of complications. Such defects include defective vision, defective hearing, dental defects, and static orthopedic conditions.

b. Officers who have such chronic conditions as to preclude their being considered for any military duty in this theater of operations will be evacuated to the United States through medical channels.

3. a. Change of classification of officers from general service to limited service will be made only upon the approved action of a General Hospital disposition board or disposition boards at 51st and 114th Station Hospitals as indicated herein. Disposition boards in recommending a limited service classification will state whether classification is permanent or temporary and if temporary the approximate date on which the officer should be re-examined with a view to reclassification to general service.

b. These instructions will not be so literally interpreted that the Army will be deprived of the services of capable officers who are already in the theater and who, in the course of routine examination or during hospitalization for other causes, are found to have asymptomatic conditions such as a mild degree of nerve deafness, hypertrophic arthritis, and similar defects, the presence of which would not preclude a service expectancy of several years.

4. Action to be taken in case of physically unfit officer.

a. Whenever it is believed that an officer is becoming permanently incapable of performing the duties of his office, due to physical or mental causes (other than those of mental indifference, inaptitude, or incompetence, to which AR 605-230 applies), his commanding officer will cause the officer to be given a thorough physical examination by a medical board consisting of two

or more officers, at least one of whom is of field grade. If medical officers are not available, request for orders for hospitalization should be made to next higher military headquarters competent to issue such orders and the officer will be hospitalized.

b. If, as a result of the above examination, it is found:

- (1) That an officer now assigned general military duties is considered physically incapable of performing such duties or
- (2) That an officer now classified as limited service is considered as physically incapable of performing limited service duties,

the officer will be sent to the nearest general hospital, if the 114th or 51st Station Hospital if the condition is mental, for observation, treatment, and recommendation for the type of duty, if any, that he may be physically qualified to perform.

c. Action as outlined in a and b above may be initiated by an officer believing himself to be incapacitated by submitting to his immediate commander a statement in writing to that effect.

d. Whenever an officer is sent to a general hospital, the 114th or 51st Station Hospital, under the provisions contained herein, the hospital will be notified whenever practicable of the expected hour and place of his arrival. Medical report on WD AGO Form 63 and WD AGO Form 66-1 will accompany the officer in a sealed envelope marked confidential for delivery to the Commanding Officer of the hospital to which ordered. The WD AGO Form 63 will show clearly in what manner the physical incapacity was incurred, its cause, if ascertainable, and whether or not physical incapacity is considered incident to the service. A detailed statement by the organization commander will also be furnished, showing the manner of performance of duty by the officer concerned, to include any factors which might indicate mental sluggishness or physical incapacity under stress.

5. Disposition of officers by General Hospitals, the 114th or 51st Station Hospitals.

a. Upon completion of observation and treatment, officers will be classified by the disposition boards as follows:

- (1) Class A1- Suitable for full military duty at once.
 - (2) Class A2- Suitable for full military duty after from 1 to 6 weeks conditioning at a replacement conditioning depot.
 - (3) Class B- Suitable for limited service, stating whether the physical disability is of temporary or permanent nature.
 - (4) Class C- Disqualified for any type of military duty.
- b. (1) Class A officers will be returned to former units on orders issued by hospital commanders, through nearest personnel center when transportation or other conditions make such action advisable.
- (2) Class A2 officers will be returned to their former units on orders issued by hospital commanders through replacement conditioning depots for from 1 to 6 weeks conditioning, as

- determined by the hospital disposition board. Hospital commanders will inform the parent unit when this action is taken.
- (3) Class E officers determined to be capable of performing duty of any kind within their former command as a whole (army, base section or other similar command) will be transferred to the headquarters of that command for reassignment on orders issued by hospital commanders.
 - (4) Class E officers who are determined to be unable to perform duties within their former command as a whole, will be transferred to the nearest Personnel Center for reassignment on orders issued by hospital commanders.
 - (5) When an officer has been classified as limited service, that fact, together with a statement as to the general type of duty that the officer may be expected to perform, will be entered on the disposition board report, Report of Physical Examination (WD AGO Form 63), and WD AGO Form 66-1. Immediately upon release from the hospital, the unit to which the officer is transferred will be furnished sufficient information on which to base appropriate reassignment.
 - (6) Class C officers will be transferred by hospital commanders to the detachment of patients and will then be forwarded to Zone of Interior (US) through medical channels. The former unit of the individual will be notified.
 - (7) In order to avoid congestion in hospitals, officers placed in classes "A" and "B", if action has not already been completed, will be transferred to the personnel center to await completion of final action on recommendations made by disposition boards. This fact will be included in the information furnished in compliance with 5b (4) above. All concerned will be informed of the final action in each case at the earliest practicable date.

6. Change from Limited Service to General Service Status:

a. Initial Examination.

- (1) When an officer who has been classified as "Limited Service" has served not less than ninety (90) days in that status and has reason to believe that the conditions for which he was classified limited service no longer exist, he may request physical reexamination. The officer's commanding officer may also request such reexamination whenever he has reason to believe that the officer is capable of performing full military duty.
- (2) Upon receipt of a request for reexamination, the commanding officer will cause the officer to be given a thorough physical examination by a medical board, consisting of two (2) or more officers, one of whom is at least of field grade. Provided the board considers it necessary, a copy of the proceedings of the disposition board from the general hospital, or the 11th or 51st Station Hospital, where the officer was classified as limited service, will be secured.
- (3) If, after a review of all records and a thorough physical examination, the board is of the opinion that the officer is physically and mentally fit for general military service, the board proceedings will be forwarded to the base section, division, or other corresponding commander, for review.

- (4) When so recommended by the board, the commander will take necessary action to reassign the officer to an appropriate vacancy. If a suitable vacancy does not exist, the proceedings will be forwarded to this headquarters for necessary action. If the board does not recommend that the officer be classified for general service, the officer and the commander who requested reexamination will be notified of that fact and the proceedings will be filed.

b. Subsequent examinations for officers assigned to units of the Zone of Communications and Air Service Commands:

- (1) All limited service officers of these commands will be examined by unit surgeons at intervals of not greater than six (6) months. When it is found that the causative condition has ameliorated or no longer exists, the officer will be sent to a general hospital, or to the 114th or 51st Station Hospital, for further examination by a medical examining board.
- (2) These boards will consist of at least two (2) officers, at least one of whom will be of field grade. If the classification for limited service was due to a mental condition, a qualified psychiatrist will be included as a member of the board.
- (3) The hospital will be advised of the expected hour and place of arrival and of the purpose of hospitalization.
- (4) If the officer is examined at a hospital other than the one where he was classified as limited service, and the board considers it necessary, a copy of the proceedings of the disposition board will be secured from the general hospital, or the 114th or 51st Station Hospital, where he was classified as limited service.
- (5) The officer will be given a thorough physical examination by the board, upon completion of which he will be returned on orders issued by the hospital commander, to his organization.
- (6) If it is found that the officer is physically qualified for full military duty, the board will recommend the officer's reclassification for general service and will furnish a copy of the disposition proceedings to the base section or air service command commander, through the officer's commanding officer.
- (7) Upon receipt of such recommendation, the following action will be taken.
 - (a) Organization Commander: Delete by interlineation the remark on the MD AGO Form 20-35-1 having reference to officer's classification as limited service. Enter and initial a remark showing the fact of reclassification for general service, with date. Forward the disposition board proceedings direct to the proper base section or air service command commander.
 - (b) Base Section or Air Service Command Commander: Take necessary action to reassign the officer to an appropriate vacancy.

- (8) If it is found that the officer is not physically qualified for full military duty, the officer will be returned to his organization, on orders issued by the hospital commander, who will enter fact of reexamination on WD AGO Form No 66-1. A copy of the proceedings will be furnished the organization commander who will file them without action.
- (9) All concerned will take prompt action to assure that personnel do not remain in hospitals longer than is essential for the accomplishment of reexamination, except where observation and treatment is necessary.

7. The instructions herein have equal application to Warrant Officers.

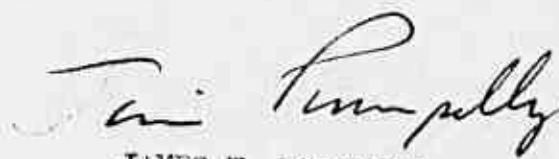
