I feel rather strongly about this. The Circolo Artistico Internazionale was founded in 1870 and occupied these premises until 1933 when it was broken up by the Fascists. The owners redivided it in two months ago on the basis of Montgomery's letter, and I simply cannot believe Michael Stewarts intellectual quality that Montgomery did NOT recognize the right of the Circolo. He ~~to~~ wrote it in reply to a letter written for the Circolo! The British Institute had the premises for one year.

If we now turf out the Circolo it will make an extremely bad impression.

Dear Fielden,

Many thanks for your letter about the Circolo Internazionale and the premises in the Via Margutta.

I have discussed the matter with Halford who tells me that Montgomery's letter of 28th September states the position exactly. That is to say, the British Embassy asked the Military Authorities that the premises should not be requisitioned, but did not by doing so imply that they recognized the right of the Circolo to the premises.

In point of fact the question of whether the British Institute will or not acquire the premises is still open, but the Embassy nevertheless wishes and has said so to the M.F.A., to reserve the right of the British Institute to the premises if the latter require them. Whether or not the British Institute succeeds in getting them, when they have finally made up their mind, will be a matter for the landlord, Marchese Patrizi, to decide, but I believe that at present Patrizi inclines to favour the Institute's claims.

I am afraid that from the point of view of the Circolo this is not a very satisfactory letter, but it is really a question of the Institute's interests against theirs and the Embassy naturally supports the former.

Further to our telephone conversations about the above I attach a copy of the promemoria which was submitted to the Embassy and also a copy of Hugh Montgomery's letter on this subject of September 20.

I was myself a member of the Circolo in 1921 & 22 and I know the people concerned very well. Acting on Montgomery's letter they have gone to considerable trouble and expense in rehabilitating the place, and the formal opening took place about a month ago.

It seems to me that it would be extremely unfair and ill advised if the British Institute which after all only accepted the premises for a very short time now took possession of them by requisition. I very much hope that any such idea may be abandoned.





1. This memo is to confirm your conversation of 7 Jan 44 with Captain Leacaces, DPRO, Region 4, concerning arrangements for accredited correspondents to obtain a story on AMG experiences in property control in Italy.
2. The story is visualized as follows: a review of AMG property control experience to date in Italy, including Sicily and Region 3 (Naples); review of the difficulties anticipated in Rome. The interview will cover the aims and functions of AMG property control, statistics and examples of types and varieties of property under control.
3. The material should present property control in Italy as an experiment, and as a view of the much greater and more complicated situation anticipated in Germany, France and other parts of Europe where the Nazis have scrambled property almost inextricably.
4. It is requested that this suggestion be brought to the notice of correspondents of the "New York Times", "London Times", "Chicago Daily News" and "Reuters", among others.
5. This communication will be forwarded to Colonel Kenneth Clark, 5 Army PRO, for his attention.
6. The date for the interview has been tentatively set (subject to change by you) for Thursday, 20 January, at 1030 hours, at the PRO Office, 1st Floor, Provincia Building, Naples.
7. Property Control officers of ACC-AMG HQ, Region 3 AMG, and Region 4 AMG will be present.
