1. During the month the book called "Desk Guide to Italy" prepared by the Information Division came off the press.

2. The 300 copies thereof, authorized to be bound, were distributed as follow:

- a) 200 copies to the Headquarters Staff, the various Sections and Subcommissions of the Allied Commission.
- b) 100 copies to Regional Staff and personnel.

3. A complete card index is held indicating distribution made.

4. Due to the number of requests made for the "Guide", request was made for permission to bind 500 additional copies.

5. During the month of February 1945 the Central Reference Library had 351 visitors and received 722 requests for information. The number of visitors for January 1945 was 625. (The increase in the number of visitors in February as against the number for January 1945 is attributed to the fact that the Central Reference Library is now in receipt of several American and British newspapers, periodicals, trade journals, and financial documents which had been requested by A.C. personnel.)

6. The Library purchased 5 books for general reference work.

7. The number of reports received from the various Subcommissions and Regional Headquarters totaled 60.

8. The number of reports of a classified nature distributed to personnel interested therein totaled 120.

9. Distribution of Monitoring Reports, Communiques, A.C.I. Bulletins, Censorship and other reports took place in accordance with distribution lists.

10. The War Information Bulletins were posted daily.

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11. 3351 cap sheets were supplied to A.S./A.M.S. personnel.

12. During the month we received a visit from a Captain sent by Major Adams of A.F.M.S. in order to "investigate" our cap department. Previous to that visit A.F.M.S. had been under the impression that we were issuing too many caps. After the "investigation" it was agreed that a larger quantity and variety of caps be placed at our disposal in order to meet the demand.

13. Three new caps were designed by the draftsman in order to meet specific requirements of the Transportation Subcommittee and the Civil Affairs Section.

14. The marking of new boundaries of all staff caps was regularly carried out.

3. During the month of January 1945 the Central Reference Library had 625 visitors and received 780 requests for information.

MEMORANDUM TO MAJOR FIELDEN

SUBJECT: Report on contact with A.F.H.Q.

1. On arrival at A.F.H.Q., I talked at length with Lt. Col. W.M. Scully, G-2 Section, OI. We discussed the type of reports that the Information Division of A.C. should receive.
2. Col. Scully was of the opinion that the Central Reference Library should be in receipt of reports dealing with countries other than Italy, since some practical difficulty might be encountered if officers of AC/AMC could only get such reports through A.F.H.Q.
3. Col. Scully's principal concern in re reports on countries other than Italy, was that he suspected that some officers were trying to prepare themselves at long range in anticipation of a move by A.C., HQ, to some other country.
4. Col. Scully said that all requests for reports had been submitted to Col. Jackman of G-5 and that Col. Jackman had indicated his approval of our requests.
5. I stated that since requests for information on countries other than Italy now totalled 20 % of the number of requests made to us, that I thought we should make every effort to supply the information desired, but that my statement was subject to approval from AC/HQ which might feel that we should deal only in reports concerning Italy.
6. I then spent several hours with Cpts. Golding and Blackmore at the G-2 OI Library. These officers painstakingly went through hundreds of reports with me.
7. The amount of information available at G-2 OI Library is vast. In my opinion much of it should be made available to AC/HQ with that thought in mind I made arrangements to have such reports forwarded to us, so that the Reference Library may serve as many as possible who desire such information.

8. I arranged to receive the information I thought we would be most interested in dealing namely with reports on

1. Economics
2. Commerce
3. Mining
4. Agriculture
5. Politics
6. Population
7. Railroads
8. Waterways and Ports
9. Industries
10. Topography.

9. I feel that as a result of my trip a closer liaison has been established between G-2, G-5 and our department.

10. I then spent some time with Major Adams of the Survey Directorate of A.F.M.V., and learned about the wide variety of maps available to us. As a result of this visit I feel that our map supply of the future will be better quantitatively and qualitatively.

Colonel Fiske and Colonel Clough seem to want a report on the "present position". The reports I sent covered the period Oct 10-20, and that is in fact the "present position". I can of course have another check made, but it will, I am sure, produce the same results - i.e. that about 25-30 people a day visit the library, and in addition a varying number of requests are made (see Lt. Cashman's last two paragraphs) some of which undoubtedly entail a good deal of research.

There is however a new factor emerging since the last report. Several of the Italian Ministries and all of the Italian press are constantly pressing for facilities to see British and American newspapers and periodicals and both PWB and the British Embassy have asked our co-operation in this matter. It is obviously desirable that such facilities should, as soon as possible, be given. Members of the Commission are supplying us with a number of papers and periodicals and the Embassy is also sending newspapers.

This pressure on the library is tending to increase and I am intending to move all security documents and military reports into Room 11 so as to leave the library free for reference works, daily newspapers, periodicals and technical journals.
