1. General Order No. 45, this Headquarters, dated 1 November 1944, is hereby revoked.
2. Pursuant to letter OA/23, dated 25 October 1944, and signal 8665, AMG 8th Army, Ancona and Pesaro-Urbino Provinces are released to AMG/AC control under the jurisdiction of the Abruzzi-Marche Region.
3. Effective from 1000 hours 3 November 1944, Abruzzi-Marche Region assumes administrative control.
4. Normal security regulations and restriction of civilian movement in that part of the two provinces north of the Rear Army Security Control Line remain in full force and effect.

The Security Branch of the present R.C. & M.G. Section is hereby transferred to the Civil Affairs Section where it will become a division of the Public Safety Sub-Commission, and will be known as the Security Division of the Public Safety Sub-Commission.

XII -- ABOLITION OF CIVIL AFFAIRS BRANCH, R.C. & M.G. SECTION

The Civil Affairs Branch, R.C. & M.G. Section is hereby abolished and the functions and responsibilities formerly assigned thereto are hereby transferred to the Offices of the Chief of Staff, Economic and Civil Affairs Sections, in accordance with the reorganization herein set forth. The Liaison Branch is hereby transferred to and is made a part of the Office of the Chief of Staff. The Pool of Interpreters is hereby abolished.

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XIII -- ESTABLISHMENT OF ESTABLISHMENT SECTION, HQ AGC

Announcement is made of the creation of an Establishment Section, HQ AGC. This Section will assume all the responsibilities and functions of the Establishment Branch of the present A.C. & M.G. Section with the exception of the following "operational" functions of the Adjutant's Department: Duplication, Files, Reception and Sorting, Registry, Copies, Internal Distribution and DMS Sections, which are hereby transferred to the Office of the Chief of Staff.

XIV -- TRANSFER OF PROPERTY CONTROL SUB-COMMISSION TO ECONOMIC SECTION

The Property Control Sub-Commission is hereby transferred to the Economic Section where it will become a division of the Finance Sub-Commission and will be known as the Property Control Division, Finance Sub-Commission.

XV -- TRANSFER OF THE MEDICAL SUPPLY BRANCH OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH SUB-COMMISSION TO THE ECONOMIC SECTION

The Medical Supply Branch of the Public Health Sub-Commission is hereby transferred to the Economic Section where it will become a part of the Warehousing Branch of the Food Sub-Commission.

XVI -- DESIGNATION AND RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CIVIL AFFAIRS SECTION

The present Administrative Section is hereby designated as the Civil Affairs Section. This section will continue to be responsible for those functions now operated by the present Administrative Section less Property Control Sub-Commission, and in addition will assume the functions and responsibilities of the Patriots Branch, Italian Refugee and the Displaced Persons Sub-Commission, presently under the A.C. & M.G. Section. The Patriots Branch, Italian Refugee Branch and the Displaced Persons Sub-Commission are hereby transferred to the Civil Affairs Section.

XVII -- AMALGAMATION OF ITALIAN REFUGEE BRANCH AND THE DISPLACED PERSONS SUB-COMMISSION

The Italian Refugee Branch and the Displaced Persons Sub-Commission are hereby amalgamated into one sub-commission, under the Civil Affairs Section. Such amalgamated sub-commission is to be known as the Displaced Persons and Repatriation Sub-Commission.

XVIII -- DESIGNATION OF DIRECTOR OF DISPLACED PERSONS AND REPATRIATION SUB-COMMISSION

Announcement is made of the designation of Colonel C. B. FIDDLAY, as Director, Displaced Persons and Repatriation Sub-Commission.

XIX -- DESIGNATION OF CHIEF LEGAL ADVISOR

The Director of the Legal Sub-Commission is hereby designated as Chief Legal Advisor to the Chief Commissioner, in addition to the functions and responsibilities of the Legal Sub-Commission.

The Medical Supply Branch of the Public Health Sub-Commission is hereby transferred to the Economic Section where it will become a part of the Warehousing Branch of the Food Sub-Commission.

XVI -- DESIGNATION AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE CIVIL AFFAIRS SECTION

The present Administrative Section is hereby designated as the Civil Affairs Section. This section will continue to be responsible for those functions now operated by the present Administrative Section less Property Control Sub-Commission, and in addition will assume the functions and responsibilities of the Patriots Branch, Italian Refugee and the Displaced Persons Sub-Commission, presently under the A.C. & M.C. Section. The Patriots Branch, Italian Refugee Branch and the Displaced Persons Sub-Commission are hereby transferred to the Civil Affairs Section.

XVII -- AMALGAMATION OF ITALIAN REFUGEE BRANCH AND THE DISPLACED PERSONS SUB-COMMISSION

The Italian Refugee Branch and the Displaced Persons Sub-Commission are hereby amalgamated into one sub-commission, under the Civil Affairs Section. Such amalgamated sub-commission is to be known as the Displaced Persons and Repatriation Sub-Commission.

XVIII -- DESIGNATION OF DIRECTOR OF DISPLACED PERSONS AND REPATRIATION SUB-COMMISSION

Announcement is made of the designation of Colonel C. B. FIELDAY, as Director, Displaced Persons and Repatriation Sub-Commission.

XIX -- DESIGNATION OF CHIEF LEGAL ADVISOR

The Director of the Legal Sub-Commission is hereby designated as Chief Legal Advisor to the Chief Commissioner, in addition to the functions and responsibilities of the Legal Sub-Commission.

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XX -- DESIGNATION OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT SUB-COMMISSION

The present Interior Sub-Commission is hereby designated as the Local Government Sub-Commission and will retain its present functions and responsibilities and remain a part of the Civil Affairs Section.

XXI -- ESTABLISHMENT AND DESIGNATION OF PERSONNEL AND ORGANIZATION COMMITTEE

Announcement is made of the establishment of a standing Committee to consider problems on Personnel and Organization and to make recommendations with

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respect to same to the Chief Commissioner. Such Committee to be composed of the Chief of Staff, Chairman, and the Vice-Presidents of the Civil Affairs, Economic and Establishment Sections as members. The Committee will meet on call of the Chairman.

XXII - GENERAL

The establishment, transfer and abolition of the offices, sections, sub-commissions and branches hereby announced will take effect on the date of this order.

The reorganizations and qualifications of Sub-Commissions and Branches hereby directed and the further recommendations contained in the Empowerment & Re-Organization Committee's report of the 27 Aug 44 with certain modifications shown in the appendix, will be carried out under the direction of respective Sections Heads and completed by 9 October 1944.
