The Acting Chief Commissioner of the A.C.C. presents his compliments to the Spanish Charge d'Affaires and has the honor to state that he duly brought to the attention of the Allied military authorities concerned the assurance given in the Embassy's memorandum No. 26 of the 11th July last that the Embassy's wireless service had been discontinued.

It is with some surprise, therefore, that investigation by the appropriate technical means seems to have established that a wireless transmitting set has been functioning from the premises of the Embassy. The matter has been referred to the Supreme Allied Commander himself, who has instructed the A.C.C. on his behalf once again to draw attention to the requirement of the Allied Military Governor of Italy set out in the memorandum of the 7th July from the A.C.C., namely that the use of wireless transmitting sets for any purpose by neutral Missions is not permitted and that the transmission of telegraphic messages by any other means than through the Allied Control Commission is not at present authorized.

The Supreme Allied Commander feels confident that the Spanish Embassy would not wish to go back on the undertaking given in their memorandum No. 26 and that they will on their own side make the most rigorous investigation to ensure that no use is made of the wireless transmitting set in their possession.
