In view of desire of House Military Affairs Committee for additional time in Rome, itinerary for Rome has been changed as follows: If weather permits committee will arrive at LITTORIO by air at approximate 1600 hours Thursday 14 December. If impossible to fly, party will come by road arriving at GRAND HOTEL between 1700 and 1800 hours. After informal dinner at hotel, remainder of evening is optional with members. Some may desire to go to opera if tickets are available. Entire day of Friday 15 December will be spent in Rome. The committee is particularly anxious for an audience with the Pope. Recommended for audience with Pope are seventeen House Committee members, 3 war department representatives, Brigadier General ARTHUR J. M. CRYSTAL, Colonel ROBERTA E. CLARK and Miss VIOLET DUPONT. It is also considered desirable to include at audience the 5 following correspondents who are accompanying the official party: KLEARCH PICHARD, UNITED PRESS, RITA HUME, International News Service, RUTH COHEN, Associated Press, DONALD WILLIAMS, Stars and Stripes, MARTIN GLATZER, United Nations News Service.

2. Committee will remain overnight, and after more informal luncheon at noon on Saturday 16 December will depart by air at 1330 hours from LITTORIO for FLORENCE. If weather not flyable party will have to leave midmorning of 16th by road for FLORENCE. In this case arrangements should be made to provide box lunches. Morning of 16th, if party goes by air, will be left open for sightseeing and shopping. We are sending 6 sedans from Rome to assist you in transportation while party is in Rome.

3. Appreciate earliest summary of your plans for Rome based on new itinerary.

4. All accommodations will be required for aircraft crews, drivers and aides, will

Because of unreliability of LIPORIO airfield Congressional party, if weather permits flying, will arrive and depart from CIAMPINO airfield. Air arrival at CIAMPINO will be at approximately 1600 hours, Thursday 14 December. The six sedans promised you to aid in transport in ROME will not repeat not arrive in ROME in time to help pick up party at CIAMPINO, as cars cannot leave NAPLES prior to take off at 1500 hours. These cars should arrive GRAND HOTEL in time for use that night. Air departure from CIAMPINO to FLORENCE will be at 1400 hours Saturday 16 December. 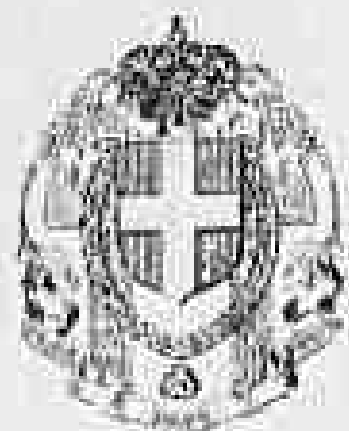

MEMORANDUM

The Department of State has been informed by the International Business Conference that they would take pleasure in inviting the National Committee of the International Chamber of Commerce in Rome if this Committee still exists and is able to nominate satisfactory delegates. The former president was Count Ettore Conti.

Before a formal invitation is given they would like to have names and brief identification of proposed delegates. They would consider sending the invitation on the same basis to the Rome Chamber of Commerce if the National Committee no longer exists. They do not desire however, to have as delegates to this conference Italians who are at present in the United States.

The date of the conference is November 10 to 18 and it will convene at Rye, New York. Prospective delegates should be informed that no air priorities for any of the delegations have been requested by the Department and that the American Government does not assume any responsibility for the arrival of delegates to the conference in the United States or for their return home and that it is possible, on account of the scarcity of transportation facilities, that the delegates' return home might be delayed indefinitely.

Dear Captain Stone:

With reference to our conversation this morning, I wish to inform you that I have received a personal communication from the Undersecretary for Foreign Affairs regarding the desire of the Italian Government to send Dr. Quinto Quintieri and Dr. Raffaele Mattioli to the United States unofficially as technical representatives to discuss economic and other questions in the purview of the reply of Secretary Hull of August 19 to Premier Bonomi's memorandum of July 22, a copy of which has been furnished you.

As I also mentioned, the Italian Red Cross are planning to send Signor Enrico Scaretti to the United States for discussions with the American Red Cross on organizational matters.

I might add that my action in connection with the foregoing matters has been limited to informal inquiries at Washington as to whether the persons in question would be welcome there and I assume that such formalities as may be necessary in connection with any regulations governing departures from Italy aside from mere travel arrangements are initiated by the Italian authorities.

Enclosed please find two telegrams addressed respectively to the German Embassy to the Vatican and to the Secretary of State of His Holiness the Pope which were transmitted by members of the German diplomatic group interned at Taormina.

These telegrams have been approved for forwarding by G-2, R.A.C. It would be appreciated were you to forward them to the Secretary of State of His Holiness for ultimate delivery.

As regards the telegram from Herr Wallenweber requesting medical treatment in Rome, the A.C.C. Officer in Taormina charged with the surveillance of the interned diplomats there, has expressed himself as follows:-

"Even if the local doctor committed himself as positively as the telegram infers (which I doubt), the Regional Commissioner would prefer no doubt to invite the consultation of another doctor. The patient arrived in Sicily with this man on his face, and it appears to my lay mind as of low standing. I cannot believe there is any urgency in this case. In view of the concern expressed by the ACC about Herr Hahn, albeit after his death, I think you would like to report this case as early as possible. In no circumstances I think would the Political Section agree to his transfer to a Nursing Home in Rome. The point to be decided is rather whether the operation should be done now at all."

I take this opportunity to confirm that the balance of L 790,905 held in the Bank of Italy for the German xxx internees has now been transferred to the name of Major J.B.WILSON. We will continue to make fortnightly withdrawals of money for which Miremare cheques have been signed, in the presence of a witness from the Finance Office. Major Withers has agreed to let Major Wilson have the use of the float facilities (L40,000) which he accorded to me.
