

Polish Diplomatic and Consular Missions to ITALY and VATICAN are pressing strongly for advance in Lire from AFA to cover March expenses totalling equivalent of ± 7647/10<sup>4</sup>. Already owe AFA 10 million Lire from past approved advances which have not been reimbursed to AFA through remittances system. ALLIED COMMISSION will not make this advance without your approval. Remittance system as used by CZECHOSLOVAK Mission is now working satisfactorily and it is not understood why Polish Government cannot contract that channel to remit to all concerned Diplomatic and Consular Missions in ITALY. Reply urgently needed.



The Supreme Allied Commander has instructed the Allied Control Commission that, the principle of United Nations representation in Liberated Italy by consular officials having already been agreed, there is no objection to M. Loret being appointed Polish Consul-General in Rome and, if the Polish Government consider it desirable, there would be no objection to his having the personal rank of Minister.

It is pointed out that it is desirable that all United Nations not represented on the Advisory Council for Italy should have uniform representation in Liberated Italy by consular officers.

It is also directed that, while consular officers at the Italian capital should be permitted to have informal relations with the Italian Government, their recognition and official functions should conform to the procedure already established for United Nations consular officers in Liberated Italy.

I accepted the appointment stop I still have a part of the fund obtained for Poland and Lidia stop on the seventeenth June I delivered to the military authorities more than onehundred boys snatched from the Germans and hidden by me in Rome with the help of a few collaborators stop ambassador informed you about budget of my office stop there is urgent necessity of a lump sum to be able helping 500 Poles in Rome only stop during the war I paid subsidies from the fund for Poland and maintained from this fund the above mentioned boys for six months stop the registrations made by me attests that there are now about eighthundred Poles in Rome part of which are clergymen and nuns stop many more Poles are expected from all parts of Italy stop I presume that there are about thousand more boys destined for the Polish Army in Italian territories occupied at present by the Germans stop July fifth I arrange a celebration as commemorial for General Sikorski stop *Loret.*

FOREIGN OFFICIAL OF POLISH GOVERNMENT, MINISTER LORET, HAS RECEIVED INSTRUCTIONS FROM HIS GOVERNMENT IN LONDON THROUGH THE POLISH MISSION TO HOLY SEE APPOINTING HIM AS POLISH REPRESENTATIVE ACCREDITED TO THE ALLIED CONTROL COMMISSION. HE HAS ASKED THAT THE FOLLOWING TELEGRAM BE SENT TO HIS GOVERNMENT IN LONDON. MESSAGE BEGINS PANA DO POLKATERNI FOR ROMER. APPOINTMENT OFFERED ME ACCEPTED. I STILL HAVE SOME OF THE FUND WHICH WAS FOR LITIA AND POLAND. I TURNED OVER TO THE MILITARY AUTHORITIES ON JUNE 17 OVER 100 BOYS SNATCHED OUT OF GERMAN HANDS FROM I HAD HERE, WITH THE AID OF A FEW COLLABORATORS, HIDING IN HOME. AMBASSADOR INFORMED YOU CONCERNING MY OFFICE BUDGET. A LUMP SUM IS URGENTLY NEEDED TO AID 500 POLES IN HOME BLOOM. 
