

DIF CMATIC RELATIONS OF THE ITALIAN GOVERNMENT

- 1) Countries with which diplometic relations were never interrupted: Argentina, Ireland, Portugal, Spain, Switzerland. Turkey, Hely See, Afganistan.
- 2) Countries with which diplomatic relations were re-established:
 The following countries have communicated to the Italian givernment their decision to re-establish diplomatic relations: Great Britain, United States, Russia, Poland, China, Brazil, Chile, Columbia, Costa Rica, Cuba, Ecurder, Honduras, Mexico, Nicaregue, Panama, Paraguay, Peru, Deminican Republic and Venezuala.

(With Peru' it was reached an agreement to elevate to Embassies the respective rapresentations).

(The U.S. Secretary of State communicated in date 25 October the American Epublics had all agreed, with the exception of Argentine, to re-establish diplomatic relations with the Italian government; relative communications from the governments of Balivia, Guatemala and Haiti have/arrived yet).

- 3) Countries which for the present have bere e consular representative in Rome: Czechoslevakia, Helland, Belgium.
- 4) Countries in which the Italian government has diplomatic representatives, but which due to present circumstances have no representative in Rome and with which Italy wishes to have diplomatic relations: Rumania, Bulgaria.

(With the re-establishment of diplomatic relations with the British government it can be assumed that the situation is normal again also with the Deminions. The only exception may be South Africa, with which was Italy had direct diplomatic relations.)
