MEMORANDUM FOR THE POLITICAL SECTION A.C.

The Ministry for Foreign Affairs thank the A.C. for their Mem. n° 360/393 of December 12th concerning the reestablishment of diplomatic relations between Guatemala and Italy, and beg them to forward to the State Department the warmest thanks of the Italian Government for the transmission of the Guatemalan Government's communication.

In accordance with the practice already followed in the reestablishment of diplomatic relations between Italy and 15 of the South American Republics, we have already directly telegraphed to the Ministry for Foreign Affairs of Sucre/Bolivia acknowledging their decision.

The Ministry for Foreign Affairs would at the same time be grateful if the A.C. would kindly interest the State Department in defining the attitude of Bolivia as regards the reestablishment of diplomatic relations with Italy. No direct communication has in fact till now been received from La Paz.

Admiral Stone, in his letter of October 25th addressed to the President of the Council, informed that an agreement had been reached by the South American Republics, except Argentine, for the reestablishment of diplomatic relations with Italy: 19 of them had already agreed on the draft of a communique while it was foreseen that the 20th Republic would have acceded at an early date. It remains therefore to be ascertained if Bolivia is one of the 19 Republics who have already acceded to the aforesaid agreement in order to avoid misunderstandings with the Government of La Paz, to whom the Italian Government have not yet telegraphed.
