RUSSO-CZECH POLICY AGREED FOR COMING ADVANCE

MOSCOW, May 1 - Details of a new Russo-Czech agreement were disclosed by Deputy Commissar of Foreign Affairs, Andrei Vyshinsky, at a press conference last night. He stated that when the Red Army enters Czechoslovakia, a commissioner appointed by the Czech government will accompany Poviet troops to administer the country, according to its own law, as it is freed from the enemy.

"As far as military operations are concerned," he said, "the Russian commander-in-chief will have complete control as long as is necessary. It will be the job of the "zechoslovak government's commissioner not only to administer the civil life of the liberated territory but also to raise Czechoslovak military units to fight alongside the Russians, and to see that the instructions of the Russian commander are carried out.

"As soon as any part of the country passes out of the zone of direct military operations, the Ezechoslovak government will take over complete administration of all public affairs. It will continue to give the Bussian commender every possible assistance, except in the immediate battle area.

"All civil crimes will be tried under Czecheslovak law, A special agreement will be made later to cover financial problems."

M. Vyshinsky pointed out that the agreement was based on the principles of the mutual aid pact between the two countries, in which each vowed not to interfere with the internal affairs of the other.
