- 3 cases signed A.C. Rossi - Rome ((Pinnonieri));

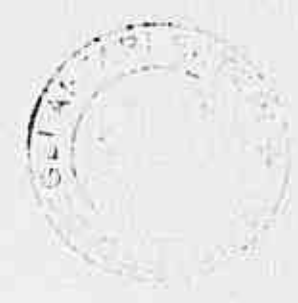
- 5 large cases addressed to Marchese Della Rosa, Ministry for Foreign Affairs - Rome;
