My dear Colleague:

Further to my letter of 11 November 1944 in regard to property belonging to Mrs. Lucy Day di Donato de Gado, and with reference to your esteemed communication of October 16, 1944, I am pleased to state that a thorough investigation by Headquarters, Allied Military Government, Abruzzi-Marche Region has indicated that the property at Marsocca de Senigallia has never been occupied by Allied troops. An advice from the Regional Commissioner indicates that the property is a small bungalow in poor repair and is occupied by civilians as are the other houses in the immediate vicinity. The Town Major of Senigallia has indicated that all houses in Marsocca which are occupied by Allied troops are properly requisitioned and that his records fail to show any such properties that are owned by Mrs. Lucy Day di Donato de Gado.

1. Reference Prov. Commissioner's A/I30 dated 3rd Nov.44.
2. I have to-day been to Marzocca to investigate the condition of property belonging to Mrs. Lucy Day di Donato de Gado, which was alleged to have been damaged by Allied soldiers.
3. The exact address of the property was given to me by the SINDACO as No.527 Marzocca. This property is a small bungalow in poor repair and is occupied by civilians as are the houses in the immediate vicinity.
4. All houses in Marzocca in use by Allied Troops are properly requisitioned and my records do not shew any as belonging to Di Donato.
5. I can only assume therefore that the house in question is occupied by civilians and not troops.

My dear colleague,

I would like to call your attention to the case of a Brazilian citizen Mrs Lúcy Day di Donato de Gado who has three houses, respectively in Castelnuovo di Conzo (provincia di Salerno), Civita Castellana (provincia di Viterbo) in the place called Fontana Quaiola and in the beach of Marzocca di Senigallia (provincia di Ancona).

2. All these properties with furniture and food included have been occupied and used by the Allied troops.

3. Mrs. Donato de Gado claims that the damages done by the mentioned troops are reckoned between 3 and 5 million lire approximately.

4. I would be grateful to you to take this matter up with Allied Military authorities and ask them to avoid the said houses being requisitioned or occupied either by Allied troops or Italian civilians.

In ottemperanza alle istruzioni di V.E. questo Ufficio ha provveduto ad interessare la Segreteria dello Ammiraglio Stone affinché lo stabile sito al n. 504 di Corso Umberto I° venga posto "off limits and out of bounds" per la truppa alleata. L' Ammiraglio Stone ha sottoposto a sua volta la richiesta al Gen. Con questa ragione il Gen. Brown non ritiene di poter aderire alla richiesta e suggerisce che V.E. trovi il modo di dare lo sfratto alle famiglie che occupano il loro alloggio per l' uso che è loro concesso nel contratto di locazione.
