Dear Sam:

Referring to our telephone conversation this morning, I enclose herewith a copy of a memorandum prepared by the Secretariat of State of His Holiness regarding the projected visit of the Cardinal Secretary of State to his home in Casoria, Province of Naples. There is also enclosed what appears to be a permit for the trip signed by Lt. Col. Ames. This permit would not seem to be adequate, because at the time that it was made out it was not possible to list all the members of the Cardinal's party. Furthermore, the permit omits the recommendation for provision of gasoline for the Cardinal to circulate while in Naples.

It would, therefore, be appreciated if the necessary steps could be taken in order that Cardinal Maglione may be able to leave Rome at the earliest practicable moment and that assurances be given that he will receive the necessary facilities while in Naples and during the return journey.

His Eminence, Cardinal Maglione, Secretary of State of His Holiness, desires to go to his home in Casoria, (Prov. of Naples), as soon as possible. His Eminence is ill and hopes to take special treatments in places in the vicinity of Naples. To make the trip conveniently, His Eminence will travel by car with a party of five. The party will be made up as follows:

1. His Eminence, Cardinal Maglione;
2. Dr. Nicola Maglione
3. Giovanni Salvato
4. Tullio Andreis - chauffeur
5. Professor Rocchi

His Eminence will use his private car, bearing Vatican license No. 32. He will also use another Vatican car, bearing the Vatican license No. 415.

The driver of the second car is Armando Cencelli.

It is requested then that the Allied Control Commission grant the necessary permits for His Eminence and his party to go to Naples and return at their convenience.

It is furthermore requested that provisions be made which will enable Cardinal Maglione to circulate freely in the Naples area and to obtain the gasoline necessary to do so.
