BOTH HANDOCK AND I BELIEVE IT VITAL THAT CHIEF COMMISSIONER PROPOSE TO BADOGLIO AS SOON AS POSSIBLE THAT ACC RECOMMENDS FRANCESCO MUSOTTO AS ITALIAN HIGH COMMISSIONER FOR SICILY. IN CONFERENCE WITH US, CHIEF COMMISSIONER STATED HE WOULD PERSONALLY TALK TO BADOGLIO IN FAVOR OF MUSOTTO, WHO HAS STRONG SUPPORT OF PEOPLE INCLUDING ALL 9 PERFECTS, LARGE NUMBERS OF MAYORS AND OTHER PUBLIC OFFICIALS. ALL POLITICAL PARTIES SUPPORT HIM. CHURCH CONSIDERS HIM FAVORABLY. MINISTER OF INTERIOR IN HIS TRIP TO SICILY STATED HE SUPPORTED MUSOTTO. THE PEOPLE OF SICILY KNOW THE FACTS AND TAKE IT FOR GRANTED THAT HE WILL BE APPOINTED INASMUCH AS HE HAS BEEN RECOMMENDED AND URGED BY AMG DURING PAST 3 MONTHS. WE FEEL STRONGLY APPOINTMENT OF ANOTHER WOULD IMPAIR AUTHORITY OF ALLIED GOVERNMENT OF SICILIAN ESSENTIAL. THERE IS NO MAN ON THE ISLAND WHO APPROACHES HIS STATURE AND ABILITIES. APPOINTMENT OF A GENERAL TO FILL THIS CIVILIAN POST IS CONSIDERED MOST INADVISABLE BY US.

MEMORANDUM FOR THE POLITICAL SECTION A.C.

The Ministry for Foreign Affairs would be informed if the Political Section can be taken into consideration concerning the possibility of representing the interests of war refugees in Italy, P.O.W. no 933563, JUP 313 - Postal Section Middle East.

Mr. Mazzolini is an employee of the Ministry who, in 1941, left the Italian Consulate in Paris - in order to participate in his military service, and who, at the time of the overthrow of Fascism, was confirmed to be loyal to the Royal Italian Government.

In consideration of the above and of the fact that Mr. Mazzolini is needed here, the Ministry for Foreign Affairs would much appreciate the kind interest of the Political Section in the matter.
