The American Ambassador, Mr. Alexander Kirk, requests information concerning the whereabouts of Aldo and Sylvan VANNUCCI reported to be in the Sant. Teresa Prison, Florence.

Aldo Vannucci was formerly the Ambassador's chauffeur and upon the Ambassador's leaving Italy, he wrote a letter of recommendation for Vannucci to Russia where the Ambassador was transferred. Vannucci subsequently was arrested as a spy, this letter figuring in the case.

Sylvan Vannucci is also mentioned in our Santa Teresa Prison, presumably also as a spy.

Will you please make inquiries and report such findings to Political Section, W.C.C.

Message from the Italian ambassador at Madrid to the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Telegram No. 7241 of November 22, follows. Maurizio Vazalda, Vice-Consul at Barcelona, daringly escaped on October 11 when on the point of being taken to the Vittel Internment Camp by the Germans. After a month's preparations he crossed the Spanish frontier and arrived on November 16 in Barcelona where the Spanish authorities detained him. Foregoing Paragraph 1, paragraph 2. Forthwith took the necessary action, vis-a-vis the Spanish Ministry for Foreign Affairs and received assurance that the authorities would release Vazalda at once. Paragraph 3. Vazalda is now in Madrid and at the first available opportunity will be repatriated. (FRANCE FOR JAMES FROM G-2 FOREIGN SOURCE COUNCIL ITEM). He is meanwhile receiving mission allowances. His report follows by bag.
