1. Reference is made to Executive Memorandum No. 77, para. 4 and Appendix "A", relating to Control of Movement, and letter AC/14080/7/PS, dated 25 October, 1944, as amended, relating to "Territorial Boundaries".
2. The Free Zone will be extended to include the Province of Viterbo (authority: A.F.H.Q. letter G.5 300.4.4 dated 28 November, 1944).
3. The Restricted Line will thus extend along the northern boundaries of the Provinces of Peramo, Rieti and Viterbo.
4. The Province of Foggia will remain for the present a Restricted Zone.

SUBJECT: Frontier Control.

TO : Allied Force Headquarters, G-5 Section.

1. To enable this Commission to issue the necessary instructions regarding Italian frontier control, I would be grateful for your directions on the following points:

(a) Upon arrival of the Allied Armies on the frontiers of Italy with France, Switzerland, Austria and Yugoslavia, will these frontiers be temporarily closed to all movement of civilians and merchandise? This Commission considers this desirable.

(b) After a period of time, will the S.A.C. permit civilian movement into or out of Italy provided the civilians are in possession of Military Travel Authorizations? This Commission considers this desirable.

(c) After a period of time, to what extent will S.A.C. permit the movement of merchandise across the frontiers? On this matter this Commission puts forward the following views:

- (i) Trans-frontier trade should be strictly controlled.
- (ii) A maximum of imports should be allowed for the rehabilitation of Italy.
- (iii) Only surplus goods should be allowed to be exported from Italy.
- (iv) Since Italian-Swiss trade agreement may still be in force when the Armies reach the Swiss frontier, this would place Swiss-Italian trade in a different category from that of other frontier States. In view of the potentialities of Swiss heavy industry and its intimate knowledge of local problems it is considered wise to establish a priority on Swiss output.

2. When I have received your directions as requested above, I will be able to send my final recommendation to you so that they may at an appropriate moment be communicated to the various Governments concerned.
