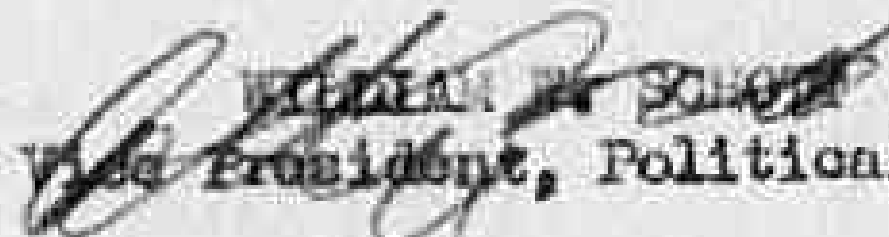

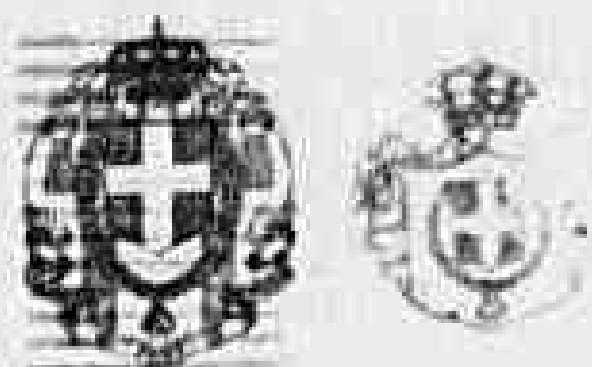

The enclosed communications have been received from the Swiss Consul in Sicily. While ordinarily communications from a neutral diplomat to his Foreign Office would, after review by this office, be transmitted to the American Representative in Algiers for forwarding, we are in some doubt as to the policy to be followed in the welfare cases. It is our understanding that routine "person-to-person" messages concerning welfare, whereabouts, etc., should not be sent via State Department or Army channels, but that they should be handled by welfare agencies such as the International Red Cross.

These messages have been examined and appear to be merely personal in character, but since they are direct (and in some cases handwritten) communications, the matter is being referred to your office.

In connection with a memorandum from Prunas (sent to you on 8 April) regarding categories of correspondence to be allowed to Italian foreign missions abroad, Roberti has asked for a reply regarding "printed matter".

You will remember this memorandum in connection with their misconception of the phrase "semi-official correspondence" which led you to instruct them that no letters to members of their foreign missions should be sent unless (a) typewritten, (b) non-family matters. The question of what constituted "printed matter" however was left alone, since a definition is a little difficult.

It will be sufficient for Roberti's purposes, I think, if you were to give him permission to send copies of, or clippings from, local newspapers for the benefit of embassies like Madrid who complain they are starving of local colour. I have already told him that we wish to decrease the bulk of their postage abroad; but if you would let him have this permission, I think we can avoid any further definition of the phrase "printed matter".
