Their situation is similar to that of numerous other Spanish and Foreign prisoners, especially Poles. All efforts to obtain their freedom have been fruitless because of the determination to apply ----- to all who belonged to armed bands from FRANCE. The question will be followed up; and I beg you to inform me of any steps which you may think best to take at the Spanish Embassy in Rome.

With reference to the Italians who will be liberated in Germany by Anglo-American troops, so far no really proper agreement exists as yet between the Italian Government and the Allied High Command. However the High Command has asked for an officer of high rank, who will soon go to PARIS and who, it is hoped, will be followed by others to ~~work~~ work with the Command in the organizing of the assistance and repatriation of Italians. The "Nzional Zeitung" of BASLE dated 3rd March published some correspondence in which, after referring to the "equivocal policy" that is being ----- in SWITZERLAND, states that there is reason to believe that by ----- of the Federal ----- it has at least been decided to proceed to an epuration which has been too long delayed.

It recalls the case of PICORDO ... (Dept note: See below: several groups indecypherable after this)... it is known that S.I.M. carries out above all a political activity.

This service (I am still quoting the above newspaper) is stated to have been -----ed in SWITZERLAND by "Capo Carabiniere DERMIDOFF (sic) who figures in the list of the Diplomatic Corps in BERNE in the capacity of Assistant Commercial Attaché". The correspondent goes on to state that his most important collaborators are PICCARDO, "Head of (groups corrupt) Vice Consul in GENEVA" and that many employees -----, clerks, and archivists are in reality agents of S.I.M. The article finally asserts that after the Armistice S.I.M. (groups corrupt) by Col. GIUSEPPE DENARI with statues of Consular Commissioner.

I consider that the articles above described are to be thought of as connected with certain previous publications and statements on the subject which have appeared in various organs of the Swiss press and which I am reporting by bag.

I shall follow up this matter and report.

In the course of my recent conversations on general subjects I once more raised the subject of restitution of grain, which (?seemed) to me to have been set going in the direction of a favourable solution. I insisted that it would be morally and politically right that the grain should be restored "in natura" (?in its natural state).

This solution would imply the importation of grain from ARGENTINA, as none can be taken from local stock.

In an interview which I had today with ----- QUE----- (?LEQUERICA) I suggested that a possible solution of the sea transport difficulty lay in the present availability by coincidence of the "MADDA" with her capacity of ab 7000 tons.

The Political ~~Separaten~~ Department here has informed me that the Federal Government has decided to forbid the import or export (or) trade (in) Foreign banker's notes (biglietti di banca). This provision is to come into force immediately.

It is clear that the matter was (?decided) in the course of the conversations now going on between SWITZERLAND on the one hand and the (British), Americans and French on the other.

The latter had (advocated) the adoption of the measure in question for their respective ----- and had said that they considered it necessary that the provision should be given a general character. The President of the Confederation has declared to the Press that the prohibition is aimed at preventing irregular transactions with bankers' notes, and avoiding the possibility that notes coming from territory formerly occupied by the Germans may be ----- in SWITZERLAND.

1. Following conversations on the subject I intend to express to the Foreign Office my sincere satisfaction over Churchill's declaration and I begged Assistant Secretary of State HARVEY to speak meanwhile on my behalf to the Prime Minister and Mr EDEN. The inclusion of Italian questions which had not been discussed at YALTA in the Prime Minister's speech, which was justly called one of the most important since the beginning of the war, was not necessarily to be expected and I think it was ----- in great measure to the Offices of EDEN of whose desire for ----- of the Italian situation I have personally had proof and assurance.
2. (?the treatment) touched on the principal subjects which are ~~we~~ closest to the Italian people's desires; Italy was clearly referred to as a name which will figure again among the "leading nations in Europe"; he asserted that England desires to go forward to meet Italy, he ~~spoke~~ of the Italian contribution with reference to the important "invaluable service" of men and women of the armed forces and patriots on both sides of the enemy lines, explaining his reasons, which in any case are obvious, for not doing it in more complete form; he admitted the responsibility of the Allies as to the Liberation of North Italy, and gave indirect assurance that in that crucially important moment ~~we~~ should be furnished necessary material aid. He confirmed the improved prospects for Liberated ITALY.
3. Adding these statements to those of MACMILLAN, it is the general feeling here that a large new link has been forged with toil to add to the chain which must lead to the rehabilitation of our country. But a special importance is attached to the fact that the British Government has decided to stand up to English public opinion, breaking the long and hard silence which previously had been interrupted only incidentally, not (?opposing us outright) but always expressing reserves, which this time are entirely absent.

It is my personal conviction that (?we have reached) as regards ENGLAND a second stage which should be considered as the starting point for a decisive re-

vision of judgments and attitudes towards us.

4. No hostile reaction has appeared in the press, which, though it did not especially emphasize this part of the Prime Minister's speech, published it as an ordinary incident of Foreign policy. In Parliament the thing met with a cool reception but nothing really hostile partly because attention was generally concentrated on the statements concerning POLAND. We should render homage to the skill of the Prime Minister who, being determined to speak of ITALY in a way which would not be popular chose a way to avoid the harm of unfavourable comments which might have been expected in view of the resentment which persists in certain quarters. I do not think that questions which may possibly be put will modify this favourable situation. To a person who expressed a desire to help us I gave the advice (because I was persistently asked to say what I thought) that he should not (belabour) people here with our case, because this might after things had gone off so well, draw attention to certain critical Italian questions at this delicate stage.

5. (Although) the Italian press and public after so much suffering would have desired and perhaps expected more emphatic expressions, apart from the events (so easily forgotten by the masses of the public) for which CHURCHILL rightly has (the term) "days of MUSSOLINI", it is necessary to remember and to say that there is a fundamental difference in temperament which remains when more serious differences disappear.

It should be explained in ITALY that recent progress is valuable for the solid and enduring character of its development and in so far as it accentuates and indicates the degree of rapprochement already achieved. The Italian press could make no greater contribution than (to express) our appreciation of this point of view, which would do justice once and for all to our friends here and to the hard work done by you and your collaborators. A last point to keep in mind is the possible resentment of Allied countries like ----- (Group corrupt) which have been under German occupation but feel justified rancour towards us.

Later as you know preemptory measures were taken by Inter-Ministerial decree of 25th May 1936 (and on 30th June for European countries and Mediterranean Basin) concerning the acknowledgement of holdings abroad.

Since 1936 a person who crosses the frontier in the regular manner can carry with him only a very small amount in paper lire, and that only by furnishing documentary proof of ownership. I received your no. 134 (Dept note: CSM/D 685) only today. Yesterday I received (the first) remonstrances against the telegram from TOGLIATTI to NEGRI, the news of which reached the Spanish Government a short time after the Cabinet meeting which I reported in my no; 248 (Dept note: CS/D 703). This action, particularly because it was taken by so eminent a member of the Italian Government, has aroused a strong resentment here which may weaken the labours which were undertaken in a spirit of cooperation and strengthen those who are trying to prevent a conclusion in our favour. You, who know well the importance in our unfortunate circumstances of solving the great problems of finance and food supply now under discussion, can well understand my anxiety at seeing the present favourable prospects compromised by party action. For my part, to overcome the present crisis I shall use every possible means of persuading those in the ^{Spanish} Government who at this moment are well disposed towards us. I trust however that I shall be informed of the intentions of the parties which form the ^(Italian) Government, concerning diplomatic relations with SPAIN, so that I may be able to guide my own ~~actions~~ activities which are governed exclusively by the highest interests of the country.

Following numerous conversations held recently with the Foreign Ministry, and with the active aid of Ambassador SARGONIZ, the Spanish Government on its own initiative this morning published a press communiqué announcing that the Cabinet, under the Presidency of the Chief of State, decided to present to the Cortes the draft of an enactment to institute an extraordinary credit of 76,460,085,50 pesetas to (liquidate credits?) toward an Italo Spanish trade balance. In conversations held this morning with Ambassador SARGONIZ and the Director General of Economic Affairs, they justly emphasized the political value of these financial measures, which are opening the way for the reestablishment of commercial relations between the two countries. This credit, added to the three payments now (due for repayment) and blocked (December 1943, June and December 1944) would according to Spanish figures which I shall verify, furnish sufficient means to establish a balance. Agreements will be reached to equalize this credit with the expected payment of future instalments on the war debt. 134. The Spanish Chargé d'Affaires here protested strongly today against telegram recently sent by TOGLIATTI to NEGRIN after sixteen Communists were shot in SPAIN. Telegram published today in newspaper UNITA.

Our reply to the Chargé d'Affaires was that PALMIRO TOGLIATTI is Head of the Italian Communist Party and that he sent the telegram in that capacity and under that authority. That TOGLIATTI is also Vice President of the Council of Ministers does not enter into this case because he did not speak as such, nor, consequently, in the name of the Government. Furthermore the attitude of the Communists towards the Spanish régime has for years been a matter of common knowledge, and is unchangeable.

The Chargé d'Affaires indicated that he understood this, but added that he was afraid that the news would give rise to antagonism in SPAIN, even though you so recently met with perfectly courteous recognition there; and that the violence of the Italian press might lead in the end to grave complications.
