The Political Section presents its compliments to the Legation of Switzerland and refers to the latter's Memorandum number 260 of July 8, 1944, concerning the telephone of the Swiss Federal Railways Office, No. 681.304. Headquarters A.M.G., Rome Region informs us that the telephone is out of order due to damage on the line, but that this will be repaired shortly.

Although it is contrary to recognized practice to permit unrestricted facilities on any civilian telephones, arrangements to permit forty calls per day on this number will be made as soon as the line is again in order.
