OF KING VICTOR EMANUEL BEARING IN MIND THE DIFFICULTY
OF SECURING OBJECTIVE DATA AS TO VARYING ATTITUDES OF
OFFICERS AND MEN. WILL YOU CAUSE A REPORT TO BE MADE
ON THE SITUATION. YOU WILL NO DOUBT DRAW UPON SOURCES
OF INFORMATION IN ACP AND ELSEWHERE, AND TAKE ACCOUNT
OF THE CIRCUMSTANCES IN WHICH THE ABANDON MIGHT BE
BROUGHT ABOUT, EG, VOLUNTARILY, UNDER PRESSURE FROM
HIS OWN PEOPLE, OR THROUGH ACTIVE INTERVENTION OF THE
ALLIES.
