SUBJECT: French Diplomatic Messages.

TO : Headquarters, Allied Commission, APO 394

1. Under date 29 September 1944 your signal 4053 stated that the French Provisional Government had asked whether the French Delegation to the Advisory Council for Italy might send diplomatic telegrams to Paris in the same way as they had previously done to Algiers.

2. French diplomatic messages between Paris and Italy are authorized provided messages from France in code are sent by means not liable to interception, and provided messages from Italy meet security requirements.

3. The Combined Signal Board has advised the Communications companies of the above, and forwarded you a copy of their letter.

4. It is requested that you advise the French Delegation on the Advisory Council for Italy.
