Before a General Court-Martial which convened at * * *, Sicily, pursuant to paragraph 10, Special Orders No. 28, this Headquarters, 30 September 1943, as amended by paragraph 1, Special Orders No. 47, this Headquarters, 19 October 1943, was arraigned and tried:

Major Stephen D. Martin, 0803542, Corps of Military Police, Headquarters Allied Military Government, * * *, Sicily.

Charge: Violation of the 64th Article of War.

Specification: In that Major Stephen D. Martin, Corps Military Police, then Civil Affairs Officer at * * *, Sicily, having received a lawful command from Lieutenant Colonel Floyd E. Thomas, Infantry, his superior officer, referring to one Luigi Galano, an Italian prisoner of war, "Do not take Luigi with you to * * *", or words to that effect, did at or near * * *, Sicily, on or about 12 August 1943, willfully disobey the same.

PLEAS
