Rescinded: Administrative Order No 13, this Hq, dated 9 Jan 44.

1. SUPPLY

a. Peninsular Base Section is responsible for the direct supply of:

- (1) All U. S. Army and French Army units assigned or attached to PBS.
- (2) All Fifth Army U. S. and French units in PBS area.
- (3) Miscellaneous units of various commands assigned or attached by competent order to PBS for supply.
- (4) Common items to all U. S. Air Force units in Western Italy thru Air Force Depots.
- (5) Common items to U. S. Navy units in PBS area or ships based on NAPLES and its satellite ports.

b. Units can obtain issues under the following procedure:

- (1) Class I rations: On "Daily Telegram" of unit submitted by 1200 hours daily to nearest Base M Class I Supply Point for issue therefrom next day to unit for consumption on day following.
 - (a) "Daily Telegram" form to be used is attached hereto as Annex No. 1.
 - (b) Fifth Army units located in Base Section will submit an information copy of "Daily Telegram" to the CG, Fifth Army, APO 464 (Attention G-4 Rear).
 - (c) Air Force units will submit their "Daily Telegrams" thru their Air Force Service Group for consolidation.
- (2) Class II: For actual requirements within authorized T/B or within special authorization approved by SCS, NATOUSA, on requisition from unit submitted the first and fifteenth days of each month. Requisitions will be submitted to appropriate Base Depots or Base Supply Points except Ordnance requisitions for which see paragraphs (b), (c), and (d) below.
 - (a) A Fifth Army unit in the Base Section will submit an information copy of its requisition to the CG, Fifth Army, APO 464 (Attention G-4 Rear).

- (b) Assemblies, sub-assemblies and parts for Ordnance equipment required by organizations will be obtained by direct exchange with Ordnance Maintenance Company to which unit is assigned for 3rd echelon maintenance.
 - (c) Cleaning, preserving, lubricating and similar materials will be issued by the Ordnance Maintenance Company to which an organization is assigned for 3rd echelon maintenance upon approved requisition.
 - (d) Ordnance Class II & IV requisitions (to fill T/EA shortages and for specially authorized major items) will not be submitted to Ordnance Maintenance Companies or Supply Points, but will be presented to the Base Ordnance Officer on the 1st and 15th days of each month for approval and issue.
- (3) Class III:
- (a) Refill of vehicle tanks on demand by showing Trip Ticket at Bulk Dispensing Stations or Vehicular Refueling Points. Allied military vehicles will be serviced at either U. S. or British Refueling Points.
 - (b) Other issues on requisition to Bulk Dispensing Stations.
- (4) Class IV: On requisition from unit submitted the 1st and 15th days of each month to the appropriate Supply Service.
- (a) The Base Section unit will route its Class IV requisition to the Section Chief under whose control the unit operates. Section Chiefs will screen these requisitions and approve only items required for the efficient functioning of the unit or to provide accommodations within approved scales.
 - (b) Ordnance requisitions will be routed in accordance with paragraph 1 b (2) (d) above.
- (5) Class V: Only issues authorized are training ammunition and prescribed loads on proper certification at Base Ammunition Depots.
- (6) Miscellaneous:
- (a) Gratuitous issues of FX supplies - no gratuitous issues will be made in FES area.
 - (b) Blank Forms - by requisition on AG Depot No 199.
 - (c) Italian Military Units - Thru Italian Army channels from Italian Army Depots effective 24 March 1944.
