NAVAL WAR COLLEGE

1. The next five months' course at the Naval War College opens on or about 1 July 1944. This is not to be confused with the Army and Navy Staff College. This theater has been authorized to submit one or more names of prospective candidates.

2. Officers selected must be physically qualified for overseas service, should be graduates of Command and General Staff School, and should have superior general efficiency rating (GER) or excellent GER with demonstrated superior capacity not yet reflected in GER. Age limits are 45 for Colonels, 40 for Lieutenant Colonels, and 35 for Majors. Officers must not have reached these ages on 1 July 1944.

3. Officers finally selected as students will be relieved from present assignments and assigned to the Naval War College.

4. Staff sections desiring to nominate an officer to attend this course will submit name, rank, serial number, organization, and qualifications called for above, to the Adjutant General, not later than 25 May 1944.
