ADMINISTRATIVE INSTRUCTIONS NO. 1. 12 LUG. 1944

EMPLOYMENT OF CIVILIAN LABOR

The following instructions are issued to organizations employing civilian labor within this command.

a. Labor will be requested from the Labor Supply Office located at No. 6 Via Lucullus - Rome - Telephone 42323.

(1) As all labor is registered at this office, direct hirings by units should be discouraged except in cases of actual emergency.

(2) Direct hiring must be reported to the above office by name, in order that the labor offices records of available labor may be kept current.

(3) Labor must be ordered 24 hours in advance of time needed. This, so that proper selection and referral may be made, as it is desired to discourage street hiring and the consequent congregation of crowds about the Labor office.

(4) Labor when ordered and referred may, be rejected if unsuitable, but must otherwise be hired for at least one working day.

(5) Reports to the Labor Office of unsuitable referrals are requested.

b. Civilian contractors doing contractual work for Military units should be instructed to make application for labor at the above mentioned office.

c. Employing officers operating within this command area will pay civilian labor promptly, especially those employing units leaving or about to leave the limits of this command.
