1. Coal gas is at present reserved for civilian use only. Owing to the very short supply, allied military units are not permitted to use coal gas for any purpose whatsoever, except hospitals for whom special applications have been submitted through Medical Branch.

2. All troops in this Command will be warned of the danger of coal-gas poisoning, due to cut gas pipes and faulty connections.

TO : See Distribution.

1. Laundry instructions and Price List relative to Memorandum #3, this headquarters, dated 22 August 1944, are hereby rescinded.
2. The following instructions are for the compliance of all American Units desiring the services of the Tarantola Laundry:

- a. Units will contact the laundry office for schedule.
  - b. Laundry forms will be obtained at the laundry office.
  - c. Service rendered will be on a cash and carry basis.
  - d. Laundry will not be accepted if not in an individual barracks bag.
  - e. Laundry to be received from 0800 hours to 1200 hours daily and returned 1300 hours to 1700 hours daily excepting Sundays.
  - f. Bags will be delivered and called for by the unit supply officer or his representative.
  - g. Receipted laundry forms will be forwarded to laundry office.
  - h. 72-hour service will prevail.
3. Prices will be governed by the attached price lists.
  4. The Tarantola Laundry is located in the rear of Forum Italia. Posters along the highways indicate direction.

LAUNDRY FACILITIES

1. The "LAVANDERIA TARANTOLA" under the direction of the Compagnia Generale Organizzazione Lavoro is now under contract to provide steam laundry facilities for officers and men of American and British Forces in this command. Units may avail themselves of these facilities forthwith:

2. Hours

Units should hand in, and collect 3 days later at the following hours:

Daily from 0800 hrs to 1200 hrs - - dirty washing received.

Daily from 1300 hrs to 1700 hrs - - clean washing returned.

3. Location

The laundry is located at FORUM ITALIA. Drivers approaching from Ponte Milvio should watch for a notice past US Army Rest Center, on their right, marked as under:

LAVANDERIA TARANTOLA  
TARANTOLA LAUNDRY

This notice is at the entrance to an avenue leading to the laundry. Drivers approaching from Viale Angelico will find this notice on their left.

5. Officer's Washing

Private arrangements should be made direct with the laundry either through units or individually. Payment will be the individual Officer's responsibility. British Officers must supply their own soap.

6. Prices

In no circumstances will payments exceed the prices shown in lists published by this Hq, with instructions under para 4 a. and b. above. Officers in command of units will be held responsible for the prompt payment of accounts and for strict adherence to the procedure laid down in such instructions.
