Special Court Martial

Order No. 34

Refers a Special Court Martial which convened at Headquarters, Zone Area, ALICATA, 2012 Area, 100 Army, pursuant to paragraph 7, Special Orders Number 100, 10 August 1945, as amended by paragraph 1, Special Orders Number 101, 30 August 1945. This Headquarters, was assigned and tried:

Private First Class Henry M. Gieseler, 3639 100, 100 Army, Administrative Battalion, Air Force Post Center, (Air Force Overhead), 100, in the area 100 100, 100, and also, 100, between about 10 February 1945 and 10 February 1945, knowingly and willfully misappropriated a sum of two and a half ten times of a value in excess of fifty (\$50.00) dollars, property of the United States, furnished and intended for the military service thereof.

He is confined at hard labor at such place as the reviewing authority or board for the 101 101, to forfeit thirty-five dollars and seventy cents (\$35.70) for each six (6) months, and to be returned to the grade of Private.

The sentence was adjudged 1 September 1945.

Only so much of the sentence as provides for a forfeiture of thirty-five (\$35) dollars per month for a period of six (6) months is to be carried out and will be fully executed.

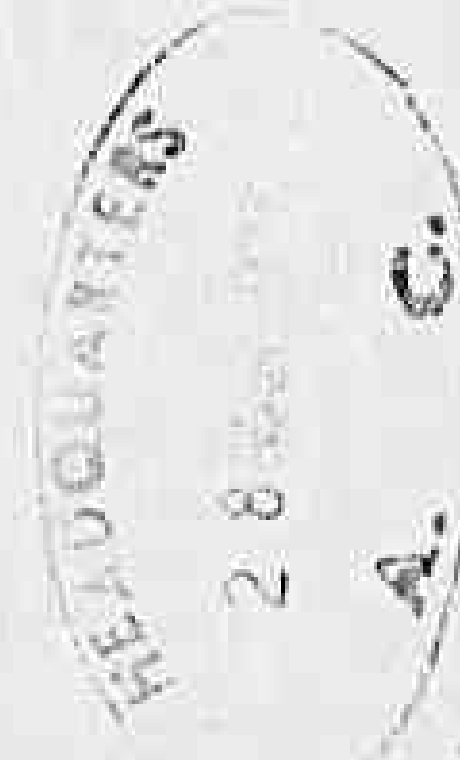
