I - RESCISSION OF GENERAL ORDER NUMBER 1, 1945

General Order Number 1, this headquarters, 4 January 1945, is rescinded.

II - OFF LIMITS AND OUT OF BOUNDS

The following locations, buildings, areas, etc, in the Rome Area are placed "OUT OF BOUNDS" and "OFF LIMITS" to all Allied Military Personnel.

1. All houses of prostitution.
2. All Public Baths.
3. All restaurants and eating houses except:
 - a. Clubs, restaurants, etc, organized and controlled by the Allied Forces.
 - b. Cafes, etc, where no foodstuffs are sold.
4. Establishment operated under the name of "R. Sciambro" located at Via Carlo Alberto 4.
5. Distillery located at Via Alfredo Rocca 158.
6. The Royal Estate of Castel Porziano located approximately 25 km South of Rome, coordinates F6750, Map: Italy, 1/50,000, sheet # 149-11, Ostia Lido.

Application for the connection of elevators not covered by (a) and (b) above will not be made unless special circumstances (e.g. infirmity, sickness or age) are considered to justify the disturbance of the programme.

II - SUPPLY OF ELECTRIC LIGHT AND POWER
TO MILITARY PERSONNEL LIVING IN FLATS ETC.

While no special arrangements will be made for the supply of light and power to Allied Officers who have taken up residence in flats etc, the present civil ration will shortly be increased and domestic appliances are expected to come into use in the future. 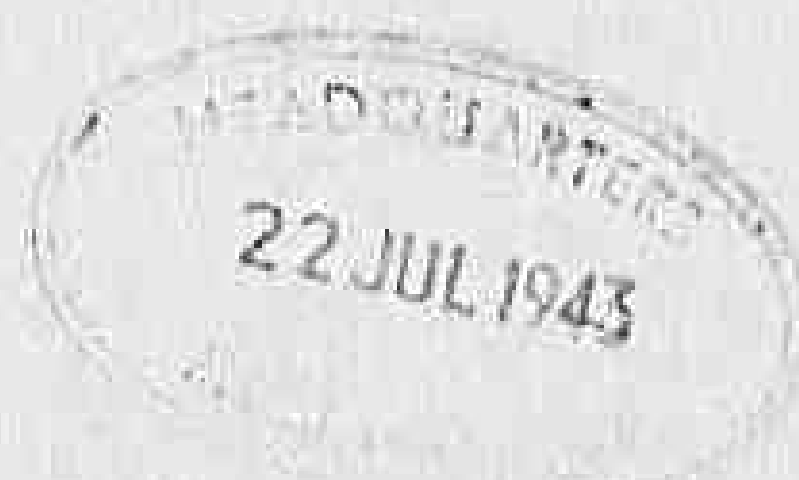

CONSERVATION OF WATER

1. The attention of all concerned is directed to the necessity for conserving water during the coming months.

2. Several factors point to an impending shortage of water and a consequent reduction of pressure in the distribution system as the season advances. There are no reservoirs in the system and therefore no reserve can be stored up in order to offset the normal seasonal reduction in the output of the source. An unusually dry spring season indicates that this output may be reduced even more than usual this summer, and the population to be served, both military and civilian, is far in excess of the prewar population for which the distribution system was considered barely adequate.

3. All possible steps are being taken to provide as good a supply as possible under the limitation of the system, but it is certain that, as the season advances, the supply of water to some of the higher buildings and to installations in the higher sections of the city will fail. The excessive use of water in all sections will aggravate this situation by causing a further reduction in pressure. Last year municipal fire engines were employed to pump water into the storage tanks of such buildings, but this somewhat antiquated apparatus is now worn out and will not be available for the purpose this year.

4. Attention is directed to the fact that the water used in the Roman fountains and that used for wetting down the streets of the city is not potable and is not connected with the drinking supply. Discontinuing these services will not increase the supply of potable water.

5. It has been found that various military users make a practice of tampering with or by-passing the control orifices which meter water from the main to the utility establishment. This practice must be discontinued since excessive water at one point will unbalance the system in an entire area, and will only complicate the problem of water discipline particularly during the season drought. The adjustment of an orifice to give more water than is normally used only results in the excess water passing through the storage tank overflow pipe and being wasted. Any required orifice adjustments will be made by civilian water company personnel only, and water complaints must be referred to the Water Section, Engineer Services, M.S.A.C.
