The Medical Supply Branch of the Public Health Sub-Commission is hereby transferred to the Economic Section where it will become a part of the Warehousing Branch of the Food Sub-Commission.

XVI -- DESIGNATION AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE CIVIL AFFAIRS SECTION

The present Administrative Section is hereby designated as the Civil Affairs Section. XXII - GENERAL

The establishment, transfer and abolition of the offices, sections, sub-commissions and branches hereby announced will take effect on the date of this order.

The reorganizations and amalgamations of Sub-Commissions and Branches hereby directed and the further recommendations contained in the manpower & re-organization Committee's report of the 27 Aug 44 with certain modifications shown in the appendix, will be carried out under the direction of respective Sections Heads and completed by 9 October 1944.
