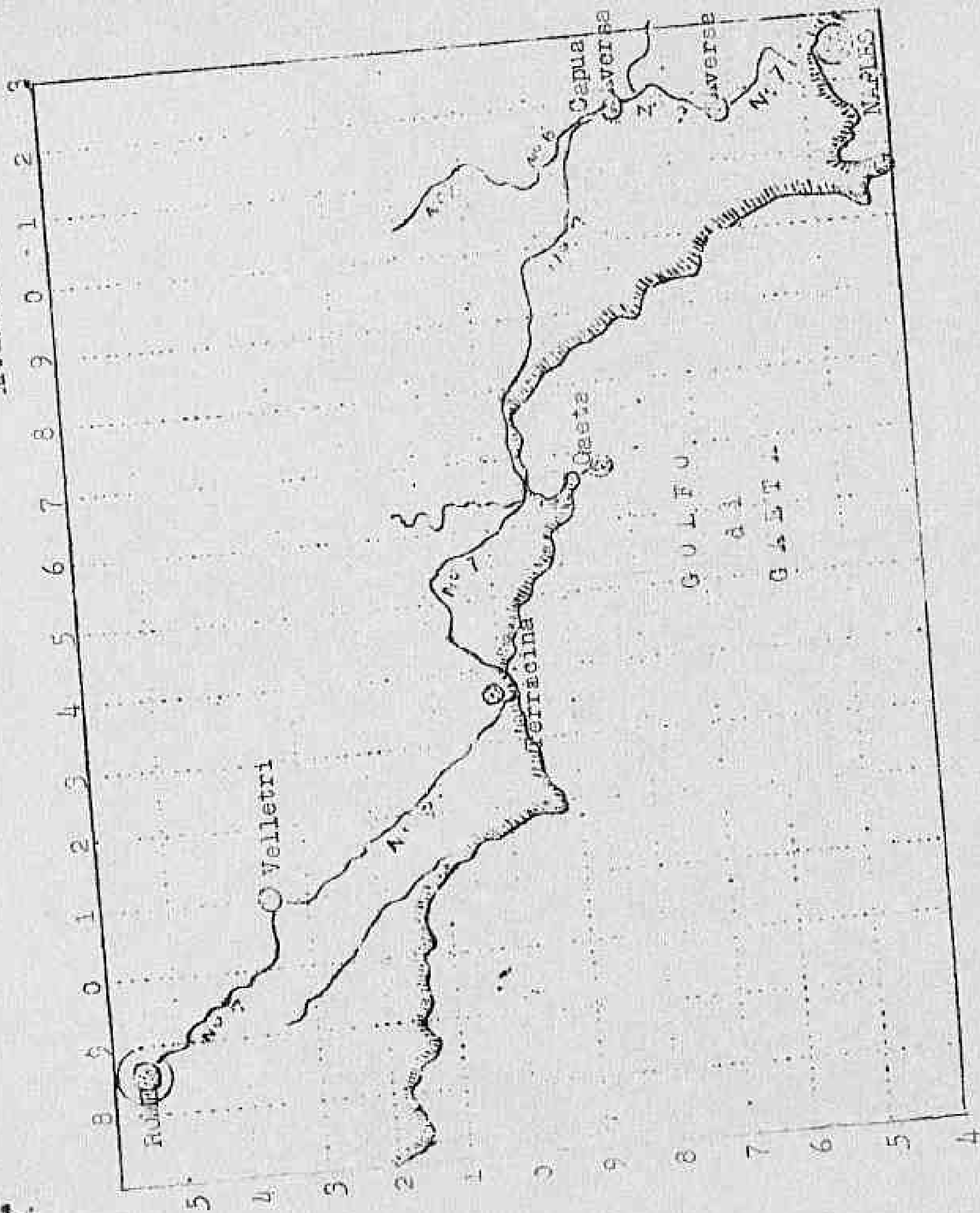

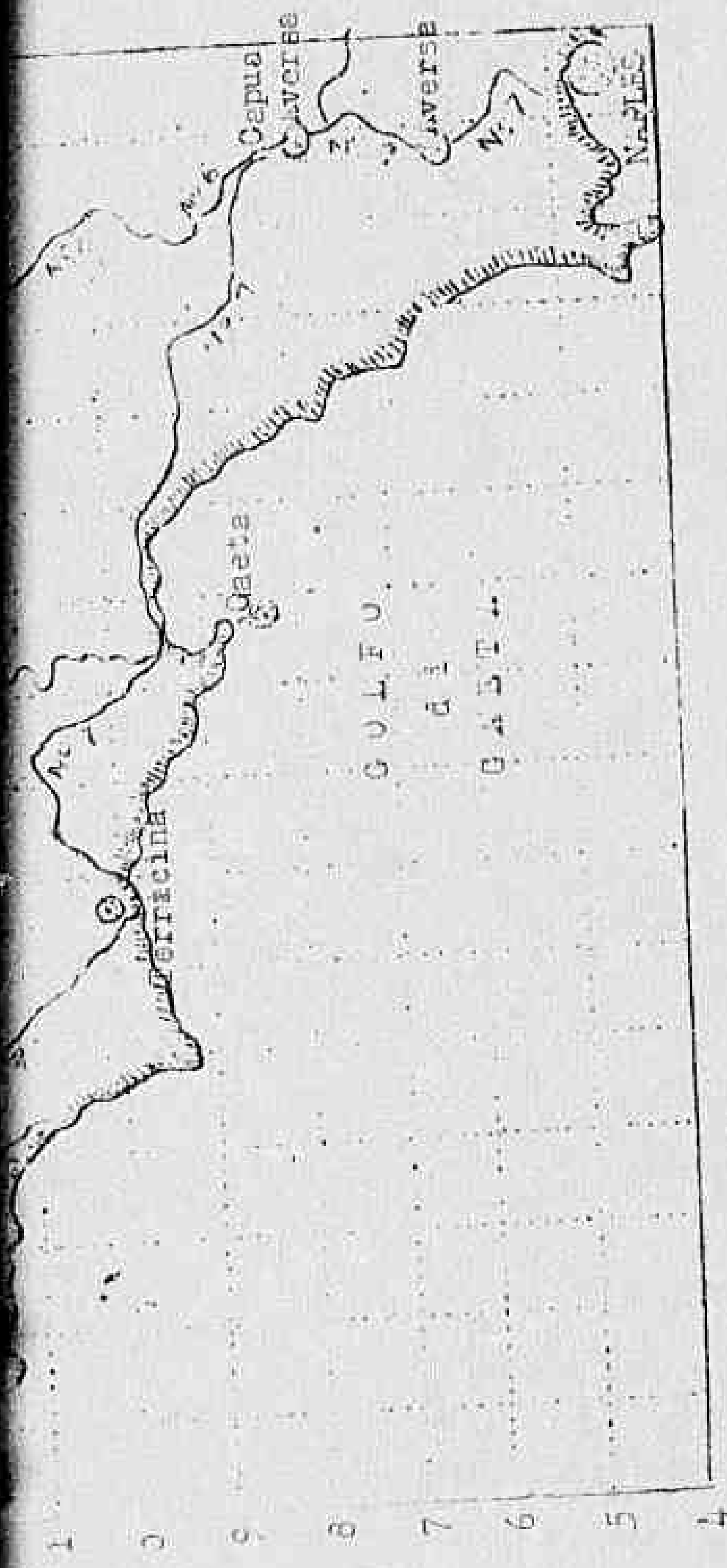


Route to be followed:

1. Platoons Nos. 2001 and 2002 of the Italian Army, attached to this Hq for duty with the Food Sub-Commission, will move to new location on or about 2 July 44. Tenente SOAVE Matteo will be in command of the party.
2. Movement will be by sea. Time of embarkation, berth number, will be notified later.
3. These platoons will proceed fully equipped and self-contained, in regard to rations, cooking equipment and tentage. G-4 (B) will supply the necessary tentage consisting of 3 x 160 lb tents, and 27 bivouac tents. Food Sub-Commission will be responsible for these tents, and will sign accordingly.
4. These men, as enumerated in Appendix "A", will be struck off attached strength of Headquarters Commandant, ACC (MAIN), and will be attached on arrival at new location to Region IV for administration. They will continue to be employed by Food Sub-Commission.
5. Rations for 10 days will be carried in bulk and Dispatch Officer will arrange the necessary transport to convey personnel and stores from Typhus Control Camp, NAPLES, to ship side.
