Signal Instruction No. 5

1. Telephone circuits are now in operation Palermo - Catania - Messina - Salerno. (UG cable). Hq. A.C.C. have ordered that these circuits be used by Italian Government officials only. A.C.C. officers will only use these circuits for emergency calls.

2. An additional telephone circuit Palermo - Catania (UG cable) has been established for A.C.C. use only. The delay on calls to Catania, Messina, Siracusa and Ragusa should now be short. Officers will make long distance calls through "DOTTY" by dialing ZERO.

3. To complete the rehabilitation of the telephone circuit Palermo - Trapani, 7 miles of copper wire is required. Efforts are being made to produce the wire from other routes and until such time as it is forthcoming calls to Trapani will be made via Broadway - Cinfizz - B. Rizzo - Napoli - Trapani (civil). Ask for each of these exchanges in turn. If the Broadway - Brown circuit is less noisy officers are requested to use it.

4. Add to the list of authorized long distance subscribers:

- a. All "Camera di Commercio."
- b. All "Medici Provinciali."

5. Attached, to the scale of one set per Provincial Hq. are telephone/telegraph signal diagrams. These are for the information of all officers and especially those of Public Safety.

6. A complete amendment to the Regional Telephone Directory is to be published within the next few days.

2. A complaint has been received from the Signal Officers, IBS, that officers are not only misusing military trunk facilities, but that on several occasions the switchboard operators at "Broadway" have been subjected to abuse. Calls for ACC subscribers will be routed through ACC switchboards and circuits. All provincial capitals are linked by ACC trunk circuits and an ACC exchange exists in either the S.E.T. or Provincial HQ. Military operators have been given orders to refuse calls on military circuits if an ACC subscriber is calling another ACC number. If the ACC trunk is out of order military facilities may be used.

3. All personnel are warned that it is a serious offense to allow unauthorized persons to use the ACC longdistance telephone system.
