1. COURIER SERVICE, ROME-CHIANCIANO:

Companies N (Liguria Region), R (Region XI), and S (Piemonte Region) will begin a daily courier service between Chianciano and Rome on the 26 September 1944.

The run will be made by a vehicle and driver from above named companies and in the order shown in the first paragraph. The courier will make three stops in Chianciano as follows:

- a. 0830 hours - Co. "N" Orderly Room (Hotel Alba)
- b. 0845 hrs - Co. "R" Message Center (Hotel Imperial)
- c. 0900 hours - Co. "S" Orderly Room (Hotel Palme)

Upon arrival in Rome the courier will deliver all items to the A.C.C. Hq. Message Center for onward transmission.

3. MALARIA CONTROL:

All personnel will take Atabrine tablets.

- (a) Dosage - One tablet (0.1 gram) daily, preferably at evening with a cupful of liquid.
- (b) The administration will be supervised by and officer or N.C.O., when possible who will personally see that the drug is taken "on the spot".
- (c) Leggings will be worn by all sentries on duty, at night.
- (d) Spray-killing of mosquitos will be done in all sleeping quarters at dusk and before bed-time.

4. OFFICER'S PAY - AMERICAN:

Statutory Provisions - a. Arrears Not to Exceed 2 Months.
