Air Forces Sub-Commission, therefore, may be able to furnish an indication of Italian Civil and Military Airfield needs in the future.
3. It is therefore requested that a list of these surplus U.S. Army Airfields needed in the future by the Italian military or Italian civil authorities be furnished OFLC/MTO to aid in disposal action.
4. The need of expeditious action is emphasized due to the fact that a number of these fields are at present needed by Italian civilians for farm land, and they are presently being held under guard by the U.S. Army until disposal action is accomplished. These fields, on which there is no sales value by OFLC/MTO, will be derequisitioned by the U.S. Army and the land returned to the farmers as soon as it is determined that there is no future Italian Military or Civil need.

STATEMENT

The undersigned, Major Adam Augusto previously commanding the partisan section "Valle d'Aosta" with the borrowed name of 'Blanc', states that between 1st and 5th of May 1945, Major Br. Howell, Provincial Commissioner of A.M.C. Aosta, gave instructions to Cogne National Society, to render serviceable the emergency airfield of Aosta with the greatest urgency, because the American General commanding the division in the North Western area of Piedmont had to land there. The arrival of the American General was in connection with the very delicate politic and military situation at that time in Valle d'Aosta.

Under the circumstances AMG gave orders to overcome any difficulty, holding responsible the O.C. partisans of any delay in carrying them out, the managers of the Company, aware of the importance of the works, succeeded through working 24 hours a day to clear the landing ground of the various obstacles and to prepare the requested strip within the time limit for which they were congratulated by the Allied Provincial Commissioner.

With reference to Headquarters R.A.F. letter 1005/4/eng. dated 20th May, the Italian Air Ministry have been notified by this Headquarters that the San Marco airfield at Vardor is derequisitioned, although it is still held in the books of the Office in charge of the Foreign Liaison Committee for a settlement between the Spanish and Italian Governments.

The Italian Air Ministry has also requested and has been granted permission to use the airfield as a stop on the Northern Corridor service and are at present setting up the ground organization to run this service and to deal with Allied and Italian Government concerned passengers using this route.

This Headquarters suggested amendments to the recommendations outlined in Para 5 of R.A.F.'s letter are:

- (a) That the Italian Offices in charge San Marco should retain control of the airfield and be responsible for flying discipline and for the discipline of Italian services and civilian personnel.
- (b) That the R.A.F. unit provide their own safety, refueling and servicing arrangements and operate flying services in conjunction with the Italian Air Force.
- (c) That the R.A.F. operate on a logistic unit basis, with a guarantee that they will be afforded every facility through the Italian Air Force Liaison Office or through the Air Force Liaison Committee.
- 4. This method of control is now functioning smoothly at Limosellon where a Polish (R.A.F.) flight is stationed.

LIDO AIRFIELD, VENICE. NAME: SAN NICOLA.

The aircraft on the Lido at Venice, 45° 25' 30" N., 12° 23' 00" E., two and a half miles east by south of the centre of Venice, is at present under the controlling authority of the Italian Air Force.

2. It presents a detachment of 654 A.C.R. Squadron, consisting of three fighter aircraft, three officers and four airmen, are stationed on the Lido Airfield. This detachment does not accept any responsibility for the control of the airfield or of the servicing of Allied aircraft which may land there. No servicing facilities can be given by this unit with the exception of extremely limited refuelling.

3. An Italian Air Force unit, composed mainly of specialist officers and men, occupies the main headquarters building. Their duties are purely meteorological and their equipment is excellent.

4. It is anticipated that the Lido airfield will be required for the use of Allied aircraft visiting Venice and it is deemed to regularise the use of this airfield.

5. Recommendations:-

(a) The Lido Airfield should be under the administrative and operational control of the Officer Commanding, 244 Wing, and all units on the airfield should come under his control for discipline and administrative control. Colonel De Robiliant, Italian Air Force Liaison Officer with Desert Air Force is prepared to be responsible for ensuring the co-ordination of Italian Air Force units stationed at the airfield with 244 Wing. The Officer Commanding, 244 Wing, should appoint an officer of the rank of Flight Lieutenant to be detached to the Lido airfield to be in charge of the airfield.

(b) A small unit consisting of 1 S.H.C.O. and 12 airmen should be detached from 244 Wing to be responsible for flying control, safety arrangements, liaison, refuelling and servicing facilities. Under the existing establishment of 244 Wing it would be possible to detach these airmen from 318 (F) Squadron with one or two R.A.F. C.R.'s to complete the complement.

(c) Flying control should be run in conjunction with the I.A.F. who will accept the capability of watches, etc., if equipment such as Aldis lamps, etc. is supplied. Colonel De Robiliant would ensure that a Colonel of the I.A.F. would be in charge and that he would exercise the direct control of the officer appointed

(b) A small unit consisting of 1 S.A.S.C. and 12 airmen should be detached from 244 Wing to be responsible for flying control, safety arrangements, limited refueling and servicing facilities. Under the existing establishment of 244 Wing it would be possible to detach these airmen from 316 (F) Squadron with one or two R.A.F. O.A.'s to complete the complement.

(c) Flying control should be run in conjunction with the I.A.F. who will accept responsibility of watches, etc., if equipment such as Altimeter, etc. is supplied. Colonel de Robiliant would ensure that a Colonel of the I.A.F. would be in charge and that he would come under the direct control of the officer appointed by the Officer Commanding, 244 Wing.

(d) It is suggested that pending the supply of a five engine and auxiliary 2 x 15 cwt. vehicles should be fitted out with extinguishers and sandbags and to stand by on the airfield during a fixed period to be laid down by Officer Commanding, 244 Wing. Should this recommendation be approved, R.A.F. O.A.'s. will supply the 15 cwt. and 244 Wing will supply and use them.

(e) All use of the airfield by civilians to cause disturbance and all units to be notified of the authority of the O.C. Lido Airfield.

Reference is made to your letter 12/6/3 dated 11st January, 1946, and to the telephone conversation between Major Dalforce and F/O James in which it was agreed that tank driving would NOT take place on the runway of Vicenza Airfield, and that exercises would be confined to the bombed and damaged part of the airfield.

2. The Italian Air Force, however, now informs this office that tank exercises are being carried out over the whole of the airfield and that the runway is being crossed indiscriminately. As a result of a recent visit by F/O James it is confirmed that tanks have been recently crossing the runway, fresh tank tracks being in evidence. A translation of the I.A.F. letter to this office is enclosed.

3. It would be appreciated if efforts be made to keep the runway serviceable, and to do as little damage as possible to the rest of the airfield.







AG/60153 dated 13th September 1945, informed us that CERVIA and BELLARIA Airfields could be derequisitioned immediately after the existing equipment on the airfields is cleared by P.B.S.

Your AFSC/22/AIR dated November 1945 enclosed a letter from H.Q. AAFSC/MTO-APO 528, ref. No. 601.53 dated 14th November 1945, authorising the derequisitioning of GHEDI Airfield.

We would like to inform you however that a "Prisoners Camp" is up to this date in existence on Rimini Airfield. Ghedi Airfield is still occupied by Allied Units, while Bellaria, Cervia and Cesenatico Airfields are occupied by Polish troops.

We are pointing out the above as it is holding up derequisitioning arrangements of the privately owned land used for airfields.



1. With reference to your letter MAAC/4203/1/AFAC, dated 15 January 1946, and your letter of even reference dated 26 January 1946, the following information is submitted.

2. The Italian Air Force would like to use Gioia Del Colle Airfield, but due to the unreasonable rental value asked by the high authorities they will not be able to occupy this field.

3. It is not understood by this office and the undersigned why such an enormous rental value is demanded for this field. It is requested that some action be taken to get this rental value lowered to some reasonable figure.

4. I have been informed verbally by a member of the O.P.L.C. Office in Rome that a number of airfields which are in the same category as Gioia Del Colle are to be consolidated and offered for sale in a special proposal to the Italian Government within the near future. If this materializes it is believed that the Italian Air Ministry will be willing to purchase installations at these fields for a reasonable sum. In view of this, it may be best for your office to sit tight and wait for further developments from the O.P.L.C. and not attempt to determine why such an outrageous rental value is placed on the field in question.

It is therefore suggested that the question be reexamined in order that the Italian Aeronautical Administration be given a solution, which, without hurting Allied interests, may improve its present condition. These improvements could be arranged following an agreement, so that a possible restitution of the airfield to the use of Allied units could be of greater advantage.

RENT OF THREE LAND PROPERTIES IN THE CIAMPINO NORD AREA

Through agreement of 10-3-1937 the General Secretariat of the "Fasci Italiani All'Esteri" was granted the rent of three land properties of approx. 7.400 square meters held by the Air Force Administration. Said zones are situated on the Ciampino North Airport area close to the Railroad Station of Ciampino.

The said zones were rented for the duration of nine years with the purpose of facilitating the construction, on the part of the Secretariat General a certain number of buildings for the storage of war material and clothing to be assigned to the "Summer for children Institutions and camping for the children of Italian citizens residing abroad."

At the present time, the Institution for children of Italian citizens residing abroad (Figli degli Italiani all'Esteri), following a decision of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, has come in possession of the whole real estate property previously kept by the said General Secretariat. In view of the time limit of said agreement, which will be effective up to the 10 of March, 1946, said Institute requests its renewal for a period of other nine years.

The writer while recommending the renewal of the agreement in question, kindly requests this Sub-Commission to examine and give favorable consideration to what is requested by this F.I.E. institution.

Your opinion in this matter will be very much appreciated.


