The only items of equipment removed by this Squadron from the Ministry of Aerial Warfare Building was done with the willing consent of the officer i/c.

Five safes were accounted for on the marching-out state forwarded to Real Estate RAAC, that is the number originally requisitioned.

It is desired to emphasise that the whole of the building in question was not occupied by this Squadron and during the period of marching-out, Ministry of Aeronautica personnel had complete access to all rooms in the building. In fact a considerable amount of furniture was interchanged from one part of the building to another by Ministry personnel while the building was still under requisition and it is therefore felt that responsibility for loss of furniture cannot be attached to the Squadron.

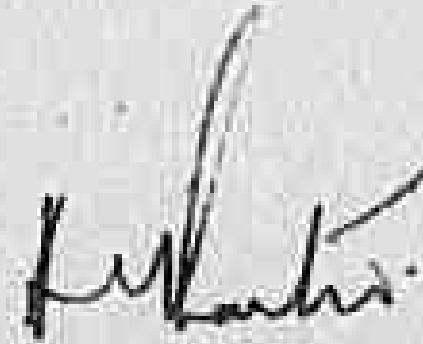

CONSUMPTION 54th SOUTH AFRICAN REGIMENT.

After the liberation of Venegono Airport from German occupation, the airfield was taken over by partisan forces on the 1st May 1945, but were replaced, upon orders received from Allied Command, on the 8th June 1945 by 20 men of the 54th South African Regiment who stopped there up to the 20th July 1945.

Owing to the fact that, during that period (42 days) The South African personnel used 25,20 quintals of fire wood for cooking purposes, with an average of 3 Kgs per man, we would be glad, therefore, if you would let us know to which unit, the request for the payment of the relative expenses which amounts to £. 7.308 should be forwarded.

1. Reference our letter R4/Agr/635 of 22/1/45 and yours AGR/397.0 dated 2nd inst.
2. Mr. Brignone Bernardo the owner of the seized tractor, has called again to this office reporting that up to now the machine has not yet been released nor has he heard any more about the tractor.
3. In view of the considerable delay and consequent losses he is sustaining and the need for hauling means of the Maccarese estates where this tractor was in operation, we kindly ask you to urge from the people concerned a final decision.
